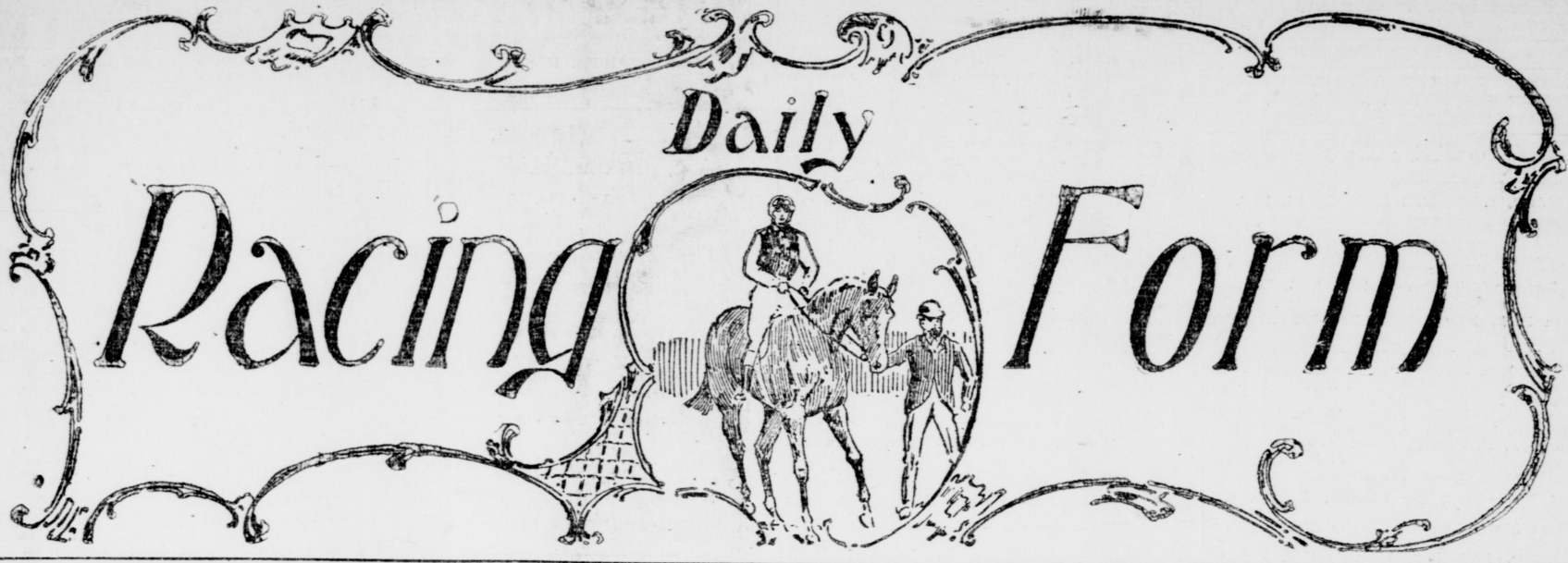

KENTUCKY RACING DATES

Spring Meetings of 1921 to Begin at Lexington April 23.

Total of Sixty-One Days Provided For—Question of Stakes and Purses Deferred.

LEXINGTON, Ky., December 23.—Racing in Kentucky for the year 1921 will begin at Lexington Saturday, April 23, and close at Latonia Saturday, July 4, making a total of sixty-one days for the spring meetings at the three tracks of the Kentucky Jockey Club, as determined by the Kentucky State Racing Commission at its meeting here today.

MAN O' WAR'S STUD CAREER

Soon to Go to the Hinata Stud in Kentucky—Golden Broom Also Is to Be Retired.

NEW YORK, N. Y., December 23.—There is naturally much interest in the stud career of the champion Man o' War, which will be shipped to his new home in Kentucky about January 1. He will be consigned to Miss Elizabeth Dummerfield, whose home, Haylands, adjoins Hinata Farm, which she has leased for a term of years. It is at Hinata that Man o' War will be kept, along with Golden Broom, the latter the property of Mrs. Walter M. Jeffords, who paid \$17,500 for the son of Sweeper—Zana, by Hamburg, as a yearling at Saratoga in the summer of 1918.
