Dear Dr. Brown:

The station has asked that Mr. Hunt be allowed to spend a month in Hawaii on his way home on furlough in order to investigate the situation there as it relates to the Christian Koreans who have gone there. I feel that we owe it to them to investigate as to their spiritual welfare and I am sure a month from Mr. Hunt given to that work will be as important a service as a month spent in looking after a Country Circuit here. We can get in communication with Rev. Frank Damon as suggested in your letter to me and I hope the way may open up for us to arrange to send a good Korean evangelist there to work among the Koreans under the direction, if need be, of the Congregational Church - or under the direction of the Korean Committee of Missions. If the Board will authorize Mr. Hunt to give a month to this work we shall await his report with great interest as will the whole Korean Church here which is interested in these Koreans who have gone from its midst.
