Dear folm,

I enclose a copy of Prague telegram No. 871, reporting a proposal by Benedikt of the Orthodox Relief and Rescue Committee in Palestine, that a few immigration certificates should be issued to Jews in Poland.

- 2. As you will see, Benedikt proposes to come to the United Kingdom to discuss this idea, provided that we are willing to consider it. You will remember that the High Commissioner for Palestine, in his telegram No. 1051 of 9th October 1946, expressed a fairly favourable opinion of Benedikt. This was partly qualified by M.I.5's suspicions of his associate Hurwitz, who was believed to be connected with the illegal immigration organization.
- 3. I should be grateful for your urgent comments and for those of Scherr, to whom I am sending a copy of this letter, in order to enable me to draft a reply to Prague.

Dear Beite.

Would you please refer to your letter (E 7988/7988/31) of the 9th September concerning the proposal of Benedikt that a certain portion of immigration certificates into Palestine should be allotted to Poland.

You will perhaps already have seen the High Commissioner's telegram No. 1690, in which he gives his views on the assignment of a certain number of certificates to France. I understand that apart from the Cyprus and German quotas, the certificates are allocated on the principle of priority application, and we feel that the High Commissioner would be very reluctant to abandon this principle in favour of distribution on a territorial basis.

I suggest therefore that Mr. Benedikt is informed that it is not practicable to agree to his proposal, and it might perhaps be pointed out to him that Jews in Poland do already benefit from the allocation of certificates by the Government of Palestine to the close relatives in Europe of Palestinian citizens.

Your telegram No. 871 [of 20th August: Jewish legal immigration].

Certificates to enter Palestine, apart from quotas for Cyprus and Germany, are allotted on a priority basis for compassionate reasons and Palestine Government would be reluctant to substitute the principle of territorial distribution. Jews in Poland already benefit by the allocation of certificates to close relatives in Europe of Palestinian citizens.

2. We do not wish to have discussions with Benedikt on this subject. You may explain objections to his proposal as indicated above.
