RAIN AND HEAVY TRACK

Patrons of Empire City Encounter Very Disagreeable Weather.

Card Is Riddled by Scratches—Royce Rools Has a Walk-over in the Main Race.

NEW YORK, N. Y., July 15.—One of the poorest cards of the Metropolitan season, coupled with the worst weather conditions encountered this year, was today's offering for the patrons of Empire City.

Scratches riddled the card and brought a walk-over for Royce Rools in the Gramatan Handicap. B. Kennedy, astride the Saintolat gelding, galloped a mile and an eighth in 2:13 1/2 to earn \$874.16, half of the value the race would have held for the winner had there been another starter.

John Sanford's The Curragh colt Steivecard, of which much was expected earlier in the spring, found a track to his liking in the first race of the afternoon and showed the form he displayed in his work-outs at Aqueduct, but not in his races. He won by five lengths. He was well supported, but not the favorite. Cydonia had that honor, his recent good winning performance giving him the call.

The blue pencil riddled the third race of all the bright lights that were expected to shine in this dash of a mile and seventy yards, leaving but four to clash. The Chicago owned Sea Sinner was the choice and again no mistake was made. He led throughout, unmoiled, and never in danger.

Another Kilmer-bred Assagai filly romped home an easy winner when Atta Gilly accounted for the final dash of the afternoon. She was never in danger, although Stock Pin, the favorite, was trying hard all the way in second place.

John Sanford of Amsterdam, N. Y., owns Dark Flight, the dam of Night Patrol, which won the Newmarket July Handicap Thursday.

RAIN HELPFUL AT WINDSOR

Brings Coolness and Makes the Race Track Faster.

Dodge the Victor in the Main Race of the Day—Card Inferior and Devoted to the Slow Ones.

WINDSOR, Ont., July 15.—Although there was no carded feature at the Windsor Jockey Club course this afternoon, a well-arranged card of seven races was offered and was productive of spirited racing.

The card today catered to the poorer grade of horses and mostly under claiming conditions. The backers were again in a quandary and failed to center on the winners with any degree of accuracy.

The attendance was again large, and well up to previous Friday standards. Jockey W. Morrissey was suspended for three days by starter Morrissey yesterday for disobedience at the barrier in the fourth race while astride Marlin Falkon.

Jockey Claver was suspended for the remainder of the meeting by the stewards for rough riding in the fifth race. This suspension places Claver, or any other boy, in a serious predicament, as it is a rule of the Canadian Racing Associations that a rider's license is automatically revoked on his suspension the second time for rough riding.

MANY SCRATCHES AT KING EDWARD

MONTREAL, Que., July 15.—A steady downpour of rain last night rendered the track heavy for racing at King Edward Park this afternoon. As a result the fields were greatly reduced by scratches.

A series of claiming races made up the day's card. The fifth was productive of the best finish of the afternoon when Miss Kruter just lusted long enough to head Ned Milebright by a head.

The winners of the remaining races scored with considerable to spare. Jockeys W. Taylor and J. McDowell have been restored to good standing. Both suffered suspensions during the Mount Royal meeting.

The good mare My Gracie will be on the shelf for at least six weeks, according to the veterinarian. She was cut to the bone when kicked just below the stifle while at the post for her last race here, which she won.
