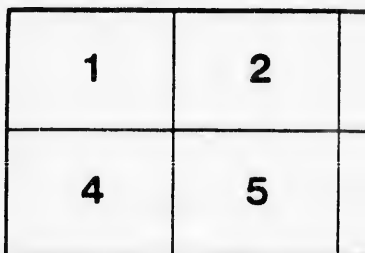

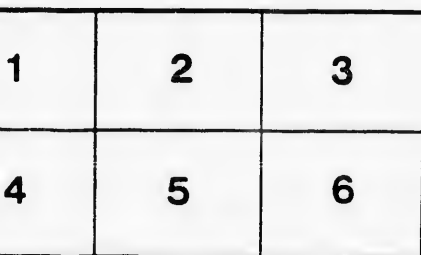
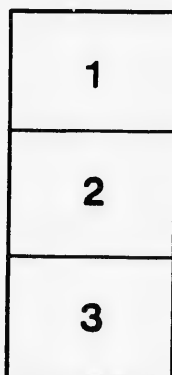

EXTRACTS FROM THE BY-LAWS OF THE ASSOCIATION.

SECTION II.—Of Members.

1. Any person may become a Member of the Association, by paying the necessary subscription, and obtaining a ticket of admission.
2. The subscriptions for Membership shall be as follows :

Merchants	\$5 00	per annum
Senior Clerks	4 00	"
Junior Clerks, Students, and Persons, under 21 years of age	2 00	"
All others	5 00	"
3. A payment of one hundred dollars to the funds of the Association, shall constitute the contributor a Member for life.
4. Each Member on payment of his contribution shall receive a ticket, which shall entitle him, during the period for which he may have subscribed, to all the privileges of the Association. This ticket he shall be bound to produce, when requested to do so, on visiting the Association.
5. If any ticket shall be presented by a person not a Member, the officer to whom it may be presented shall detain it, and it shall be forfeited.
6. Persons may be elected Honorary Members at any general meeting of the Association, and such persons shall be entitled to all the privileges of regular membership, except the right to vote and hold office.
7. Ladies shall be admitted to all the privileges of Membership, except the right of voting at Meetings, or taking part in the management of the Association; a room shall be appropriated for their use, if found necessary, by the Board of Direction. The subscription for ladies shall be fixed at \$50 for life, or \$3 for one year.
8. No Member shall injure any of the property of the Association, or conduct himself in the Rooms in any way inconsistent with decorum.
9. In all cases, hereinafter not specially provided for, any Member who shall violate any of the By-laws of the Association, shall make good all damage caused thereby, and in addition thereto, shall incur a penalty of One Dollar for each offence; but nothing in this By-law shall be held to prevent the expulsion of any Member for violating any of the By-laws, if such violation be of an aggravated character, or for repeated violation of the By-laws, or in any of the cases included in Section V.

SECTION VII.—Of the Library.

1. The Library shall be divided into two departments—one of books for reference, and the other of books for circulation, and shall consist of such books only as the Directors may approve of.
2. The Library shall be in charge of the Assistant-Secretary, under the control of the Board of Direction. He shall be in attendance to receive and deliver Books, at such hours as may from time to time be determined on by the Board of Direction.
3. No Member shall be entitled to draw a book from the Library, until he shall have paid all sums due by him to the Association, and made good all damages and losses that he may have occasioned.
4. Fourteen days shall be allowed for the perusal of any book taken from the Library.

5. Any Member who shall detain a book or pamphlet longer than the time above limited, shall forfeit and pay, to the Association, two cents for each day such book or pamphlet is so detained.

6. If any Member lose or injure a book, he shall make the same good to the Library; and if the book lost or injured be one of a set, he shall pay to the Association the full value of said complete set, and may thereupon receive the remaining volumes as his property.

7. No Member shall lend a book belonging to the Association, to any person out of the dwelling house or counting room of said Member, under a penalty of fifty cents for each offence.

8. Any Member may be allowed the perusal of a book in the Rooms of the Association; but such book must be at once resigned to any Member who may require it for perusal at home.

9. The books marked in the Catalogue with an asterisk (*), and such others as may from time to time be specially designated by the Board of Direction, shall not be taken from the Rooms, except by express permission of the Board.

10. No person, except Members of the Board of Direction, shall remove a book from its place in the Library, without the permission of the Assistant-Secretary.

SECTION VIII.—Of the Reading Room.

1. The Room shall be open every day (Sundays and holidays excepted) from 7 A.M. till 10 P.M., from 1st May till 1st November, and from 8 A.M. till 10 P.M. during the remaining six months.

2. No Newspaper, or other publication, shall be admitted into the Room unless sanctioned by the Board of Direction, or by a Committee entrusted by them with the necessary powers.

3. A list of all the Newspapers, Periodicals, new Books, Books of Reference, and other publications, shall always lie on the table in the Reading Room; also a Book in which Members may enter the title, time, and place of publication, together with the Publisher's name, and the price of any book or periodical which they desire to have added to the Library; and a book in which any suggestion or complaint in reference to the management of the Reading Room or Library may be entered.

4. No conversation shall be allowed in the Reading Room, otherwise than in a whisper; and no person shall be permitted to smoke in the Rooms.

5. Any person injuring any of the Periodicals or Papers placed in the Reading Room, shall be liable to a fine equal to double the cost thereof.

6. No Newspaper or any other publication shall on any account be removed from the Rooms, unless by the officers appointed to take charge of them.

7. Any Member may have the privilege of introducing a friend, *not resident in Montreal*, to the Reading Room, for the term of four weeks; and the names of all persons thus introduced shall be registered in a book provided for that purpose.
