FARCICAL STEEPLECHASE RACE AT LATONIA.

Four of the Six Starters Leave the Course and Jim Bozeman Has It Easy.

Cincinnati, O., August 3.—The steeplechase over the short course, which was the spectacular feature of a good card at Latonia this afternoon, resulted of a good card at Latonia this afternoon, resulted in the most disappointing contest of the season and came in for a good deal of adverse criticism from spectators. An even half dozen faced the starter with Subador the natural favorite on past performances. However, the market quickly became active on others besides the logical choice. Byrne of Roscrea and Jim Bozeman were most in demand. The former was considered a good thing by his owner, J. S. Bratton, who came here from St. Louis to wager heavily on his candidate. Jim Bozeman was pounded down several figures from his high price. After a short delay at the post occasioned by the actions of Jim Bozeman, they were dispatched to a fair start with Jim Bozeman showing the way and the others closely grouped until the third obstacle was reached. Here a slight dip occurs. Jim Bozeman made the dip successfully and jumped the obstacle in faultless style, but the and jumped the obstacle in lattices skyr, out he others with the exception of Ohio King, went around the wing. This left the contest a farce. Jim Bozeman had little opposition from the badly ridden Ohio King and won as his rider pleased. The others, with the exception of Byrne of Roscrea, regained the course and came home many seconds after the first two had crossed the finish. Subador, proving best, secured third place.

The rider of Byrne of Roscrea acknowledged that he had carried the others out, but explained that he was unable to keep the horse in the course. His statement was accepted and it was corroborated by a number of horsemen who added that "Bratton had not cooled out long after the last race as a result of the big bet he made on the horse." To-day's mishap will probably cause a change to be

made in the steeplechase course.

REACH AGREEMENT AS TO KENTUCKY DATES.

Schedule Is Arranged in New York Subject to Approval of State Racing Commission.

If the Kentucky State Racing Commission ratifles the action of the track owners, and it probably will, the question of dates for the remainder of the seaon at Latonia and Louisville is settled. Joseph L son at Latonia and Louisville is settled, Joseph L. Rhinock, representing the Latonia Jockey Club, Matt J. Winn, representing the New Louisville Jockey Club, which controls Churchill Downs, and Louis A. Cella, the principal owner of the Douglas Park track, met at the Imperial Hotel, New York, Thursday evening and, after a long conference, announced that they have agreed upon the following arrangement of dates, subject to the approval of the Kentucky State

The present meeting at Latonia to close on Satur-

day, September 1.

Douglas Park to open on Monday, September 3 and continue to Saturday, September 15.

and continue to Saturday, September 15.

The Kentucky State Fair to open at Churchill
Downs Monday, September 17 and continue until
Saturday, September 22. There will be some running races for small purses during the fair.

Douglas Park to open Monday, September 24 and

Douglas Park to open Monday, September 24 and continue to Saturday, September 29, Churchill Downs to open Monday, October 1 and continue to Saturday, October 20. Latonia to open on Monday, October 22 and con-tinue to Saturday, November 17.

This arrangement will add eighteen days to the present meeting at Latonia, which was scheduled to close August 11. It will give Douglas Park and

close August 11. It will give Douglas Fark and Churchill Downs eighteen days each and will give Latonia twenty-four days for its fall meeting. Between the closing of the fall meeting at La-tonia and the opening of the winter racing season in New Orleans, which will be at the Crescent City Jockey Club's track on November 24, there are five days. It is not improbable that these dates will be occupied by Lexington. Secretary W. C. Scott has said that the Kentucky Racing Association would give a fall meeting of five or six days if a suitable schedule could be arranged.

Cincinnati, O., August 3.-The announcement that an understanding had been reached on the date ques-tion was well received by the horsemen at Latonia. Many, however, would have preferred the meeting here to continue and that a fall meeting be dispensed with. It would have effected a saving in shipping

openses to and from Louisville.

John Hachmeister says he will shortly go to Louis ville and assume active duties at Douglas Park, "We may give some stakes, but this has not been officially decided on yet," said he. "Our officials will be submitted to the Western Jockey Club for approval at its meeting Monday."
