Your letter OF 85/10/6 dated May 14th and our reply.

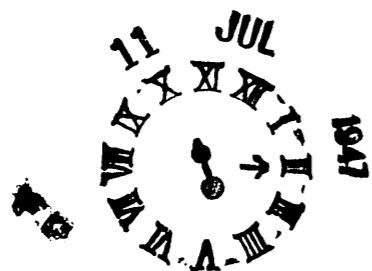
1. Estimated military expenditure in Palestine for calendar year 1947 is as follows:

- a) Army £21,000,000.
- b) R.A.F. £2,500,000.

The total estimated figure for these two services is therefore £23,500,000 (repeat £23,500,000).

2. The Royal Navy here are unable to estimate proportionate expenditure in Palestine and they inform us that all records are held by Admiralty.

3. From figure at paragraph 1 above the sum of £1,500,000 (repeat £1,500,000) should be deducted. This is estimated receipts which will accrue from disposal of surplus stores.
