Grier in the Dwyer Stakes at Aqueduct on July 10, when the champion triumphed after meeting the first real serious opposition he encountered this year, every one of the 30,000 persons who witnessed that contest, as well as the countless number of sportsmen throughout the country, have hoped that Man o' War and John P. Grier would meet again.

The history of the Travers Stakes carries with it the recollections of the oldest turfmen. Its first running was back in Civil War times. It was inaugurated in 1864 and Hunter & Travers' Kentucky was its first winner.
