The Campfire Purse for all ages at six and a half furlongs was provided as a supplementary attraction of the day's sport and it brought together a small but speedy band of crack racers.

May W. was the medium of confident and heavy support in the opening race. She flattered her backers by leading to the eighth, where she tired and fell back.

Spaulding Jenkins' Duc de Morny furnished another surprise by again taking the measure of Sobrigade, a slow beginning ruining the latter's chances.

J. Mooney rode his second winner of the day when he brought Super home a victor in the fifth race, in which the Superman colt was a pronounced favorite.

E. F. SIMMS' PRIVATE TRAINING TRACK

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N. Y., November 25.—Contractors have started the work of constructing extensive stables and a training track on the big tract of land purchased by Edward F. Simms last September from the Trask estate.

A mile track will be built for the exclusive use of training the Simms horses. The stables will be located along the north side of the property.

NEW ORLEANS' GOOD OPENING

Great Crowd Assembles to Welcome the Return of Racing to the Crescent City.

NEW ORLEANS, La., November 25.—To Johnny Dundee's War Mask went the honor of taking the first feature race to be decided at New Orleans this fall, for he accounted for the Thanksgiving Handicap of \$1,500 value in easy style and covered the mile in 1:39 3/4.

A well matched band comprised the starters and they furnished a splendid contest throughout, the winner being in the thickest of activities, with Woodtrap also enjoying prominence.

Never has the Jefferson Park track been called on to entertain so vast an assemblage, as that which was within its inclosure this afternoon. The crowd was so dense that circulating about with free movement was impossible, resulting in considerable crowding, but with the spectators took their lack of comfort in jovial style and displayed their appreciation of a return of racing here.

The betting pavilion was nearly impassable and, at times, required football scrimmage tactics to carry one free of the jams. Betting activities were considerably hampered as a result of the big gathering and probably it was well for the price quoter that such was the case, for the winners were supported in extensive fashion and it would have entailed a greater deficit for the layers had the betting been heavier.

Judge J. F. Monck, who will officiate in the stewards' stand with Joseph A. Murphy and Herman Conkling, was late in reaching the track on account of a delay of his train to reach the city, but he was in the stand during the afternoon.

Word has been received from Bowie that James Arthur's good horse, Bendage, has gone amiss and will not be raced any more until next year.

An indication that reinstatements made by the directors of the Business Men's Racing Association recently will not be recognized by the Jefferson Park track officials was afforded when the stewards gave orders to deny admission to George Carroll to the grounds until further notice.

FINE OPENING AT TIJUANA

Winter Meeting in Far West Begins Auspiciously—Stakes Close Today.

SAN DIEGO, Cal., November 25.—Before one of the largest gatherings ever seen at the Mexican course across the boundary line the winter meeting of the Lower California Jockey Club was inaugurated today under most favorable auspices.

The racing was interesting and thoroughly enjoyed by the big crowd.

Entries to nine of the valuable stake races to be run here during the winter will close for entries tomorrow. These stakes are the Los Angeles High-weight Handicap, \$2,500, three-quarters mile, for all ages; the San Francisco Handicap, \$2,500, one mile and seventy yards; the Tijuana Business Men's Handicap, \$2,500, one mile and a sixteenth; the Mexicali Handicap, \$2,000, one mile and seventy yards; the Far West Handicap, \$2,000, three-quarters mile; the San Ysidoro Claiming Stakes, \$1,500, one mile and seventy yards; the Oakland Claiming Stakes, \$1,500, three-quarters mile; the Sacramento Handicap, \$1,500, one mile, and the Speed Handicap, \$1,500, five and one-half furlongs.

CUBA'S AUSPICIOUS OPENING

Great Crowd Sees Inauguration of Winter Meeting in Havana—Buford Stake Winner.

HAVANA, Cuba, November 25.—The seventh annual winter racing season in Cuba began today at Oriental Park with a record crowd in attendance that included the elite of Havana society and representatives of the United States and Cuban government.

The Thanksgiving Inaugural Handicap was the principal racing attraction and the victory of Senor E. Alvarez' Buford was immensely popular, especially among the Cubans, and there were many of them present. The race was spirited throughout and not until Buford disposed of Helen Atkin in the stretch was his victory assured.

It was a great day for the Cuban owners, as in addition to Senor Alvarez' success in the stake race, the Armonia Stable scored a double with Pomerene and Black Prince.
