PIMLICO'S GRADED HANDICAP

Spirited Contests, with Results Disastrous to Favorites.

Announcement Made of Thirteen Probable Starters in Preakness Stakes Next Tuesday.

BALTIMORE, Md., May 14.—The Australian system of graded handicaps was given a trial at Pimlico this afternoon before a great crowd and over a heavy track. Results of the experiment were satisfactory except in one particular, that being that the favorites were hooked in every case, except in the one captured by Glen Light.

Mike Lynch, who acted as assistant starter at different times for A. B. Dade, James Milton and Mars Cassidy, has been engaged to do the starting at nine of the half-mile tracks in Pennsylvania.

James Butwell has been engaged to ride Thomas Clyde's Fairway in the Preakness Stakes.

W. A. Shea has obtained an option on a stock farm in Loudon County, Virginia, and will probably close for it within the next month.

The plater Fring Line, which came out of his last race a lame horse, changed hands this morning, G. W. Forman purchasing him of E. K. Bryson, the consideration being six shares of the Devonshire Park stock.

HERRON DEVELOPS A SPRINT.

W. Daly, who came back from Kentucky with Senior E. Alvarez Herron, reports that the colt has thrown a splint. It is his intention to have it fired for this ailment.

The Kentucky claiming rule will be in force at the coming meeting at Thorncliffe, Toronto.

FIRST CANADIAN RACING OF THIS YEAR

MONTREAL, Quebec, May 14.—After a lapse of three years thoroughbred racing was resumed in Canada with the opening of the Rock River Jockey Club's spring meeting at Mount Royal Park today.

There will be no scarcity of riding talent, the jockeys here numbering twenty-seven, including Thurber, J. Dominick, H. Gibson, who is making his initial appearance after one and a half years in the Canadian army; Carswell, J. Bell, Connors and J. Murry.

STAR HANDICAP HORSES COMING WEST

Best Racers of the Ross, Hildreth, Garrison, Carman and Other Stables for Kentucky.

BALTIMORE, Md., May 14.—The finish of the Maryland Jockey Club's spring meeting at Pimlico track next Tuesday, which will be marked by the renewal of the \$30,000 Preakness Stakes, the East's greatest three-year-old special, will be followed immediately by a heavy westward flow of three or four of the strongest eastern racing stables.

Half a dozen stakes of high value for long-distance runners give Blue Grass racing this spring a particular attraction to the owners of big and expensive establishments.

ROSS THREE-YEAR-OLDS DISAPPOINT.

Commander Ross' horses have not done as well so far this season as they had done at a corresponding period of 1919. The Canadian had no three-year-old of good class ready for the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness.

RICH PREAKNESS STAKES TUESDAY

Man o' War to Compete with Seasoned Kentucky Derby Starters and Is Ready.

BALTIMORE, Md., May 14.—The Preakness, a race of one mile and an eighth for entire colts and fillies three years old, that will be renewed at the picturesque old Pimlico course on Tuesday with Man o' War on Watch, Donnacona, Upset and twelve to fifteen other good three-year-olds competing, will be the richest of eastern racing prizes for that age this year.

No race for three-year-olds that has been run in the United States in the course of the last fifteen or twenty years has attracted a field of much better three-year-olds than the group that will compete in this year's renewal of the Preakness.

Man o' War, under the silks of Samuel D. Riddle of Philadelphia, earned \$83,325 on American race courses last year and suffering defeat on but one occasion, and then under the circumstances that reflected no credit on his jockey, will start for the first time in a three-year-old race in the Preakness.

WHITNEY CANDIDATES DANGEROUS.

In Upset and Wildair, both competitors in the recent Derby at Louisville, Harry Payne Whitney will have a pair of formidable Preakness contestants. Wildair is at his best on a fast track.

On Watch, one of the Kentucky Derby's placed contenders, will wear the silks of George W. Loft of New York, and he will have a companion runner in Donnacona. On Watch, a son of the unbeaten Colin, is a famous mud runner.

DISTINCTION'S FINE VICTORY

Fast Filly Runs Away from Her Opponents with Ease.

LOUISVILLE, Ky., May 14.—T. C. McDowell's highly rated three-year-old filly Distinction scored her initial purse for this year and incidentally made a show of the fillies that started with her by winning in hollow style and as her rider pleased.

OUTSIDER WINS GREAT METROPOLITAN

LONDON, England, April 6.—From 1851 to 1859 the City and Suburban, at a mile and a quarter, and the Great Metropolitan Handicap, at two and a quarter miles, were decided on the same day at Epsom.

One of the champion hurdlers of the season is Trespasser, a son of the French-bred sire Kidare G. He was unbeaten over the jumps, and on March 20 won the Imperial Cup of \$5,000 over two miles at Sandown Park, in which race he carried 168 pounds, and won by six lengths.
