## PROGRESS IN CALIFORNIA

PETITION FOR LAW PROVIDING FOR RACING COMMISSION NUMEROUSLY SIGNED.

Names of 7,300 Electors Attached to Request for Initiative Vote Filed with San Fran-

cisco Election Board.

San Francisco, Cal., July 23.—An initiative petition for an act to prohibit bookmaking and poolselling on horse races in California and to provide for the appointment of a state racing commission, and to permit wagering on the races by the parimutual and auction pool systems only, \* has been filed with Registrar J. H. Zemansky.

The petition has been circulated through the state for the last few weeks, and it is said by the circulators that the necessary 36,000 signatures to carry the measure before the general primaries will be secured with ease. The petition containing the names of electors of the country of San Francisco contains 7,300 names.

As stated in a preamble to the petition, the purpose of the proposed amendment to the statutes is to promote horse breeding and turf contests, and to place the latter on a higher scale. The racing commission, under the tentative law, would be composed of five persons, all of whom must have been actively connected with breeding and racing of horses for a period of five years.

Violation of the law incurs a penalty of imprisonment for a period of one year or a minimum sentence of thirty days. An infraction of the proposed statute consists of making wagers on a horse race contary to the law, or of holding a race meeting with out the sanction of the racing commission. The commissioners, according to the amendment which may be put up to popular vote, are to be appointed by the governor of the state and are to serve for a term of five years.

## YOUNG THOROUGHBREDS AT BROOKDALE.

Thirty-eight Yearlings and Thirty Weanlings Among Choice Stock at H. P. Whitney's Breeding Farm.

New York, July 23.—There are still a dozen two-year-olds at Harry Payne Whitney's famous thoroughbred nursery, Brookdale Farm, in New Jersey. All are in training, Jockey Joe Notter has been made foreman of the establishment by Manager James Rowe and he has been keeping himself close to riding condition by breaking the yearlings and riding the two-year-olds, He knows every foal on the place and has proven himself much more than only one of the best jockeys of recent years.

One of the two-year-olds is Balled, a sister to Baliot, one of the stars of the James R. Keene string a few seasons back, by Voter—Cerito. She will doubtless be retained for the stud. Another is the filly Wonder, a half-sister to Novelty, winner of the last Futurity and now in Charles Kohler's French string, where he is intended for steeplechasten. The others are all bred in the purple, and as ten of the twelve are fillies they will undoubtedly become broodmares of importance.

Most of the interest at this time at Brookdale centers in the yearlings. There are thirty-eight of them, ten being colts, ten geldings and eighteen fillies.

He is as sensible as a three-year-old even now and has a way of moving that suggests great speed.

A chestnut son of Hamburg and Black Venus in a great measure resembles his dam in conformation, and he is one that can be picked apart and found flawless. No youngster at the farm has been more liberally entered in the English stakes, and should he race to his looks he will be a worthy American representative.

An unsexed son of Broomstick and Heart's Desire is a young racer of excellent size and conformation. He is of a decidedly racy build and has all the marks of one that ought to come to hand early.

A mating of Broomstick with Tanya, daughter of Meddler and Handspun, should produce a thoroughbred worth while, and the bay son of this cross looks the part. He has a particularly good head and neck, splendid shoulders and an abundance of heart space. His quarters are powerfully made, and right now of a size to suggest a four-year-old.

## RECORD IS TWICE BEATEN

WOLFERTON AND MANASSEH RUN MILE AND TWENTY YARDS AT LAGOON IN 1:41%.

Former Reduces Old Mark of 1:42% and Manasseh Equals New Mark in Winning Derby Trial-Several Horses Change Hands.

Salt Lake City, Utah, July 23.—Wolferton, in winning the third race at Lagoon today, reduced the track record for one mile and twenty yards to 1:41%. The record had previously stood at 1:42%. In the succeeding race, an allowance affair for three-year-olds, Manasseh equaled the record just made by Wolferton.

Wolverton was badly outpaced in the early part of his race, but when straightened out in the stretch he rapidly overtook and passed the leaders, to win drawing away.

The race won by Manasseh was in the nature of a Derby trial and brought out five contestants, Starter Morrissey sent them away to an excellent break. Henderson & Hogan had two entries to represent them in Guaranola and Gockspur, and they ruled first choice. Both ran disappointingly, and brought up the rear. Manasseh, favored by a light impost, outran her opposition from the start. Vanir, making his first appearance since he won the Coeur d'Alene Derby, ran a creditable race and so did Lady Rankin.

Madeline Musgrave, winner of the closing dash, was bid up from \$300 to \$800 by Miller Henderson and became the property of Henderson & Hogan.

The list of winning owners under Jockey Club rules is naturally headed by M. Achille Fould, whose total has been brought up to the large sum of \$92,815 by the victory of Houli in the Grand Prix de Paris. In the published statistics Baron Edouard de Rothschild comes second with \$60,120, thanks principally to the victories of Floralson, but the success of De Viris in the Prix du President de la Republique on Sunday at Maisons Laffitte will give a big lift to Baron Gourgaud, whose total now reaches \$74,325, entitling him to second place. Other owners who have done well this season are Prince Murat, \$41,710; W. K. Vanderblit, \$39,000; August Belmont, \$34,200; Edmond Blanc, \$34,120; H. B. Duryea, \$29,970; A. Veil-Picard, \$28,670; A. Aumont, \$26,945; L. Olry-Roederer, \$25,800, and L. de Romanet, \$25,250. There are fifty other owners who have won between \$25,000 and \$5,000. while there are another fifty entitled to mention on the role of honor, among them being J. D. Cohn. \$5,165.
