A pageant of 20th century art done during the past year by Cleveland area artists and craftsmen opened at The Cleveland Museum of Art on May 16. Thousands viewed the opening of this 44TH MAY SHOW as they have done each year since 1919.

This year the Horace E. Potter Memorial Award for Excellence in Craftsmanship, the highest MAY SHOW citation in crafts, went to John Paul Miller, Cleveland.
