



HAMBURG BELLE'S VICTORY.

DEFEATS WHIMSICAL IN THRILLING CONTEST FOR THE BRIGHTON MILE.

Flip Flap, Added for an Outside Chance, Much of a Factor—Starter Dade Makes a Most Favorable Debut.

New York, July 11.—At the popular old Brighton track, so convenient, compact and democratic, the Brighton Beach Racing Association inaugurated its summer meeting of twenty-two days under the most promising auspices.

ROUGH RIDING MARS RACING AT LATONIA.

Funiculaire's Defeat Proves Costly to Heavy Bettors—Redgauntlet and Elastic Save the Day.

Cincinnati, O., July 11.—Some of the big speculators received a severe shock when Funiculaire and Lightning Conductor, both from T. P. Hayes' stable and short priced choices were beaten in their respective races at Latonia today.

Today's card was one of the fair quality and the attendance large, but the racing was marred by poor starting and rough riding. Favorites and well backed horses, however, won a majority of the races, so that the crowd did well in a betting way.

It was decided today to institute one day drawings for bookmakers instead of the three-day cut in as heretofore and sixteen accepted positions in the big ring, the same number that went on at the last previous drawing.

Chocolate Drop, which was badly cut down in her previous start, was to be destroyed today. Blood poisoning had set in. Because of Fialto's fractious acting her entry will in future not be accepted here.

INTERESTING RACING AT FORT ERIE.
