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

Dear Mr. Talbot,

I refer to yesterday's telephone conversation regarding the transfer of real property in Palestine, and as mentioned I shall try to give you further details of the matter:

Upon the death of a Norwegian subject Mr. Aron Mendelsohn, who was killed in Auswitz, Germany, on the 4th of March, 1943, his legal heirs have agreed to transfer two plots of land in Palestine belonging to the deceased to one of his sons, Mr. Fillip Mendelsohn, who is at present living at Kfar Schmarjahu, Herzliah, Palestine. In spite of repeated efforts both by Mr. Fillip Mendelsohn and lately by the Norwegian Vice Consul in Tel Aviv it has not been possible to effectuate this transfer, as the Custodian of Enemy Property in Jerusalem has so far refused to release the property, which is regarded as being inherited from an "enemy". For your information I enclose copies of letter to the Norwegian Vice Consul in Tel Aviv from the Custodian of Enemy Property(Palestine), Jerusalem, dated the 13th of August, 1947, and from the Government of Palestine, Chief Secretary's Office, Jerusalem, dated the 11th

of September last.

28 NOV Thank you for your letter, E 10607/8619/31, of November 21 about the enquiry received from the Norwegian Legation about the transfer of property from Palestine. As in the United Kingdom the property in Palestine owned by Norwegians came under the control of the Custodian of Enemy Property as a result of the German occupation of Norway. The release of such property is now being effected in the United Kingdom as a result of an agreement between the Norwegian Government and HMG. This agreement contained a clause to the effect that Colonial Governments would have to make analogous The Palestine Government, arrangements. however, has asked for four modifications to the U.K. agreement in its application to their I understand that these suggested territory. modifications have been referred to the Norwegian Legation on October 10, 1947 and acknowledged by them. As yet, however, they have not indicated their approval of these modifications and all Norwegian assets in Palestine therefore remain under the control of the Custodian of Enemy Property until the Norwegian reaction to the proposals of the Palestine Government is We have no reason to doubt that ascertained. the property referred to in the enclosures to your letter will be released as soon as the

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



> In my letter No.E 10607/8619/31 of the 21st November about the transfer of real property in Palestine, I promised to let you have a more detailed reply as soon as we had heard from the Colonial Office.

2. As you are probably aware, Norwegian property in Palestine, like Norwegian property in the United Kingdom came under the control of the Custodian of Enemy Property when Norway was occupied by the Germans. The release of such property in the United Kingdom is now taking place in accordance with an agreement between His Majesty's Government and the Norwegian Government. Release of similar property in Palestine has been held up pending the negotiation of certain modifications to this agreement proposed by the Government of Palestine.

3. Now that the Colonial Office and the Norwegian Embassy have reached agreement on this question, subject to the views of the Government of Palestine, the release of Mr. Mendelsohn's property should not be long delayed. If you require any further information on this subject, perhaps you would be good enough to get in touch with the Colonial Officer (Commercial Relations and Supplies Department), with whom the Norwegian Embassy have hither to carried on direct negotiations on this question.
