Dear Friends:

I have pleasure in enclosing you herewith a statement showing by states the amounts received in cash and pledges for the seven Union Colleges for which the Campaign was made under the International Christmas drive, showing a total of \$147,240. in cash and \$72,215 in pledges.

Dealing now with the cash in hand that has been received undesignated as to college, we have a total of \$112,387.82 from which is to be deducted the amount of expenses to date, namely, \$7,218.25, leaving a balance for distribution of \$105,169.57.

Omitting Peking Medical, the askings for the six Union institutions amounted to \$2,840,000; Tokyo \$610,000, Ginling \$790,000, Yenching \$840,000, Madras \$200,000, Isabella Thoburn \$200,000, Vellore, \$200,000. In accordance with the resolutions adopted by the Joint Committee at its late meeting, I am paying this \$105,169.57 over to the treasurers of these six Union Colleges on the basis of 61/284 for Tokyo, 79/284 for Ginling, 84/284 for Yenching and 22/284 each for Madras, Isabella Thoburn and Vellore.
