## HORSES THAT WON NEARLY \$30,000 FOR R. T. WILSON THIS YEAR

R. T. Wilson's horses did not run in 1912 to that measure of success which all would wish for such a tried and true upholder of American racing. His stable was extensive and expensive. Returns from racing probably sufficed to pay ordinary expenses, but the lack of at least one high-class stake winner prevented more than that much accumulation in stable earnings. Had Olambala retained his four-year-old speed it would have made a great difference. But he did not and none of the younger horses raced up to more than the form of the useful class. Of these Tartar showed best and may prove a good three-year-old in 1913. So may Genesta, the progeny of Broomstick seeming, as a rule, to train on and improve. Flying Yankee did vell for his stable and so did the veteran, Beaucoup, but Penobscot was a disappolatment, although he won races. He stands with his feet well under him, and his under-pinning suggests strength and agility. A black colt that has been named Ardington is another that is expected to be well worth while. He is a son of Ellisdale and Debater and in many respects resembles his sire. He has a good head and neck, powerful, well placed shoulders.
