## MARY DAVIS' AMSTERDAM

DAUGHTER OF WATERCRESS — COLONIAL SCORES IN SARATOGA FEATURE.

Change of Riding Tactics Proves Efficacious in Case of Martinez and He Wins with Ease—Temperature Falls at Spa.

Saratoga, N. Y., August 26.—It was an off day with the Saratoga Association, the only feature down for decision being the Amsterdam, a selling affair at a mile. Though there were fourteen carded for the race only four went to the post, and Mary Davis, ridden by apprentice Estep, was an easy winner over S. C. Hildreth's Restigouche, the only one of the quartet that offered anything approaching a contest.

A decided drop in the temperature came as a relief from the recent hot spell and wraps were not altogether out of place. The attendance was excellent considering the sport offered, and there was no lack of enthusiasm even if class was wanting in some of the fields.

What should have been one of the best races of the day was marred by the leaving of George Odum's Folie Levy at the post. It was a six-furlongs selling affair and the daughter of Golden Maxim and Ridicule was a legitimate favorite. She had one of the erratic spells that made her so uncertain at Yonkers and when the field left she propped and jockey Knapp was unable to chase her after her opponents. After the race she was barred from starting again, which action was taken by the Empire City Racing Association after she had been guilty of a similar offense at Yonkers.

The mile handicap was really the best race of the afternoon and it went to Martinez, from the stable of Harry La Montagne. The running demonstrated that jockey S. Davis had brought about the defeat of the colt in the Huron Handicap by racing him in front. Today he trailed almost to the stretch and when he made his move, Martinez quickly raced around on the outside and came home a winner with great ease by four lengths over Hildreth's Frostone, Shannan and Frostone, who pacemakers, but they were both so used up when Martinez made his move that it was no contest through the last furlong.

Mary Davis won her race rather handily and she, like Martinez, avoided the early pace. Restigouche was rated along in front by Shilling in the early stages and he looked the winner at the head of the stretch, but when Mary Davis challenged at the last furlong post, he could not keep step with her and faltered badly under a drive.

Stinger was winner of the opening handicap for two-year-olds. In this race Heatherbroom started for the first time under the silks of Capt. E. B. Cassatt. She was beaten, but her race suggested that no mistake was made when \$1,000 was paid for her at the recent sale of the stable of James R. Keene. Dugan, who rode her, was slow to have her away and she did not begin to run freely until the stretch was reached. There she closed a big gap to finish third to Gauntlet and Stinger.

Kormak was winner of the seven-furlongs dash for selling plater two-year-olds, and at the end of the program Baron Dieskau beat some maidens easily at a mile. In this race the disappointment was Bishop, John E. Madden's starter. He has been racing with better horses and among maidens. It was supposed that he would give a good account of himself. He was never able to keep up with the pace and failed to finish in the money, such cheap ones as Frances Ray and M. Cambon beating him for second and third.

Clifford B. Harmon is negotiating with the Saratoga Association for the use of its course for an aeronautical meeting to be held by the Aero Club of America during its convention week, which begins September 27.

Jockeys Estep and King were suspended for the meeting for misbehavior at the post.

## FITZ HERBERT HURTS A FOOT.

Saratoga, N. Y., August 26.—S. C. Hildreth announced yesterday that he would not start Fitz Herbert in the Saratoga Cup Saturday. Fitz Herbert bruised a foot the other day when he worked half a mile through the stretch between races and Mr. Hildreth has let up on him. It is possible, Mr. Hildreth says, that V. Vivian Gooch, the English sportsman who purchased Dalmatian for Louis Winans, may also buy Fitz Herbert. Mr. Gooch came near buying Fitz Herbert the other day. The marks of a firing iron on one of his ankles were all that deterred him. Mr. Gooch did not understand those scars. Fitz Herbert has been lame twice since Mr. Hildreth took him in charge in 1908. He hurt himself just before the running of the Futurity which fell to Maskette, and had to remain in the stable, and he bruised a foot the other day. But Mr. Hildreth did not have Fitz fired. The stars Mr. Gooch saw the other day date back to the time Fitz Herbert was a yearling. Jack Joyner had him fired because one of his ankles was weak.

Fitz Herbert has proven one of the hardest campaigners that ever raced on this side of the Atlantic. He has packed all kinds of weight and beaten first-class horses at all distances. Mr. Gooch concedes that a horse of his size, conformation, sweet disposition and ability to run swiftly and far would be invaluable in cup races in Great Britain. If Mr. Gooch does not purchase Fitz Herbert, Mr. Hildreth will prepare him for the \$10,000 Dominion Handicap, to be run at Fort Erie in October. If Fitz Herbert comes safely out of the Dominion Handicap, it is likely that Mr. Hildreth will train him for the Bowie Cup. The Bowie is a two-mile race, run at Pinhook in the fall. Fitz Herbert won last year's Bowie in 3:25, the best time on record in this country for two miles.

Montreal, Que., August 26.—For the benefit of horsemen who have not secured stabling accommodations at Blue Bonnets track for the fall meeting of the Montreal Jockey Club, the committee which is making the allotment of stalls this week will send out notices to those to whom they have given stalls. There are less than 700 stalls at Blue Bonnets and already the applications total over 800. Some will have to be turned down and due notification will be sent out within a few days. This will save horsemen who intended shipping to Montreal on a chance the long trip for nothing. Blue Bonnets is not situated like some of the other Canadian tracks and no outside stabling is available for the meeting. This is the first time in the four years' history of the club that the stabling at the course has not been sufficient, the crowding being due to the increase in the number of horses coming from Saratoga and New York.

## JAMES R. KEENE IS OPTIMISTIC.

Considers American Racing in More Promising Condition Than It Was One Year Ago.

Saratoga, N. Y., August 26.—Besides Ballot, Maskette and Iron Mask, which were reserved when the rest of his horses in training were disposed of this week, James R. Keene will next season race a stable of some twenty-five two-year-olds. These youngsters are now at Castleton Stud. They are sons and daughters of Disguise, Voter, Ben Brush, Kingston and Hippodrome. Major Foxhall Daingerfield will ship them to New York some time in September or October, and then they will be broken in Sheepshed Bay under the eye of trainer James Rowe. Mr. Keene has not the least fear for the future of racing, and he said as much yesterday. "Racing," Mr. Keene declared, "is in a more promising condition than it was a year ago. The laws passed last winter at Albany were drastic, to be sure, but they were obviously unfair, and I have a notion that the courts will turn them down. I do not believe that the sentiment of the people of the state is with such laws. Racing is a popular institution, and behind it is the great breeding industry of which the people of the state are beginning to take notice."

"I am convinced that we will have a change of administration next fall and it will be possible to secure a modification of the Hughes laws that will enable us to race as we used to."

"Many valuable thoroughbreds the country could ill afford to lose have been shipped from American shores as result of the crusade against racing in this and other states, but there will be plenty to fill stakes and compete for purses in 1911. Notwithstanding the hard knocks the sport has had, the racing here at Saratoga has been first-class and it has been fully supported."

Mr. Keene recently shipped a bunch of horses to the Argentine Republic under the charge of John S. McDonald, but he did not send away his best yearlings. The star youngsters of last season's Castleton foals were left in Kentucky. They will bear the spotted jacket of the vice-chairman of the Jockey Club next summer in races like the United States Grand Union, Futurity, Great Trial and Great American.

Mr. Keene is undecided whether to retire Ballot or to order him in training again. Ballot was injured in the running of the Saratoga Handicap, and he had an ugly-looking leg until a few days ago, but he is going soundly again and Mr. Rowe says it will be possible to train him again this year. Mr. Rowe is confident the chestnut will stand up next season. Ballot has been racing the better part of five years now, and he was never lame until he was injured before the start of the Saratoga Handicap. Ballot is destined for the place of Voter, his son at Castleton Farm. Mr. Keene considers that Voter outran himself when he got Ballot. The son can spring as swiftly under weight as his sire used to do, but certainly not as well as his sire used to do, because Voter could not do. Ballot has made several track records at such distances as one mile and three-sixteenths, one mile and five-sixteenths and one mile and a quarter. One mile was as far as Voter cared to go in first-class company, and he preferred seven furlongs to a mile. Such a horse as Voter is considered well worthy of preference at Castleton.

**MANY ENTRIES FOR LOUISVILLE STAKES.**

Louisville, Ky., August 26.—Every mail is bringing heavy batches of entries for the ten stakes to be run at the coming fall meeting of the New Louisville Jockey Club. The entries for these stakes will close August 31. Secretary Davis, in all his letters, gets words of cheer from out-of-town horsemen, who are unanimous in the hope and opinion that the meeting which begins here October 1 will be an unparalleled success.

Trainer W. C. Westmoreland left tonight for Windsor. He has an engagement to meet F. J. Pons there and will return to his training stable at Douglas Park next Friday. While at Windsor he will arrange for the shipping here of eight horses owned by Mr. Pons which have been racing in Canada this summer. They are Abrasion, Louis des Coquilles, Bill Bowles, Dolly Buttman, Roseboro, Lady Ornament, Tony Parker and Rockcastle, the latter two being recent purchases. Rockcastle is a half-brother to Carthage and is by Dick Welles. He was trained as a three-year-old by J. B. Respess, who regarded him as a Derby possibility at that age.

Trainer Westmoreland let Ed McCloskey have the services of jockey Willie Brannon to ride Sandy Hill at the Scottsburg, Ind., fair this week. Yesterday Brannon won a five and one-half furlongs heat race with the gelding and he expects to land the Scottsburg Derby at a mile and an eighth. It is noted that every horse that has gone to the fair races from Douglas Park this summer has come back a winner.

The only arrival here today was Dr. W. H. Holgrave, who came from Latonia with a string of four, headed by Pin Oak. Dr. Talbot this morning fired Oriflamb for a weak tendon. He will be thrown out of training for some time on account of the operation, but his owner hopes to get him ready for winter racing.

**GOSSIP FROM THE BLUE GRASS REGION.**

Lexington, Ky., August 26.—Work has begun on the extension of the betting shed at the Kentucky Association track and when the races begin on September 19 turfmen will hardly recognize the old structure in which the betting has heretofore taken place.

The shed itself will be much larger and roomier, permitting the installation of more pari-mutuel machinery, while the room used as a clearing-house will be bigger and better than ever. This room will be located much closer to the fence separating the paddock from the promenade which stretches from the grandstand alongside the betting shed to the paddock gate. This improvement is one of the biggest yet undertaken by the association and is in line with a number of changes in view.

John McLaughlin, one of the best-known pool-sellers in America, has arrived home from West Baden, where he has been for two weeks. Mr. McLaughlin will handle the auction pools on all the Kentucky tracks this fall and with the easterners here probably will be a busy man.

## JOHN MADDEN AS A HORSE TRADER.

The purchase of S. C. Hildreth's three-year-old distination by Louis Winans of London for \$40,000, or perhaps more, throws more light upon the important figure cut by John E. Madden in the making of horse trades. Mr. Winans, an American, born in Baltimore, is a wealthy sportsman who became identified with the trotters years ago and incidentally purchased Silko from Madden for \$30,000. Being interested in the runners in England, where he has lived for some time, Mr. Winans two years ago purchased Sir Martin and Edward from Madden, and according to the latter, he paid \$75,000 and \$5,000 respectively for these colts.

Sir Martin was a crack two-year-old in this country before he sailed for the other side, where he was made favorite for the Derby won by the late King Edward's Man. Sir Martin fell, it will be recalled, while running in a prominent position in that event. But in other British turf fixtures Sir Martin proved his quality, so that when he broke down recently, as currently reported by cable, Mr. Winans turned to Madden again for another good horse.

Madden's close relations on the American turf with Hildreth have been a subject for much comment and for that reason it is assumed that the former sounded the praises of Dalmatian to the owner of Sir Martin, with the result that the Ethelbert three-year-old was bought for a princely sum and will race on the English tracks next year. Madden therefore has done Hildreth a good turn, which is not at all strange in view of the way Hildreth has been buying Madden horses. While many turfmen have persistently argued that Madden only leased the running qualities of these thoroughbreds to Hildreth, both parties to the transactions have stated that the sales were bona fide. They denied the report that the ownership of Fitz Herbert was jiggled last spring when that famous horse was reported sold to Madden by Hildreth for \$40,000 and within two months was handed back to Hildreth for \$8,000.

Madden has frequently stated with emphasis that he has sold King James, Joe Madden, Fayette, Dahlia, Hampton Court and Novelty to Hildreth outright and that he did not retain an interest in any of them. Taking Madden at his word, therefore, it must be admitted that he received the short end of some of these transactions, as King James, Joe Madden and Novelty have won stakes and purses many times in excess of their purchase prices. Two years ago King James and Joe Madden were turned over to Hildreth for \$12,000 and \$10,000 respectively, it was said. Last year alone King James earned \$38,253, while Joe Madden's winnings amounted to \$44,905. This year King James has earned \$11,450 more, but Joe Madden has done nothing. In the case of Novelty, Madden sold him early last spring for \$6,000 to Hildreth, who then interests in the Kingston colt has risen to \$30, so far and has a sterling chance to capture more than \$25,000 in the future.

Figuring it therefore it appears that Hildreth in return for a trifore more than \$25,000 paid to Madden for King James, Joe Madden and Novelty has cleaned up \$125,000 in round numbers, which would seem to indicate that Madden was a trifle hasty in parting with these thoroughbreds.

Hildreth did not obtain Dalmatian from Madden, however. He bought him for \$400 as a yearling when Perry Belmont put the colt on the market, and since the beginning of Dalmatian's racing career, Hildreth has earned \$21,500, of which \$5,305 was gathered last year. Backed by Madden's recommendation, therefore, Hildreth has been enabled to sell Dalmatian for big money and incidentally swell his bank account for the year. It is worthy of note that while Hildreth's horses have won more than \$100,000 for him this year on the New York tracks, Madden in his own country has won less than \$2,000, his horses winning four stakes, eleven seconds and nine thirds. But Madden has had the satisfaction of seeing the two-year-olds, Naushon, Onager, Amahl and others sold by him as yearlings to R. T. Wilson, Jr., win good races. Madden received \$30,000 for a batch of yearlings including those youngsters and \$30,000 more for another lot a few weeks ago, so that it cannot be said that the turf here no longer has attractions for him.—New York Sun.

## NOTES OF THE TURF.

Live Wire has been added to the schooling list at Saratoga.

The suspension of jockey Battiste was raised yesterday by the judges at Butte.

W. G. Yankee will ship a dozen horses from Kentucky to Oklahoma for winter racing.

George A. Saportas, owner of the Bonnie Brook Stable, will sail for France September 13.

John J. Hyland has changed his plans to race in Canada this fall and will instead ship his horses to Sheephead Bay during the first week of September.

The three-year-old filly, Infatuation, and the two-year-old filly, Cow, sold at the Keene weeding-out sale, will be handled by the veteran trainer, S. W. Street.

John Powers will race Chapultepec, Indian Maid, Nethermost and Dominus Arvi in Canada. The horses will be shipped north after the end of the Saratoga meeting.

Trainer Nat Beyer will ship five horses to Montreal on September 2 and at the conclusion of Canadian racing Mr. Carman will race a stable of goodly proportions at Philadelph.

Tommy Burns, who purchased Glucose at the sale of the Newcastle Stable, has arranged to race at the Louisville meeting. It was Tommy's intention to take out a jockey license at Saratoga. Instead, he will apply for a trainer's license in Kentucky and race at one of the southern courses the coming winter.

Lawrence &amp; Comstock, who race under the name of the Oakwood Stock Ranch, will race a big string at Oakland the coming season. They plan to occupy more than one stable, which has about twenty-five stalls. There are a number of yearlings which trainer Maxwell will prepare for the races of 1911. Roy Hindoo will be among the horses to carry the colors of the stable.

The steeplechase horses of Joseph E. Davis, in charge of trainer Matthew Brady, will be shipped to Brooklyn, L. I., at the end of the Saratoga meeting. Mr. Davis takes especial interest in cross-country racing and maintains a stable of hunters at his Long Island establishment. Elaborate plans are under way for hunt meetings at Westbury and in the adjoining territory during the fall.

John Madden offered J. R. Wainwright \$2,000 for Trance before she was shipped to Louisville from Saratoga with the rest of the Wainwright horses, with the proviso that Mr. Wainwright might race her in Kentucky and send her to Hamburg Place after the Kentucky season closes. Mr. Wainwright is counting on becoming a breeder himself and for that reason turned down the Madden offer.
