The object of this College is to bring a liberal Education within the reach of women engaged in various kinds of work during the day, by systematic teaching given in Evening Classes. It is also the aim of the College to promote social intercourse between teachers and students, and thus to afford opportunities for mutual help and fellowship amongst its members.

The College Teachers are all unpaid, and the Fees will be kept as low as possible.

A Library will be formed, and a room is set apart as a Coffee and Conversation Room.

All Students must be above 15 Years. No Class will be formed or carried on for less than Four Students.

The Drawing Class Room is open for practice every night in the week except Saturday.
