## No. 528-A BY-LAW

Reapeoting Pootpathe and ditches on Publio Highwayn.
WHEREAS it in expedient to make bottor provinion for the regulation of the trafie on the Publio Hilghwayn; to met apart a portion thereof for the purpose of a footpath, and to prowerve and majatain the name, and the ditches on each or oither alde thereof.

Be it therefore enseted by the Munioipal Councll of the Corporution of the Township of Raleigh, in the County of Kont, by authority of ond subjoct to the rentriotion and provisions contalined in "The Municipal Aot," and amendments thereto.

1. That from and after the paming of this By-law, all that portion of any and every highway in the maid Township of Raloigh nituato, lying and being between the boundary linow and the road ditoh, on each or eithor nide thereof, be, and the same in hereby not apart an a footpath, for the uno and convenience of travellers on foot only.
2. That all hornee or other animale, led, ridden or driven, whether or not attachod to any carriage, wagon, aleigh, machine, engine or any vohicle when pauing alosg any pablic highway in the said Townehip of Raloigh, shall occupy oniy the portion of such highway which is situated between the ditches on either nide thereof, and in case there in no ditch on any or eithor alde thereof, ihall then occupy only such portion an lies botween lines drawa fifteen feet from the boundary line of such highway, and all much traffio, other than porsona travolling on loot, shall be restrained and wholly prohibited from treapaming upon, injuring or in any way uaing or ocoupying, for the purpone of anoh traffio, any portion of any highway, an in used for the purpose of, or ocoupled by any ditch, footpath or remorved apace all aforesaid.
3. It shall be the duty of the Overcuer in each and every Statate Labor divinion, or other officora appointed by the Municipality, to prosecute in the name of the Corporatioa, any permon or permons violating or iofriaging any of the provinions of this By-law who, if fovnd gailty on the oath or affirmation of a oredible witnese, whall, in the dil. oretion of any Juatice of the Peace having jurindiotion, forfeit and pay a penality not oxoesding ton dollarn, nor leme than two dollars and conta, to be levied by distreme and nale of goods and ohattola ; and it no sufficient distrese coan be found on whioh to lovy it thall and may be lawiul for the convioting or other Justice to commit the offender to gaol for any period not oxoceding twenty daya, or until the fine and conts of oommittal shall be paid. One half of such fine to be paid to the informant and the other half to the Treamarer of the Municipality.
4. Any person other than the Overneer of Highwaya may, for the purponen of proneoution under thin By-law, be the informant or compiainant.
5. Any Overneer of Highwaya may expend a portion of the Statate Labor fund in his divilion in improving and keeping in repair the said footpathn, and may ereot much ponte, raila, fonoen and bridgee as ho may deem neconmary to protect the eaid footpatha from injury or treepam.
6. This By-law whall take effeot on and after the first day of May, A.D. 1890.
