Cincinnati, O., July 11.—Some of the big speculators received a severe shock when Funiculaire and Lightning Conductor, both from T. P. He trailed his company to the stretch where he managed to save a lot of ground but succumbed to Colonel Jim Douglas, which came with a great rush in the final strides. The race was not truly run.
