FINAL KENTUCKY MEETING

Churchill Downs Fall Racing Begins Today with Splendid Card.

Track Given Special Treatment to Make It Faster Than Heretofore—Overflow of Horses.

LOUISVILLE, Ky., November 1.—With Churchill Downs opening tomorrow Kentucky autumn racing enters its last stages and with the wind-up of the eleven days' meeting here comes a termination of the sport for this year in these parts. Judging by the favorable conditions that have prevailed at Lexington and Latonia the meeting here should be equally memorable, for local interest in the coming racing is feverish and an augmentation by horses from the East will add material improvement to the Latonia brigade, which was transferred here almost intact.

At no former fall meeting has there been concentrated so many horses here and the total has created a shortage of stable space at both commodious Douglas Park and Churchill Downs. The reason for the large number here this fall is found in the fact that many owners who campaigned in New York, Maryland and Canada this year intend to go into winter quarters at Churchill Downs and Douglas Park. Then there are those who have the intention of making a campaign at the winter tracks, who have made this a stopping-off point, en route to their ultimate point of operations. The close here will find many special trains destined for Havana and New Orleans, as the bulk of horses for both these winter points will be secured here.

The Churchill Downs management offers for its opening one of the best programs ever staged at any autumn meeting. The Falls City Handicap, with its \$5,000 added, has among its carded starters the topnotchers in these parts. The other six dashes have also filled to the record point and good class horses predominate in all, even the cheaper condition races.

Churchill Downs has not been overlooked in the matter of improvements since the close of racing last spring. One of the many features has been to resurface the track, which will eliminate the cuppiness and make the oval more resilient. Not only did this cause slow time in races, but it also mitigated against some of the starters, which found themselves unequal to showing the best over the going. During the eleven days four rich stake races are down for decision, with the Jockey Club Stakes, fashioned with a view to deciding the two-year-old championship, as the stellar prize. It will be worth close to \$30,000 gross and will have among its starters next Saturday some of the cracks that have campaigned in all parts of this country and Canada.

Sporting Blood, one of the intended starters, is now here to fill his engagements and Sam C. Hildreth's Grey Lag, for which Harry F. Sinclair and S. C. Hildreth are said to have paid a great price, is expected to arrive tonight.

EVERY STALL ON GROUNDS FILLED.

The arrival of horses yesterday and this morning was continuous and darkness found every stall occupied. The eagerness of the owners to race their charges is indicated in the lavish entries made to the initial program; this, too, in spite of rain and muddy track. In its present "skinned" condition, however, it will require almost a deluge to cause a noticeable change in the going.

The plant proper is in its usual excellent order and the vast patronage that will be on hand for the opening will find every comfort painstakingly anticipated and cared for. The club house and exclusive space has been beautified and made more roomy in anticipation of the big crowds that will congregate there.

The racing here will begin daily at 1:30 p. m. and obviate the possibility of racing in darkness. Under the last ruling in the matter of war tax, the same tax will be acceptable on women's badges as on men's tickets and will apply on the admission rate of \$2.

P. Ferrell, manager of the E. Cebrian racing and breeding establishment and chief trainer, was an arrival from California.

Fifteen horses will be permitted to start in races at three-quarters, seven-eighths and one mile, while the limit will be twelve at all other distances. The mile chute makes the increase in the fields specified possible.

Mose Goldblatt canceled his stall reservations for the Churchill Downs meeting and will ship direct from Latonia to Havana.

Trainer Cal Milam brought only three of the J. N. Camden horses here from Latonia, Rangoon, Darjeeling and Bettina. The remainder were sent to their owner's Hartland Farm, Versailles, Ky.

Former jockey George Molesworth has taken over three of the George J. Long horses to train, Orlova, Cortez and Frank F.

The George M. Hendrie stable here in charge of trainer John Walters is the smallest in a long while, there being only seven horses in it. They are Rancher, Ed Horter, Claymore, Esterio, New Britain, Salvo and Last One.

Thomas C. McDowell's horses will be absentees, having been retired for the winter.

The E. R. Bradley horses will consist of seventeen. W. R. Hurley will have six of these under his supervision and the remainder will be looked after by Dick Thompson. The Hurley consignment will be transferred at the close of the racing here to New Orleans. The others will be shipped to the Idle Hour Farm, near Lexington, to go into winter quarters.

OFFICIALS FOR JEFFERSON PARK TRACK

NEW ORLEANS, La., November 1.—G. D. Bryan, upon his arrival here from Kentucky, announced that Joseph A. Murphy, J. B. Campbell and H. P. Conkling will be the stewards for the coming Jefferson Park meeting, which will open on Thanksgiving Day.

EMPIRE CITY FALL RACING FIGURES

S. C. HILDRETH'S LUCK CHANGES AND HE LEADS THE MONEY-WINNING OWNERS OF MEETING --- JOCKEY ENSOR'S RIDING A DISTINCTIVE FEATURE

The final meeting of the year on the Metropolitan racing circuit was held at Empire City from October 16 to October 30, and during the thirteen days of racing \$118,791 was distributed in stakes and purses, the daily average distribution amounting to \$9,137. More of the better grade of horses remained to participate in the racing at the Yonkers course than has been the case in past years, with the result that the sport was on a par with that seen on the other New York tracks. Fine weather, with the exception of the last few days, was an important factor in keeping up the attendance, which was of godly proportions throughout the meeting.

A break in the ill-luck that has been pursuing the Hildreth stable this year came during the Empire meeting with the result that that capable turfman's name appears at the head of the money-winning owners, his horses having won seven races and \$16,109. R. T. Wilson and C. K. Moore also fared exceedingly well, the former finishing second with \$9,970 to his credit, while the latter's earnings amounted to \$7,638.
