THE STORY OF K-9

"A dog is a man's best friend," the old saying goes. When Professor Marius was told that he couldn't take his pet hound aboard a space laboratory, he was most upset. But he didn't stay lonely for long. He built a computer, shaped like a dog, designed to help him in experiments, and keep him company. This was the origin of the lovable metallic animal known as K-9.

The Doctor first met K-9 in the adventure called "The Invisible Enemy." Professor Marius had been called to Earth, and on his return was told that, owing to weight problems on the ship which was to shuttle him back to his space lab, he would have to leave K-9 behind. The disappointed boffin entrusted his mechanical pet to the

Doctor and Leela. The Doctor's huntress companion was delighted at this, but the Time Lord was none too pleased at acquiring a metallic pet. Countless adventures involving malfunctioning computers and devilish robots had taught him never to trust a thinking machine, much less a contrary robot mutt!

K-9'S CONVERSATIONS WITH OTHER COMPUTERS

Nevertheless, he took K-9 aboard the TARDIS. To Leela's protests, however, he dismantled the robot, to check its circuits fully. It was probably the result of this tampering which caused K-9's later malfunctions—but the Doctor would hardly admit to this theory!

K-9 was no ordinary computer, as the Doctor soon realised. The dog had taken on characteristics of its master, and seemed to be able to think for itself. Very soon, it became clear that the Doctor was growing fond of his adopted pet, and K-9 proved a useful addition to the party of time-travellers.

One of K-9's most obvious talents was the ability to converse with other computer intelligences. For example, in the story, "The Invasion of Time", the robot dog actually *spoke* to the TARDIS itself! K-9 decided that the TARDIS was an extremely stupid machine, but was proved wrong in a later episode. In the adventure entitled **The Stones of Blood**, the TARDIS re-generated K-9's circuits, after one of

the monolith Ogrî had torn the dog to pieces.

On another occasion, K-9 spoke to the computer called Mentalis, last relic of the civilisation of Zeos. By this, K-9 was able to warn the Doctor and his friends, who were searching for the Key of Time, that Mentalis was about to self-destruct. In this way, K-9's unique powers proved an invaluable aid to his master. But the partnership between K-9 and the Doctor was soon to come to an end, in an unexpected fashion...

At the end of the story called, "The Invasion of Time," Leela decided to stay with the Gallifreyan soldier, Andred, with whom she had fallen in love. K-9 elected to stay with her, telling the Doctor that it was more logical that Leela needed the aid of a computerised guard dog on a strange planet, than the Time Lord needing his protection. Secretly, K-9 was interested in the vast wealth of knowledge accessible through the observation chambers of the Time Lords on Gallifrey.

THE PIRATE PARROT'S WRATH

Though the Doctor seemed surprised to lose K-9, he must have been expecting to part company at some stage. No sooner had the robot dog left, than the Doctor produced his own invention: K-9 Mark Two! This new model was basically the same design as the old K-9, but had greater mobility and was programmed not to be able to kill, but merely to stun, its enemies, unless ordered by the Doctor.

Perhaps the strangest robot with which K-9 had to battle, was Polyphase Avatron. This parrot-shaped menace was owned by the captain of the planet Zanak, half-robot himself. On his orders, the mechanical bird attacked the Doctor's party from the air, and it was only K-9's accurate firing which saved them all from the pirate parrot's wrath!

Despite obvious drawbacks in its

construction, K-9 has proved a constant companion of the Doctor since that time. However, the mechanical dog sometimes misses an adventure through breakdowns. For example, a speech circuit defect stopped K-9 from helping the Doctor in the epic battle with the Daleks. The marshy terrain also made it impossible for K-9 to operate against the Krolls. On occasions, it has been necessary for Romana to carry K-9 across rough ground to do battle against the Doctor's foes!

A TIME LORD'S BEST FRIEND

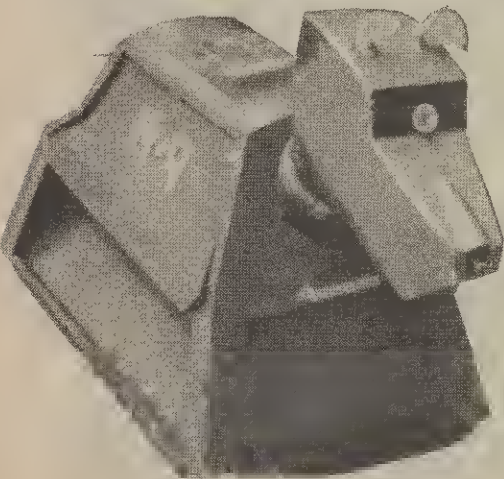
For years, the Doctor had been accompanied by at least one companion. That familiar pattern was altered with the addition of K-9 to his retinue. Together with the Time Lady Romana, K-9 seems set to help the

The Doctor (Tom Baker) with his trusty companion, K-9, and his time machine, the TARDIS, in the second episode of The Stones of Blood.

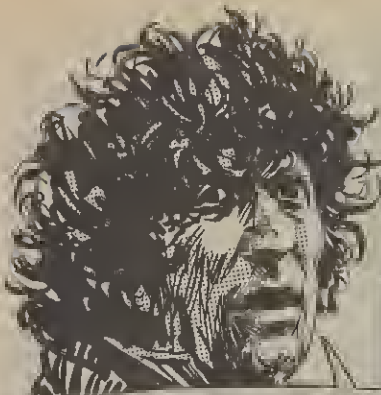


Doctor on his travels through Time and Space for a long time to come. From initially mistrusting the idea of a robot pet, the Doctor has come full circle in his thinking. If it's true that a dog is man's best friend, then a computerised canine is certainly a Gallifreyan's favourite pet too!

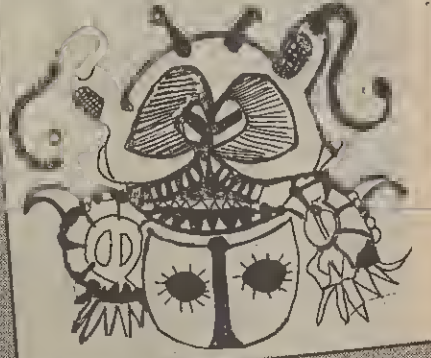

DOCTOR WHO STORY TEN

THE DALEK INVASION OF EARTH Part Two

The Daleks still hold twenty-first century Britain in their pitiless grasp, but, despite their worst efforts, there is still hope . . . We continue with the final half of this six part serial, first shown on BBC television on the 21st November, 1964.

David Campbell is carrying a pouch of Dortmun's bombs and he uses the acid detonator from one of them to defuse the Daleks' incendiary device, thus rendering it harmless. But with Daleks patrolling the streets, the young

resistance fighter decides that the best route for Susan, the Doctor and himself to take northward is underground – in the sewer network of tunnels. David warns her of possible dangers on the subterranean paths – wild animals and

scavengers!

Inside the Transport Museum, Barbara has managed to coax the engine of an old dust cart back to life. Together with Jenny she drives the vehicle through the streets of the

capital, now a blazing conflagration, and straight through a line of Daleks. Very soon they reach the open countryside but here a new danger threatens. The Daleks in London have sent a message to the mines, and now the flying saucer is hunting them. Jenny and Barbara only just have time to leap from the cab before a death ray zips downward from the ship and destroys the vehicle.

As night draws on, the two girls seek sanctuary in a forest cottage inhabited by two women. The forest dwellers make a living nowadays by mending clothes for the mine workers, and in return they are left in peace by the Daleks. Barbara and Jenny gratefully accept their offer of hospitality but discover too late that they have been led into a trap. During the night the Daleks come for them and the pair are taken away to begin work in the mine.

When the saucer landed earlier in Bedfordshire, Larry and Ian were able to make use of the ship's disposal chute system to escape. Now they have taken refuge in one of the work huts on the

fringe of the mining zone where they are befriended by one of the workers, a man named Wells. Larry has told Ian of his brother's presence at the mine and of his theory concerning the reason for the Dalek invasion of Earth. Intrigued, Ian is anxious now to penetrate the heart of the whole operation — the control building! Wells thinks he might be able to arrange this with the help of Ashton; an unscrupulous profiteer who preys on the miners — selling them escape in exchange for jewellery and other valuables.

THE DALEKS' MASTER PLAN

David, Susan and the Doctor have a stroke of luck. They meet up with Tyler, whose own search for survivors proved useless, and together the four head north.

With dawn only a few hours away, Ian is bargaining with Ashton inside the hut when a roar is heard outside. It is the Slyther, a "pet" brought to Earth by the Black Dalek to guard the mine zone at night. The Slyther has a voracious

appetite for human flesh and has sensed the people in the wooden hut. The creature bursts in and devours Ashton. Still hungry, it pursues Ian and Larry who finally evade it by leaping into a pit bucket from where they watch as the monster plunges to its death.

But the machinery is moving and the pair discover the bucket is being lowered into the mine.

They make a safe landing in one of the galleries, where they meet Wells again and attempt to conceal themselves among his work detail. But they are spotted by a suspicious Roboman who turns out to be Larry's brother. Larry tries vainly to break through the Dalek conditioning but it is too strong. Finally, in desperation, Larry is forced to kill his brother to allow Wells and Ian to escape, but dies in the effort.

The Doctor's party are likewise set upon by a group of Robomen but manage to come out best in the fight. Finally the team reaches the outskirts of the mine where the Doctor's mind begins to grasp the enormity of the

Dalek's plan. They are tunnelling for something deep within the planet's interior and by doing so they are daring to interfere in the very forces of Creation itself. They have to be stopped!

Barbara has reached the same conclusion, and in the hope of saving herself and Jenny, she offers the Daleks Dortmun's plans—supposedly giving details of a mythical global rebellion against the invaders. The two girls are taken before the Black Dalek in the control centre, where they overhear one of the Daleks announcing near completion of the project. They have now drilled to within four miles of the Earth's interior crust. An explosive device will be dropped down the completed shaft and the detonation of its warhead will allow the Daleks to remove the planet's core and substitute a drive system to pilot Earth to any point in the Universe. The Daleks are not planning to steal anything from the Earth at all—they are planning to steal the planet itself! The capsule containing the nuclear explosive is swung into position above the shaft. What nobody knows is that Ian Chesterton, in a bid to evade capture, has hidden himself inside the capsule and is now frantically endeavouring to get out.

Eventually the violent pitching of the capsule, caused by Ian's struggles, causes the Daleks to arrest the progress of the bomb and it is brought back to the surface where Ian is finally able to kick open an inspection hatch and escape. However, with Daleks rapidly converging on the bomb, the only escape route is downwards and once again the ex-schoolmaster finds himself trapped in the shaft...

A HEART RENDING DECISION

With the 'fault' now apparently rectified, the Black Dalek orders the human slave force to be herded into the lower galleries where they will die as the bomb explodes. The Daleks then turn their attention to Barbara, who begins telling them about the supposed mass-uprising by the remaining resistance organisations. While their interest is diverted, Jenny edges closer to the communications unit and issues a command for all Robomen to attack the Daleks. Although this order is quickly cancelled, it buys enough time for the Doctor, Susan, Tyler and David to steal into the compound. Instructing Susan and David to destroy the radio communication aerials with Dortmun's bombs, the Doctor and Tyler make their way towards the Control Centre.

While all this has been going on Ian has spent his time building a barrier across the shaft to stop the progress of

the bomb when it is eventually dropped.

The order to release the capsule is given, and the cylinder begins its descent into the abyss—only to be deflected by Ian's barrier into one of the upper galleries. Unaware of this, the Black Dalek orders all Daleks to board the flying saucer which will then hover over the mine to observe the results. Only the Dalek guards are left behind.

The Doctor and Tyler have made a surprisingly easy entry into the Dalek operations centre and are releasing Barbara and Jenny from their magnetic wall bonds when a Dalek sentry catches them. At that moment the destruction of the radio masts is achieved by David and Susan. Since



the Daleks communicate mainly by radio signals the sudden wrecking of the system immobilises the guarding Dalek. Now the slaves must be released. Using the back-up transmitters, the Doctor orders the Robomen into action against the Daleks and warns the slave workers to get clear of the area before the bomb explodes. Ian joins the group and together they join in with the headlong rush to escape the mine.

Clearing the zone they are just in time to witness a giant explosion which totally engulfs the hovering Dalek ship with the last of the invaders aboard. A small split opens in the Earth's crust and the Doctor points proudly down at the first volcano England has known for centuries.

The Dalek invasion of Earth is over and the remaining population can now embark on the mammoth task of rebuilding their shattered world, and that, in the Doctor's eyes, begins with the clearing of an iron girder away from a police box on the banks of the Thames.

This accomplished, the gateway to time and space is once more open to the Doctor, but first the old man must make a heart-rending decision. Ushering Ian and Barbara into the TARDIS, he closes and seals the doors, leaving Susan on the outside. As Susan panics and runs to the doors her grandfather uses the external speaker to talk with her for one final time. He explains that during her youth each of them thought they were looking after the other, but now Susan has clearly grown into a woman and as such should not spend time fussing after a dodderly old man. Her future is now with David Campbell, whom clearly she loves.

As the dematerialisation sequence begins, the Doctor voices the hope that he will be able to return one day and see the kind of world his granddaughter has helped to make. The ship fades to nothingness. Taking David's hand, Susan casts away her key to the TARDIS, knowing she will never again have use for it.

COMMENT

The final scene of this story showed the camera tracking in on the discarded key and, through its contours, the viewers saw a panorama of space. To this date Susan's farewell from the series remains one of the most touching scenes ever produced, and was a fitting end to the Doctor's re-match with the Daleks.

And let us not forget the Daleks, who had to undergo a major operation for this series. To enable the Dalek operators to move the machines over Earth's rough terrain, a special pedal-car device was fitted inside, covered by an enlarged fender section on the Daleks themselves.
