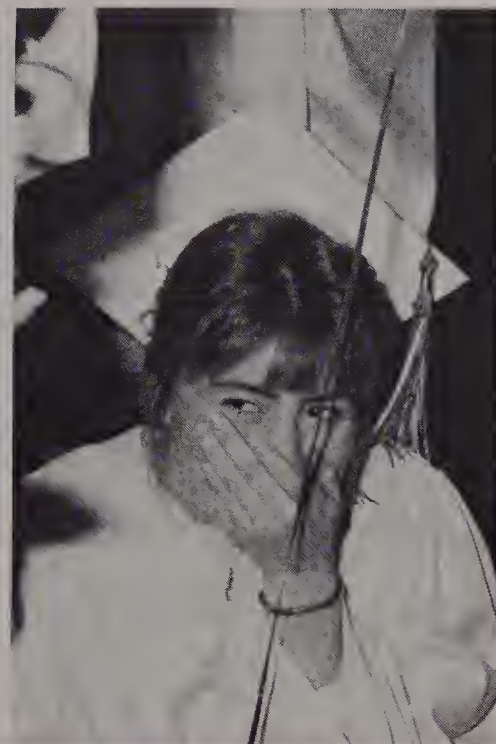
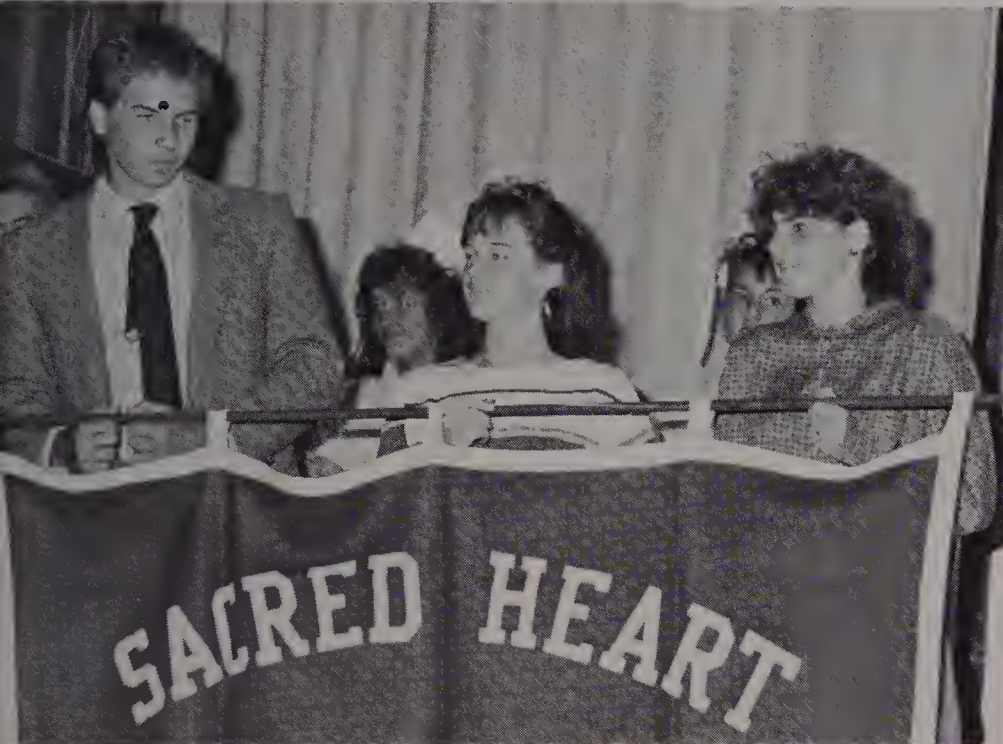
Awards Day - May 19, 1987 - a traditional assembly in the auditorium where the entire school views the senior slide presentation, the passing of colors, and students receiving their awards.
