## RANCOCAS TRIPLE VICTORY

Mad Hatter, Kai-Sang and Grey Lag Its Three Winners.

Kai-Sang's Success in East View Stakes Comes After Runstar Is Disqualified.

NEW YORK, N. Y., July 23.—Runstar, the California colt of more speed and reputation than manners, lost the \$10,000 East View Stakes at Empire City today because he couldn't run straight. He had no other excuse. Off well and in his stride in front, with a clear path, Runstar weakened when gamely assailed with speed by the Rancocas Stable's colt Kai-Sang, headed and bumped his racing antagonist and enabled Metcalf, his rider, to foully impede Kai-Sang and to leg-lock and prevent Sande, Kai-Sang's rider, from winning. Runstar generally misbehaved himself in the closing contention of the race and was correctly disqualified for his faulty performance, the \$7,300 first prize being awarded to Kai-Sang. Metcalf, his rider, was also punished—justly.

It wasn't a fast-run race. The East View was over the Futurity short six furlongs, for which Old Koenig's 1918 1:07½ is the speed mark. There were no ten second furlongs and no thirty-three second three furlongs in Runstar's front racing. Facts are facts, and the Runnymede colt in the face of them rather showed the white feather under pressure.

Bad manners are handicaps always, of course, but in the running of the East View it seemed as if even the scant three-quarters was beyond Runstar's compass. He is a massive colt, of fine action and speed, but so far losing speed and work speed appear to be his forte. Runstar has raced three times as a philanderer. There isn't much doubt but that he will improve, but as between him and his ex-stable mate of more generosity and docility—Mervich—there is no present comparison as racing colts.

### METCALF TO BLAME FOR FOUL.

There were eight select in the East View field. The nimble beginning Little Chief (Fator) and the more sedate and superior Kai-Sang (Sande), under the Rancocas white and green, were the natural favorites and staunchly supported. Runstar and Mustard Seed were both broadly backed. The start was perfect and early, with June Grass in front. He showed a free footed way for nearly a quarter of a mile, with Runstar and Penitent in attendance. With profuse speed Runstar then assumed command to the stretch. Here Kai-Sang moved up. Penitent had been roughed and impeded and was eased, and June Grass was fading away. For a furlong Kai-Sang pressed Runstar hard and the Californian, weakening, began to roll, so to write, leaned over and bumped Kai-Sang and forced Sande and Metcalf together so that their legs were locked. Sande reported that they were. At the winning post Runstar's nose was in front—the racing nod of odd strides put it there. Kai-Sang was three lengths before his stable companion, Little Chief, and Mustard Seed two more lengths behind him. Mustard Seed seemed to lack his usual insistent speed, though he met with some interference to throw off his stride and had to race widely. It was obvious to all watchers of the finish that Runstar would be disqualified, and he was—deservingly. The stewards also suspended Metcalf from further action at the meeting for his dirty work at the finish. Metcalf obviously didn't use any effort to straighten out his tiring mount. Instead, he appeared only to want to win by foul means, even to the extent of a misapplied whip. Metcalf's case goes to the stewards of the Jockey Club. His punishment is likely to be extended. It was a nasty piece of foul riding. There was much expressed dissatisfaction after the disqualification. There usually is. One extra demonstrative spectator was "given the gate."

The talent got a facer to begin with. The Boy had run a good race under stout backing behind Lunetta and Guy'nor Thursday, where he ran as if short. The Boy was in the Rye seller over the short three-quarters course against Sunflash II, the elderly Rancocas sprinter, which had Sande up and was a reasonable odds-on favorite. Only the two were considered, as Billy McLaughlin and Welfinder were absentees. The Boy won on his merits. Sunflash II was mildly restrained in front to the last furlong. Then Haynes—who can ride excellently—brought up The Boy with a peremptory challenge on the outside, which Sunflash II, couldn't resist and, in a handsome finish, The Boy won by a head in the last dozen strides. Sunflash II swerved from the Sande whip in the closing strides. The trio of moderates behind, headed by Staunch, were four lengths away. It seemed as if Sunflash II was the short one this time.

### MAD HATTER'S FINE RACE.

There was a stake field in the entries for the Cosmopolitan Handicap of a mile and seventy yards. Here seemed the place for some of the selling race funds which so often go awry. Bashful owners drew all the teeth of interest. Purchase and Mad Hatter must have frightened five of the entries away. Purchase left the Rancocas chance to Mad Hatter. But Yellow Hand, Royce Roots, Dimesdale and Dr. Joe were absent too, and consequently it was merely a fast gallop for Mad Hatter, at 1 to 8 and less, to win all the way and by a half a dozen lengths at the finish from Recount and Snapdragon II. Mad Hatter's trip was rather sightly for its ease, for speed and action. He is in rare fettle just now. The quarters were well rated—the second in 23 seconds. The mile was in 1:38½, the fastest of the Empire City present meeting, and the eased-up finish in 1:43½, less than a second slower than St. Isidore's track record of 1:52½. Sande had no whip with him. Good! Good! If the fine young rider will lose all the whips in his kit Rancocas and its horses will do better. It isn't that Sande cannot be trusted with a whip. He and a whip are mere acquaintances; not friends. Bad tools spoil good mechanics.

## SARATOGA'S GREAT STAKE ARRAY

THIRTY-FOUR RICHLY ENDOWED FIXTURES PROVIDED FOR THE COMING AUGUST MEETING, WITH THE HOPEFUL OF \$30,000 THE MOST VALUABLE

One week more, then Saratoga. The annual meeting of the Saratoga Racing Association opens Monday, August 1, and continues throughout the entire month of August. Richly endowed by nature and further embellished by the handiwork of man, Saratoga each year attracts the beauty and wealth of the nation, giving it a prestige enjoyed by no other race course in this country. That is also true of the horse. The best of the East, West, South and Canada meet there to settle the supremacy of the year. The great array of time-honored and valuable stake races are primarily the means of bringing together these aristocrats and giants of the turf. Richest of these fixtures is the Hopeful for two-year-olds, with its guaranteed value of \$30,000, for which one hundred and forty-eight juveniles, out of an original nomination of two hundred and forty-five, still remain eligible. Nearly all of the most promising two-year-olds of the year are among them. The old-established Travers Stakes is next in value, with \$12,500 guaranteed. The United States Hotel, Alabama and Grand Union Hotel Stakes each have \$10,000 guaranteed, and the Saratoga Special will equal, if not surpass, that amount. Sixteen of the thirty-four stakes have a guaranteed value, the remainder being of the added money variety, which assure the winner, in most cases, in excess of the amount subscribed by the Saratoga Racing Association. Such are the Saratoga Cup and Saratoga Handicap, both famous races, with a list of renowned horses among their winners. With this great outlay of stake prizes, and valuable overnight handicaps and other races, the total monetary distribution during the coming Saratoga meeting will undoubtedly exceed the \$38,240 of last year. ## FINE WEATHER AT MONTREAL

Brings Out Largest Crowd of Week—Cacumbo Wins Imperial Purse in Close Finish.

MONTRÉAL, Que., July 23.—After being outrun by Musito to the stretch, Cacumbo closed up steadily and beat the former by a neck to win the Imperial Purse, the fifth and feature attraction at Maisonneuve Park this afternoon.

Old Pop scored his fifth race of the local season, when he easily annexed the initial dash for homebred horses.

Favorable weather and track conditions prevailed for the first time during the meeting and the half-holiday crowd swelled the attendance to over 5,000, the largest of the week.

After investigation jockey R. Pauley was exonerated from blame of Frenchy swerving in front of his opponents in the first race yesterday and his suspension consequently was lifted.

H. A. Ekker has donated Jim Thorpe to the Canadian National Bureau of Breeding.

George Magee has departed for Toronto with Thomas F. McMahon and John Lake.

Mormon bowed a tendon in his last race here and will be out of commission for some time.

The stable of P. M. Moore, including Rainbow Girl, Sabretash, Miss Kruter and Fait Accompli has been shipped to Apollo, Pa. Fait Accompli was purchased from Harry Herdel just previous to the departure of the string.

H. Herdel has left for Timoneau, Md., with the remaining members of his stable, Koran, Blondel, Superior and Director James.

Word reached here today from Quebec City that jockey A. Casey has recovered from a recent attack of lockjaw, which followed an operation when he had his left leg amputated. Jockey N. Collins, who had all the ligaments of his left foot severed during a race at the Quebec meeting, is now able to be about with the aid of crutches. He will be unable to ride again this year.

The string of A. H. Vivell, including Gwynedd, Northern Lady and Arbitrator, has left for Timonium, Md.

J. H. Wilkens' stable of five, Headman, Justinia E., Lucky Last, Zelota and Short Change, has been shipped to Saratoga.

## JAMAICA FALL PROGRAM

Twelve Added Money Stake Races for October Meeting of Thirteen Days.

NEW YORK, N. Y., July 23.—Walter C. Edwards, racing secretary of the Metropolitan Jockey Club, has announced the list of stake races to be run at the Jamaica autumn meeting of thirteen days, from Saturday, October 1, to Saturday, October 15. There are twelve of these feature attractions, six for three-year-olds and over, four for two-year-olds and two for three-year-olds. All are of the added-money variety, with the Pierrepont Handicap of \$5,000 added as the topliner. The Interborough Handicap, for three-year-olds and over, at one mile and a sixteenth, with \$3,500 added, is a newly-established race. Entries for these events close Monday, August 8. ## BLACK SERVANT IS BEATEN

Races Gallantly, but Gives Way to His Weight Finally.

Bygone Days a Going Away Victor —Clansman Develops Speed Suddenly.

KENILWORTH, Ont., July 23.—C. J. Brockmiller's three-year-old gelding Bygone Days was the victor of the Windsor City Handicap, a dash of a mile and a sixteenth, which was the feature of the card at the Kenilworth track this afternoon. Back of the son of Helmet finished Golden Sphere, with Black Servant taking the small end of the money. A field of seven went to the post for the dash, with the Bradley starter, despite his unreasonable impost, again installed the choice. The start was a good one and Black Servant again elected to go to the front, closely pursued by Jean Corey and, after disposing of her, Butwell moved up with Golden Sphere. The winner in the meantime had been reserved behind the leaders and, gradually improving his position, was taken to the outside when entering the stretch. Closing up with a fine display of speed and gameness, he passed the leaders with a rush and was going away at the end. The race had \$5,000 added and the route was covered in 1:45½.

While the wagering had been in progress on the third race the stewards permitted trainer John Schorr to scratch E. B. McLean's Saddle and Boots. The colt was suffering from a slight attack of coughing and while in the paddock developed fever. An examination showed that he had a temperature of 103. James B. Brown, which had been installed an odds-on favorite, was a disappointment when second was his portion behind Clansman. The latter was one of the longest priced winners of the meeting and had been running bad races.

A dash of a mile and a sixteenth brought together a speedy band under claiming conditions in the fifth race, and added another victory to the score of J. C. Gallagher, when Kinburn was returned the winner from Belarie and King John. Kinburn was in front all the way and withstood several threatening challenges to win away.

Jockey E. Taylor was the victim of a painful accident this morning, that will keep him out of the saddle for some time. While schooling the Canadian-bred two-year-old Shoulder Arms at the barrier the colt swerved into the fence and Taylor suffered a dislocated ankle. He was removed to a local hospital and an x-ray examination was taken.

The city of Hamilton Ont., boasts of supplying three of the leading lightweight riders at the course, namely, C. Lang, T. Brooks and L. McDermott. Gantner is doing his share to hold up the prestige of south of the border.

J. W. Bean has decided to send the two-year-old filly All Fair to his farm at Silver Springs, Md., where she will enter the stud. The older division of horses at present quartered at the farm, including Arrah Go On, Silver Springs and two others, will be taken up for the fall racing in Maryland.

Word was received from Lieut. Col. A. N. McClure, of the Remount Association at Sacramento, California, of the purchase of the stallion Epiphany, 4, by Honeywood—Purse Rose; Pizarro, 4, by Baranosa—Becky, and Trophy, 6, by Ballot-Miss Condon. All are at present at Reno, Nevada, and will be shipped to the Coast.

## SON OF TRACERY A RECORD HOLDER

LONDON, England, July 23.—The Liverpool Cup race of a mile and three-eighths produced a new record for English racing when Abbot's Trace, by Tracery, the American sire, won it by eight lengths pulling up in 2:15, a new record for the distance, and less than a second slower than the time of the American champion Man o' War made last year over one of the New York courses. Abbot's Trace was third choice and virtually won from start to finish. The cup favorite, Lord Derby's Red Head, at 11 to 4, with Donoghue in the saddle, was last in the race. The racing ground was hard, owing to the continued drought. A great crowd was in attendance and the weather was hot and dull. The Liverpool Cup summary follows:

Clancy's old gelding was sharply chosen to win the mile and seventy yards Genesee claimer, fifth on the card, among eight, all that were left of fifteen entered plebeians. Phalaris failed most dismally. He had neither speed nor disposition to win and, off slowly and hemmed in always, Fator could do nothing to induce him even to try. Scotch Verdict—rendered—won the Genesee. Ensor was up and rode the Shaffer horse one of the races he can ride when in form. He saved Scotch Verdict in the early running, headed the rapid Episode in the turn and kept Scotch Verdict going long enough to win under a hard drive by a length from the fast-coming Pirate McGee, well warmed by the persevering Master Penman in the last furlong. Old Mose closed a lot of ground up the stretch and weakened in the final drive, but was third. Phalaris and His Thoughts were beaten about eight lengths.

Grey Lag is in great form just now. As he races on he seems to gather and exude quality. In the \$4,200 Knickerbocker Handicap, at eight furlongs and a half, the grandson of Star Shoot and Miss Minnie, an odds-on favorite, shouldered 135 pounds—nineteen more than that for his age and route—and beat Careful, Copper Demon and Knobbie as he chose, in 1:45, which is but two-fifths of a second off the track record of 1:44:3, held jointly by Borrow, in 1914, under 121 pounds, and Spur, in 1917, under 122. Grey Lag's was a superior performance to the record. It was so easily and sterling done, too.

Only the four started. Dry Moon was declared Careful, from her Saratoga quarters for the race—and good set the pace. It was smart, the quarter in 23% and half in 47. Sande and Grey Lag lay away third to the turn. Then they moved up, took the lead and a hard, smart gallop home to win by nearly three lengths, the three-quarters in 1:42%, a fifth of a second faster than the track's mile record—Boots, 1916, 1:38%, under 110 pounds. Careful was a busy second, three lengths before Copper Demon, with Knobbie used early for pacing—twelve lengths back.

Grey Lag is a magnificent horse at present. Sam Hildreth keeps his kind in form. Unless loaded to the back breaking point the western three-year-olds or oldsters will not take his measure at Saratoga. He is great in gait, disposition and courage, and seems to have the rare gift of instant speed and balance in his racing.

There was a big crowd at the Yonkers course. It filled all points of vantage. The racing ground was as fast as it will be this year. The air was hot and full of sun. Only a cloud veil tempered the glare and it was without permanence.

There never was a better afternoon's racing over the Yonkers course. All the action of the afternoon was sharp and full of incident. The demonstration over Runstar's disqualification was cut of line and illy directed, because the decision was just.

Four favorites won their races. Sande rode three winners, and Raneccas, through Mad Hatter, Grey Lag and Kai-Sang, won some \$14,439 during the afternoon.
