Charles Quintard (1824-1898) was an Episcopal priest who, in spite of his pro-Union stance, volunteered to be a chaplain in the Confederate army in the American Civil War. A sympathetic, warm, intellectual man loved by soldier and civilian alike, he volunteered because he felt that the soldiers from his local area needed him more than his local parish. His election as bishop of Tennessee after the War was a major step toward healing wounds in the Church and in civil society. Bishop Quintard wrote this memoir in 1896.
