FLAMBETTE'S LATONIA OAKS

Narrowly Defeats Bit of White
in a Rousing Finish.

Miss Joy an Easy Victress in the
Cincinnati Trophy, with Whit-
ney's Bonus Second.

LATONIA, Ky., July 2.—P. A. Clark's Flam-
lette, victress of the Coaching Club Oaks, was
triumphant this afternoon in the Latonia Oaks,
which she won by a scant head from Bit of White,
with Aphie Dear in third place and Nancy Lee,
a stable companion to Flamrette and Fallacy, fol-
lowing.

The race had a net value to the winner of \$8,870.
The mile and a quarter was covered in 2:03%,
which is four-fifths of a second off from the track
record, made by Busy Signal in the same race last
year in her memorable victory over Cleopatra.
Shipped here from the metropolis this time, the
East, or rather P. A. Clark, prepared for the Oaks
victory by sending here a pair of the best fillies
in that part of the country and it was well he did
so, for Nancy Lee, the supposed mainstay of the
Clark pair, was an easy victim to Bit of White's
fleetness. However, to Nancy goes the credit of
being the main factor in Bit of White's downfall,
for she forced the Bradley filly to keep herself
extended from the start and left her well spent
when Flamrette offered her stubborn challenge in
the last eighth. To Connally was trusted Flamrette
and he kept her under restraint at a considerable
distance back of the leaders until just before
reaching the stretch turn. Here he sent her for-
ward with a rush and soon drew level with Bit of
White, but the latter, in spite of having withheld
challenges in succession from Nancy Lee, Fallacy
and Aphie Dear, would not give way and stubbornly
disputed every inch of ground until in the last
twenty yards, where Flamrette succeeded in get-
ting her nose in front and kept it there until
crossing the finishing line. During the last six-
teenth Flamrette came over a trifle from an outer
position and had Bit of White in close quarters.
Aphie Dear ran an excellent race and but for the
fact that she was caught in a pocket on the stretch
turn when Butwell tried to rush her through next
to the inner rail she would have been closer to the
leading pair.

MISS JOY THE PHENOMENAL.

The phenomenal Miss Joy was an enforced vic-
tress in the Cincinnati Trophy, which had a value
of \$7,400 net to the winner, as well as a trophy. It
was due to the inability of her stable companions,
Fair Phantom and Rockminster, to head Harry
Payne Whitney's Bonus. It was the intention,
as in several previous cases, to reserve Miss Joy
and win with Fair Phantom, with the intent of sav-
ing Miss Joy from a penalty as a stake winner,
but the Whitney filly upset this plan this after-
noon by coming with a rush through the last
eighth and ousting Fair Phantom, which had
kept pace with the hard restrained Miss Joy. Luns-
ford, seeing Fair Phantom's plight, was forced to
move away on Miss Joy in the last sixteenth, but
near the end he had the Jones candidate under
restraint again. Bonus had no difficulty heading Fair
Phantom for second place and directly in Fair
Phantom's wake came Rockminster, another Mont-
fort Jones candidate.

During the early running of the race Miss Joy
and Fair Phantom were far in advance of the
others and even in the stretch it appeared that
the stable could succeed in keeping the penalty off
Miss Joy with Fair Phantom to head her at the
finish, but Bonus shot out of the field with a
rush and, finishing gamely, soon had Fair Phan-
tom in trouble and made a bold threat at dis-
placing Miss Joy from the lead. Then Lunsford
gave Miss Joy a free rein and she moved away
in a flash. The Hewitt pair, Starke and Wash-
ington, were prominent to the stretch, where they
gave way. The race further emphasized how
much superior the fillies are to the two-year-old
colts in these parts, the three placed ones being
of the gentler sex.

IMMENSE THROG DESPITE HEAT.

The pair of twin features was responsible for
the presence of an immense throng at the Latonia
track, despite the intense heat. Spirited racing
again developed, some of the finishes having the
crowd enthused to a high pitch.

The opener inaugurated the close finishes when
By Golly only managed to outstay His Choice and
get the verdict in the last stride.

Inquisition, like By Golly, was installed fa-
vorite and she proved much the best in the second
race.

The veteran Bromo, after a two years' layoff,
 essayed a comeback and nearly succeeded, being
beaten out a scant neck by the nearly 100 to 1
shot Nelle Yorke. Bromo would have won but for
going lame in the race.

Jim Murray, which has a pair of victories to his
credit during the present meeting, added another
one when he won the sixth race from Buddie Kean
and Botheration. He had to be driven to his utmost
to outstay Buddie Kean.

Kewpie O'Neil continues his winning way and
beat a good band of platers, Mint Cat landing
in second place and Marse John just managing to
outstay Kimpalong for the shorter part of the
race.

Trainer James Ownbey has terminated connections
with the C. H. Knebelkamp stable and will keep
Botheration and Thinker here to be rested until
the fall opening. The Knebelkamp horses will be
shipped to Windsor after the closing here and will
be trained by Lon Jones.

Jockey Murray was reported resting safely and
the doctors in the hospital where he is confined
expect him to show no ill effect of his hard fall,
though his back is still under suspicion and he
complains of pains. Heinrich has several ribs
strained and a possible near fracture of one, but
was at the track this morning.

S. Wida is not showing much improvement and
will probably be out of the saddle for some time.

THEY'RE OFF AT FORT ERIE

Second Thoughts Accounts for Niagara Stakes
—Eddie Rickenbacher Meets Defeat.

FORT ERIE, Ont., July 2.—Edward F. Whitney's
consistent daughter of Ultimus—Lydia II, Second
Thoughts, accounted for the annual renewal of the
Niagara Stakes at Fort Erie this afternoon. Ogarite
was the one to run second, while the Canadian-
bred Corenzo was third. The race was a dash
of five-eighths, to which \$2,500 had been added.
Of the original overnight entry list but six con-
tested the issue, with Second Thoughts an over-
whelming favorite. There was a slight delay at
the post, but the start was a good one. The win-
ner and Captain Scott were the first two to show
in front, with Corenzo in close pursuit. They raced
this way for the first three-eighths and Captain
Scott was through. Ogarite in the meantime was
hemmed in next to the inside rail and Walls was
forced to take the outside. Second Thoughts
swerved badly under the weight through the final
sixteenth of a mile, but was clear and did not
interfere with any starter. Ogarite closed fast
and wore down Corenzo in the final strides to
take the place by a short margin.

The opening dash of the summer meeting of the
Niagara Racing Association was ushered in this
afternoon under conditions that could hardly be
improved upon. Well balanced fields paraded for
each of the different races and spirited racing re-
sulted. Apart from the running of the feature race
the Lafayette Hotel Handicap was offered as a
secondary feature. This race, which was a three-
quarters, brought together some of the fastest
sprinters on the circuit. This even resulted in a
surprise for the talent when Mock Orange came
along to win over Eddie Rickenbacher, with Day-
dream third. The winner was ridden by C. Lane and
negotiated the distance in 1:13%. The early pace
was set by Carmandale and Hidden Jewel and
both quit.

John Hachmeister, one of the stewards at the
Cuban meeting, arrived from Latonia this morning
and viewed the races from the judges' stand. Mr.
Hachmeister returns to Kentucky tomorrow.

C. J. Brockmiller and Capt. G. C. Bunbury ar-
rived here from Latonia this morning, the former
with five and the latter with two horses.

O'Brien. The plater will be rested up and turned
over to E. J. Salt.

At the recent meeting of the Canadian Racing
Associations held at Hamilton it was left optional
what different clubs to draw for post position on
the day of the races or the day previous. In the
latter case the post position will be in program
order and this will be followed out at Fort Erie.

Jockey J. Gruber will in future do the riding
for the stable of A. L. Kirby.

Numerous scratches were necessitated today, due
to the late arrival of the special horse train from

in the opening race.
