COMMUNICATION FROM SECRETARY OF TREASURY.

TREASURY DEPARTMENT, C. S. A, Richmond, December 31, 1863.

HIS EXCELLENCY, THE PRESIDENT:

Sir: I have the honor to enclose herewith an estimate of appropriation necessary for the payment of interest on the removal and subsistence fund due the Cherokee Indians in North Carolina, under the act of Congress approved May 1, 1863, and would respectfully request that you communicate the same to Congress.

ESTIMATE of appropriation required to pay the interest on the removal and subsisteme fund due the Cherokee Indians in North Carolina, under the act of Congress approved May 1, 1863.

The number of Indians in 1861, as per report of Commissioner of Indian Affairs, was 1512, which, at \$53 33 each, makes the fund - \$80,634 96
Interest upon this fund, at 6 per cent., for four years, from January 1, 1861, to January 1, 1864, inclusive, at \$4,838 09 per annum, - \$19,352 36
which tast sum is the amount required.
