**BRUCE LOWE NO. 5 FAMILY L. WATERBURY STABLE'S RECORD**

**VETO IS IN WINNING FORM**

Contains Group of Great Runners,  
but Scarce of Sires.

Charles O'Malley and Sunstar  
the Present Stars—Best  
Branches Considered.

A goodly array of famous race horses and great producing mares trace back in the direct female line to a daughter of Massy's Black Barb, the tap root of family No. 5. For all this, but one really influential sire, and this Doncaster, is a member of this family.

Bruce Lowe, of course, did not regard family No. 5 as a sire line, although this is the family of the seven times leading English sire Hermit, and of such good sires of winners as the Palmer, Rosierian, Winkfield, Galtee More, Ard Patrick, Sunstar, etc. Bruce Lowe, I take it, was right, because No. 5 family sires do not seem capable of transmitting their own sire excellence, with the exception of Doncaster, to their direct male descendants. Hermit, in the male line, has practically ceased to exist, unless the No. 14 horse Ballot gives to this Hermit line a fresh start. Neither Rosierian nor the Palmer have set up a house of his own and Winkfield's best racing son, Bachelor's Button, failed as a sire. It is too early yet to say just what fate holds in store for Sunstar as a sire of sires. However, the odds are against him and the fact remains that No. 5 horses, as a rule, no matter their own attainments as sires of winners, do not seem capable of transmitting sire excellence to their lineal descendants.

As a running family, however, No. 5 is much in evidence and many good sires of winners are also members of No. 5 family.

The Hermit or Seclusion by Tadmor branch is one of the best winner-producing lines there is, for, besides Hermit, to Seclusion trace St. Bris, Son in Law, Minor, Mirthful, Fair Rosamond, ancestress of many, etc., and no mistake can be made in the selection of either mares or yearlings which trace in the female line to Tadmor's daughter, Seclusion.

The Elizabeth by Rainbow branch is also good, as this, the branch of the No. 5 family from which comes the great No. 5 sire transmitter Doncaster and the French stud success Simonia, which latter, by the way, traces to Elizabeth's half-sister Maria, by Waterloo.

The Diversion by Defence branch of the Foyle by Bay Middleton division is extra good as a running branch. Diversion bred three daughters, Miami, Madame Eglington and Crosslanes. To the first named trace St. Alvynne, sire of the 1920, 140 pounds, winner of the two miles Melbourne Cup, Poitrel; St. Leger winner Marie Stuart; Morganette, dam of Galtee More; Ard Patrick and Blairfinde, and I am left wondering if either Galtee More or Ard Patrick will prove strong enough to sire some son fit to carry on the line. To Madame Eglington trace Rosierian, The Palmer, Marion, Winkfield, Nimbus, Nuncio, Finasour. None of these, however, are sires of sires. To Crosslanes traces perhaps the best of the No. 5 horses which have appeared in a long time—Sunstar—and Sunstar is the sire of that good, honest colt Buchan. And here is the as yet unanswered question: How much of his own sire excellence has Sunstar been able to hand on to his son Buchan?

**CHARLES O'MALLEY THE FAMILY JEWEL.**

Charles O'Malley, a No. 5 horse, is doing right well these days at the sires of the Oaks winner Charlebelie and others, as is Sir Martin's French conqueror Bihou. A real good French racing branch of the No. 5 family starts with Bathilde by Young Emilus, to which also strains the South American Grey Fox. Grey Fox, I am given to understand, has been purchased for sire duty in England and, on account of his membership in the No. 5 family, I shall watch his stud career with unusual interest and must now regard his chance of success as at least promising, from the fact that he is descended in the male line by way of Le Samaritain and Le Sancy, from Herod. Anyway, England will not be the loser on account of the coming of Grey Fox, for his daughters, as certain as anything, are to prove their worth as brood mares.

The avenger of Waterloo, Gladiateur, was a member of the Warwick mare by Merman branch of the No. 5 family, as is the Two Thousand Guineas winner Kirkeonel, as well as that good Australian Patron. Gladiateur's failure as a sire was complete enough for anything and this can only be attributed to his membership of a non-sire branch of the No. 5 running family. Nothing much is heard these days of the doings of Kirkeonel as a sire, and Patron, I believe, had an unsuccessful try as a sire in England, and must also be written down as a failure as a sire.

The Ecstacy by Touchstone branch of this family, though productive of many a good winner, is not celebrated for the excellence of its sires. Ecstacy traces to Royal Oak's dam by Smolensko. Royal Oak sired no sire, as does Mary Aislabie by Malcolm, ancestress of that first-class French race horse Jandy, which, his turf career ended, was taken away to the Argentine, there to sire many a good winner, but what the success of his sons as a sire I do not know.

The best winner producing branches of the No. 5 family, then, are the Diversion by Defence and the Seclusion by Tadmor, the Bathilde by Young Emilus, Elizabeth by Rainbow (Doncaster branch), Mary Aislabie (small one) are also good, but as a sire line, with the Doncaster exception, No. 5 family cannot be considered as first class.

Really it is amazing how marvelously accurate was Bruce Lowe, in his differentiation of the sire and running families, for even successful sires of winners which are members of the No. 5 running family do not seem capable of transmitting their own sire excellence to their male descendants; in other words, family trees are but seldom carried forward by a No. 5 horse.

**IDLE DELL'S FINE VICTORY IN THE WALDEN STAKES AT PIMLICO GIVES THE STABLE ITS CHIEF PRIZE IN THIS YEAR'S RACING**

**American Maid No Longer a Maiden—Talisman Wins Another Race.**

Qualifications of his horses considered, "Larry" Waterbury was quite successful in the racing of 1920. Truth to tell, he had no horse of great racing value in his stable except the two-year-old Idle Dell and, under the circumstances, his stable earnings of nearly \$40,000 must be voted highly satisfactory. Idle Dell is a fine and fast filly and her victory in the valuable Walden Stakes at Pimlico was an excellent exhibition of speed, gameness and stamina. Her sire, Delhi, was a brilliant race horse, but has been overshadowed in the stud by other sons of Ben Brush, so Idle Dell is a distinct credit to him. Next to her Jennings Park was the best money gainer for the stable and ran some good races in high-class company, but not up to his best western form. The stable earnings were:

## PIMLICO FUTURITY OF 1922 ATTA BOY II. AND HERRON

Over Seven Hundred Entries in Maryland's Richly Endowed Race for Two-Year-Olds.

The Maryland Futurity of 1922, with its \$40,000 added, is bound to be one of the most coveted prizes of the racing of that year. It closed November 8 with 765 nominations. A striking feature of its big entry list is the number of impending young stallions from which much is expected through their progeny. Among them are Kenneth D. Alexander's Escoba, G. L. Blackford's Prince Hermits, E. R. Bradley's North Star II, John Sanford's George Smith, August Belmont's Hourless, Willis Sharpe Kilmer's Sun Briar, L. A. Lyne's Wormleighton, John E. Madden's The Finn, H. P. Whitney's Chicle and R. T. Wilson's Campfire, all with good credentials for stud success.

A pleasing item is the reappearance of the name of August Belmont as a nominating owner.

He is represented by five colts and two fillies by Fair Play and colt and filly by Hourless.

J. K. L. Ross has twenty-nine entries, all of which are of his own breeding, significant of the fact that he will presently be raising his own race horses. By 1923 he should have a good crop by Cudgel to exalt over. His entries now are in the main by the well-tried sire Marathon and the young English horses Fitzwilliam and Hillhampton. If it should prove the good fortune of Commander Ross to carry off this big race, he will be the beneficiary of that one of his conditions which reads: "An additional \$5,000, of which \$4,000 to the winner and \$1,000 to the breeder of the winner, will be added by the Jockey Club, if the colt or filly is the product of a mare served in Maryland and foaled there." When Sir Barton becomes a studmate of Cudgel and Marathon, owner Ross should not be long about sending some great home products into racing.

John Sanford certainly has an international entry list.

In his nomination of twelve he has colts by Rabelais, Nassoyan, Rockton, Marathon, Spanish Prince II, George Smith and Eouen, and fillies by Sunstar, Tracey, Uncle, George Smith and Short Grass. There is certainly variety here and there should be a touch of high quality as well.

Harry Payne Whitney has forty-eight nominations with the singularity of not one of them being by Peter Pan.

Evidently the sire of Trysile was in disfavor for a time. But the untried sire Chicle has been given a good chance with ten sons and daughters entered.

Evidently this son of Spearint and Lady Hamburg is well thought of at the home farm.

The great stallion Broomstick has a representation of seventeen, made up of six colts and eleven fillies. One of the latter is a daughter of the crack filly of a few years back, Rosie O'Grady.

One of the Chicle colts is a son of the famous Regret. For her fame it would be appropriate to find him winning the Kentucky Derby, when his time comes.

**SIX-YEAR-OLD GALLEY HEAD IS DEAD**

The six-year-old Galley Head, by Galatine—Fairlie Head, by Ayrshire, which last raced at the fall meeting at Bowie, is dead. He broke a knee and had to be destroyed. Galley Head never amounted to much as a racer, his record for his five years on the turf being as follows:

**KUMMER TO RIDE FOR H. P. WHITNEY**

NEW YORK, N. Y., December 22.—H. P. Whitney has secured second call on the services of jockey Clarence Kummer for the year 1921. It is understood that Kummer's retainer fee from the Whitney stable will be \$15,000. Kummer gained fame this year as the rider of the peerless Man o' War, guiding the champion in all but two of his memorable races. Altogether Kummer rode in 353 races during 1920, of which he won eighty-seven.

Furnish Interesting Duel at Havana—Vic Munoz Qualifies for Sunday's Big Race.

HAVANA, Cuba, December 22.—Mose Goldblatt broke the spell of bad luck that has seemingly hovered over his stable since its arrival in Cuba when the good three-year-old Atta Boy II, defeated the Cuban Derby winner Herron in a thrilling finish in a three-quarters of a mile dash, run as the fifth race. It was a sparkling contest from start to finish, with Atta Boy II and Herron racing like a team and fighting every inch of the way. Great enthusiasm prevailed as the two horses came thundering through the stretch and the finish was so close that the admirers of both horses claimed victory and the result was in doubt until the official placing was announced.

The Peter Pan colt Vic Munoz qualified handsomely for the Championship Stakes to be run Sunday when he won an impressive victory in the Trial Handicap, easily defeating Spuds, Aunt Deed and Santa Claus, to each of which he was conceding much weight.

The winner of the first race came from the stable of G. C. Mizell in the Transvaal filly Jill. She was ridden by R. Ball and displayed a high order of speed, leading all the way. After entering the stretch, with what appeared to be a safe lead, she suddenly tired and victory was almost turned into defeat, Frank Burke closing like a flash and just failing to overtake the filly.

G. B. Foley's Maryland breed Smite, a son of Prince Ahmed, robed the second race of all interest by stealing away into a long lead and easily holding sway throughout. Elment, after going a half-mile in this race, bled and was pulled.

The Mariamano stable's Avion, under the skillful guidance of B. Kennedy, ran up to the expectations of his admirers, who made him an even money favorite at post time, and easily accounted for the third race, never being in danger at any part of it. Kewessa was second and Driffield third.

Avion was claimed out of the third race by W. B. Campbell for \$1,100.
