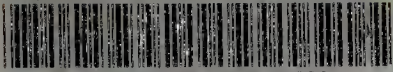

Detroit is next to a big lake called Lake St. Clair. ▷

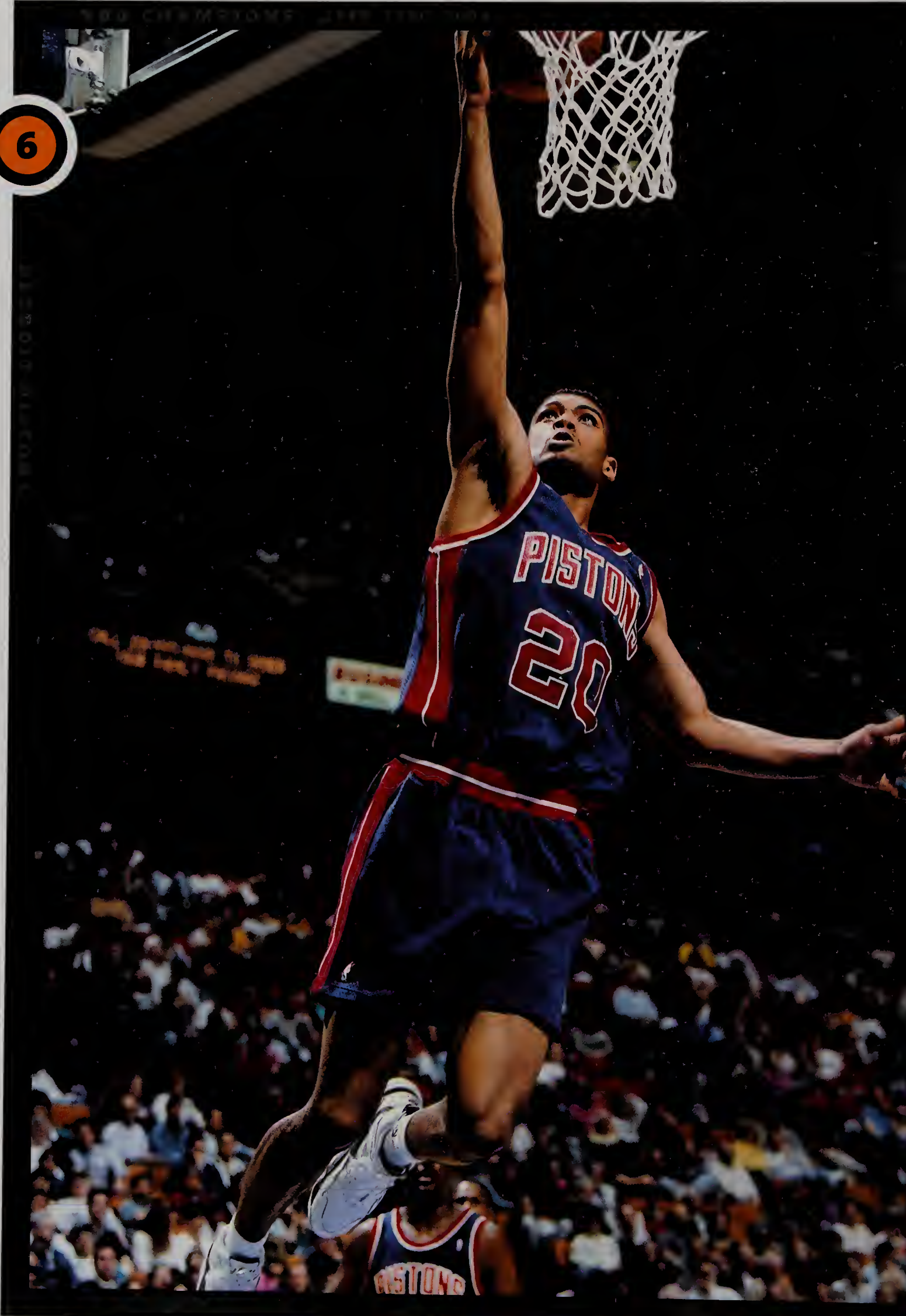

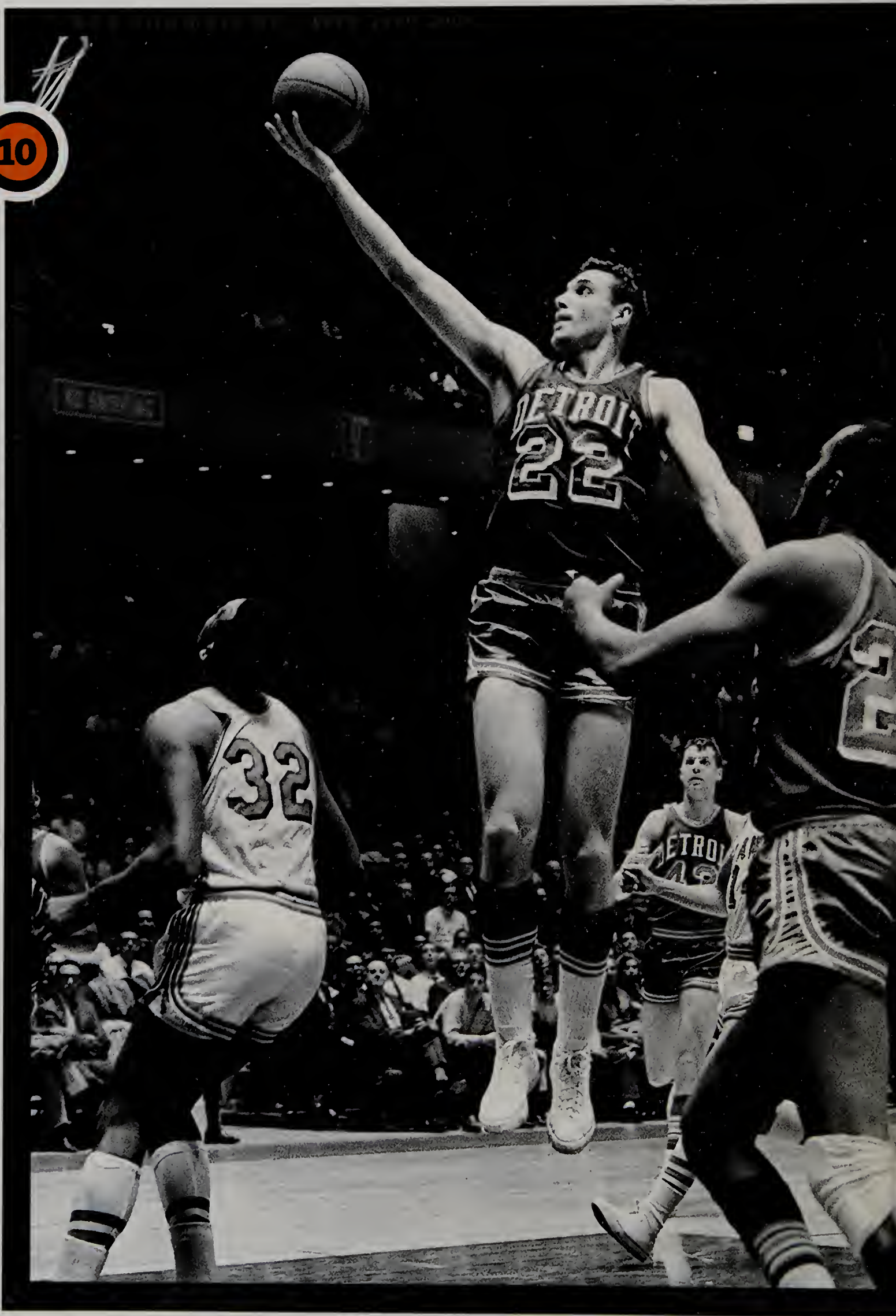
THE PISTONS' arena is called The Palace of Auburn Hills. Their uniforms are blue, red, and white. The Pistons play lots of games against teams called the Bucks, Bulls, Cavaliers, and Pacers.

◀ The Palace of Auburn Hills is almost 20 years old

THE PISTONS played their first season in 1941. They started out in a different town called Fort Wayne, Indiana. They played in Fort Wayne for 16 seasons. Then they moved to Detroit.

The Pistons moved to "The Motor City" in 1957 ▷





DAVE DEBUSSCHERE *(deh-BUSH-er)*

was one of the Pistons' first stars. He played guard and forward and always hustled and played tough defense. But the Pistons did not make the playoffs very often.

◀ Dave DeBusschere made lots of steals and baskets

CENTER Bob Lanier (*luh-NEER*) was another good player. He was so big that he needed size 22 shoes! He helped the Pistons win a lot of games. But they still could not win the NBA championship.

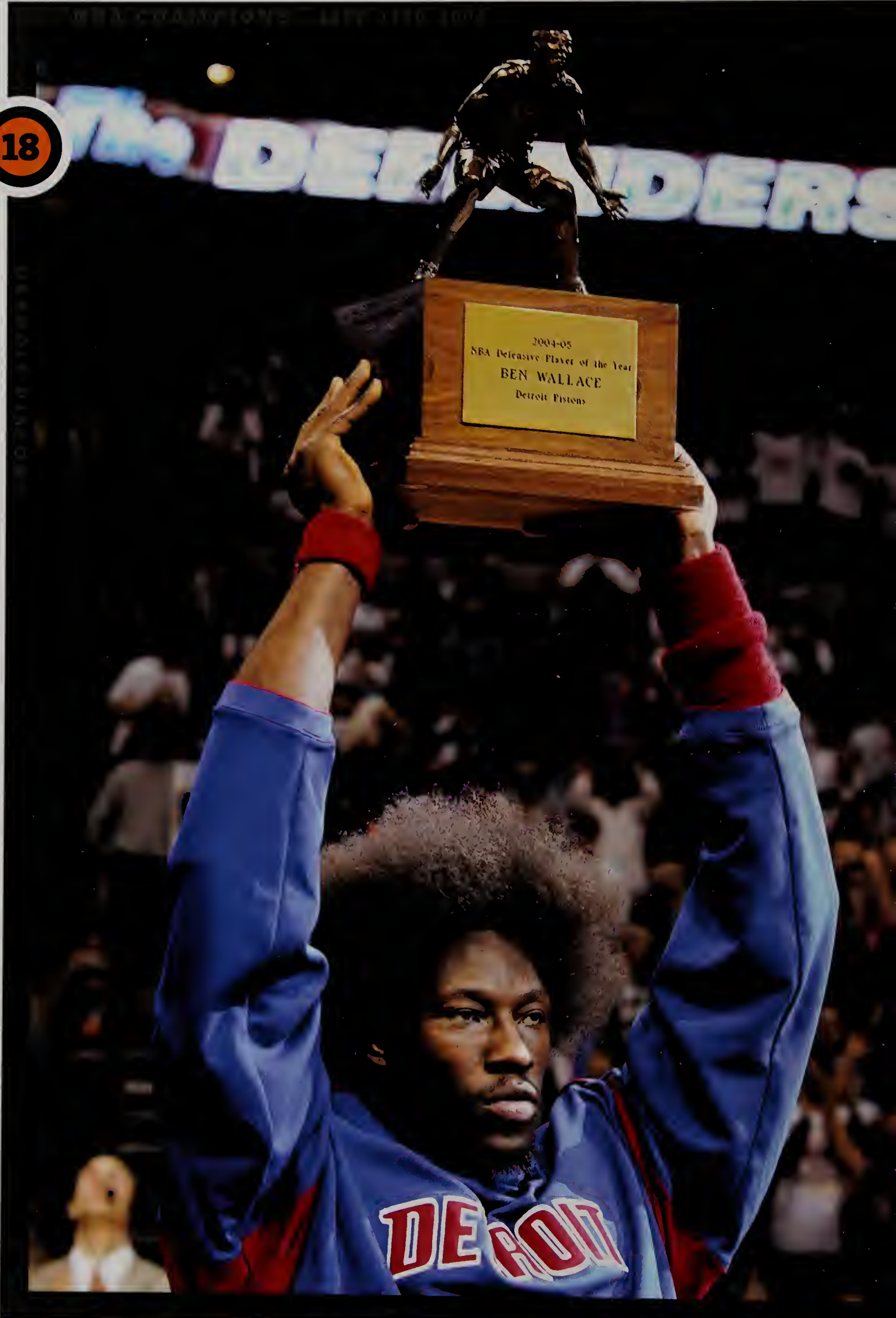
IN 1981, Detroit added point guard Isiah Thomas. He set a team **record** for assists (passes that let his teammates score). Forward Dennis Rodman was another star player. He helped Detroit play tight defense and get rebounds.

◀ Isiah Thomas was small, but he was smart and fast

IN 1989, the Pistons finally won their first NBA championship. They were so tough that fans called them the "Bad Boys." They won the championship again the next year, too!

THE PISTONS were not as great in the 1990s. But then they got some new players and became the NBA's best team again. Ben Wallace was a forward with big muscles. He helped Detroit win another NBA championship in 2004.

◀ Forward Ben Wallace's nickname was "Big Ben"

CHAUNCEY BILLUPS was another good Pistons player. He was a point guard who played tough defense and was a good leader. The Pistons have many new players today. Detroit fans hope that their team will win the NBA championship again soon!

GLOSSARY

ARENA a building with lots of seats where teams play basketball

NATIONAL BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION (NBA)

a group of basketball teams that play against each other; there are 30 teams in the NBA today

PLAYOFFS games that are played after the season to see which team is the best

PROFESSIONAL a person or team that gets paid to play or work

RECORD something that is the best (or most) ever

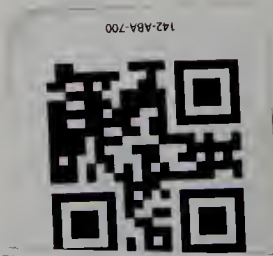
