## DISCOMFORT AT HAMILTON

Cold Weather Surprises Patrons and Reduces Attendance.

King John Captures the Feature Race from Murray and Madge

F.—Get 'Em Wins.

HAMILTON, Ont., August 2.—What may be described as the feature race at Hamilton this afternoon was a dash which brought together some good class platters under claiming conditions to go a mile and a sixteenth. F. Musante's King John was returned the winner in a spirited drive through the stretch with Murray. The latter cut out most of the running and only succumbed while racing through the final sixteenth. Madge F. ran a bad race for her, but outstayed the others to take the small end of the purse by a safe margin.

Unseasonable weather prevailed this afternoon and it showed in the reduced attendance. The crowd, generally large from Toronto, was greatly reduced from the holiday gathering of yesterday. Cloudy skies prevailed and summer clothes were dispensed with in favor of light woolens.

The racing was of a spirited order, but again the backers failed to center on the winners, favorites meeting with mishaps, which may be because of the wetting of the homestretch previous to the first race. Hose lines are played freely through the homestretch to reduce the dust. The fractional time through the final quarters was much slower than that shown on the backstretch and by horses in their morning works.

The closest finish of the meeting came with the running of the fourth race, which drew a large and awkward band to the post. Get 'Em, under really good riding by Brooks, managed to get up in the closing strides to win from the tiring pacemaker Sister Emblem.

Lady Heart accounted for the running of a dash fashioned for Canadian-bred two-year-olds from Plymouth and Humorist.

The opening dash of the afternoon served to introduce maiden jockeys. Marie Maxim, a recent arrival from New York, served to graduate N. Brook in easy manner after recovering from early interference.

Charles C. Smith arrived today from Columbus, Ohio, where he terminated a successful trotting meeting on Saturday.

T. F. Bornman will ship from here to Windsor to rest and await the opening of the racing at that point.

Harry O'Neal was scratched from the opening race by the stewards. The rider failed to report to the clerk of the scales in time to make weight.

W. A. Porter departed for Saratoga to rejoin H. McDaniel, in charge of the J. K. L. Ross stable at that point.

G. R. Foreman will divide his stable now here, five going to Fort Erie for racing at that point, while the remainder will proceed to Montreal to rest while awaiting the opening there.

The Brookdale Stable will ship from here to the farm at Barrie, Ont., the two-year-olds Aquatic and Fanatic and the three-year-old Resarf. The former has developed a slight attack of skin disease, while Fanatic is suffering from ankle trouble. Resarf has broken out with sores on her legs.

The next meeting of the Canadian Racing Association will be held August 10 in the clubhouse at Fort Erie. General and routine business will be transacted.

The condition books for the coming meeting at Fort Erie were distributed today.

## KEMPTON PARK PROSPERING

Owner Jackson Has a Strange Adventure While En Route to Saratoga with His Horses.

MONTREAL Que., August 2.—W. R. Padgett provided the winner of the St. Lawrence Handicap, the feature attraction at Kempton Park this afternoon, in Sister Susie. She took the lead after completing half the journey and, in a driving finish, outstayed Assumption. First Pullet easily disposed of the others in the final struggle.

Pleasant weather conditions were present, and the usual large midweek crowd was in attendance.

Miss Holland came from behind in the stretch to take the initial race for Canadian-owned horses.

Lady Harrigan and Frivolous also scored by narrow margins. Mike and Le Balafré both won with considerable to spare.

Cecil Knight has sold Liberator to B. Lafondé, a local owner, and the horse has been turned over to J. Lewis to train.

P. E. Fitzgerald claimed American Soldier for \$1,050 after his race yesterday.

After his last race here on Friday No Trumps was found to have a sponge concealed in one of his nostrils. This is the first report of a horse having been tampered with here this year.

It develops that Wade Brown sold Right Angle and O'Malley privately to J. C. Jett previous to their being shipped from here to McLeansboro, Ill., Saturday.

D. Jackson departed from here with Laughter and Bar One last week destined for Saratoga. At Roscoe Point, the point of entry into the United States, the American customs authorities discovered a large quantity of liquor concealed in the car. The officers consequently confiscated both horses and liquor and it is reported Jackson evaded capture only by beating a hasty retreat across country on foot.

## RACING OF THE SECOND DAY

**EXPECTATION STAKES THE FEATURE AT SARATOGA AND THE FURNISHER OF A THRILLING FINISH BETWEEN SPORTIBOY AND KILLALA --- ROBERT OLIVER FIRST IN THE STEEPELCHASE --- ROSE BRIGADE WINS FOR RANCOCAS STABLE**

## DEVONSHIRE'S FINE TURNOUT

Big Assemblage Gathers to Show Favor to Ladies' Day.

Yorkist Outfinishes St. Paul in the \$5,000 Prince Edward Hotel Handicap.

SARATOGA, N. Y., August 2.—The \$3,000 guaranteed Expectation Stakes, at a mile, one of the more recently established stake races, served as the headliner of today's card, which on the whole was somewhat ordinary for this pretentious racing course. The finish in the feature made amends for any other shortcoming of the afternoon, for the winner only achieved his success by a matter of inches.

W. R. Coe's Sportiboy, ridden by the repentent F. Wilson, got up in the last stride to down John Sanford's Killala, with Copper Demon in third place. The mile, in 1:38%, does not give the victor full credit for his performance. It was in the manner in which he went about his work; his last quarter sprint being particularly of a brilliant style, for he was in the rear of the others when the stretch turn was reached, with Killala, Wellfinner and Copper Demon considerably in advance of him.

He moved up resolutely, but Wilson retarded him somewhat when he began applying his whip. Killala in the last sixteenths had drawn clear, and seemingly was the winner, but Sportiboy finally buckled down to his work and gained with a rush.

It did not seem that he would be able to overhaul Killala, on which Keogh was taking matters somewhat easily, but the Coe colt would not be denied and succeeded in the last stride in getting up to nip Killala out of the spoils of victory.

The shortest priced winner of the afternoon proved to be the western owned Royal Duck, which scored as his confident backers expected. He raced into the lead when F. Smith called on him, and it was hardly an effort to keep his lead in the stretch and win by a big margin from Sunny Hill, with Ticacey following. There were only four starters in the race, Fair Mac, one of those entered, electing to try conclusions in the steeple-

chase. The best race carded was the opener. Some representative sprinters met and put up a contest fitting in with Saratoga action. The winner turned up in W. J. Salmon's fine filly Careful, which raced on almost even strides with Naturalist, but beat him home in game style by the margin of her neck. Lanius, under a good ride, heading the others in third place. Billy Kelly and E. Sander, a redoubtable combination of the past, were given the call in a betting way, but Billy Kelly was not equal to the occasion and, after racing prominently in the rear of Careful and Naturalist to the stretch turn, fell back rapidly. Of course he was not at his best. In that state it would have been play for him to win.

The Rancocas Stable scored its initial success of the meeting in the third race when Rose Brigade, ridden by Fator, showed her fleet heels to the other two-year-olds trying conclusions with her and won all the way without much trouble. Carpenter, an outsider, beating Cydonia home in easy style for second place. Rose Brigade was entered for \$3,500 and invited a \$4,000 bid from G. Miller and a \$5,000 bid from J. Evans, but trainer Hildreth offered the \$5 additional advance to retain her for her owner.

A well-thought-of band of fillies took part in the closing race, but as a contest it was ruined when several in the field, including Nedna, the half-sister to Leochares and the favorite, were left at the barrier. The poor sendoff was attributed to Nancy Shanks wheeling and impeding those lined up alongside of her toward the outer rail. John E. Madden's Harridan, well supported, won under Sander's excellent ride, with Pierre Qui Roule in second place, hard ridden to outstay Evil.

Copper Demon shook off Wellfinner in the final strides for third place. The net amount of the stakes to the winner totaled \$2,175. It was Wilson's first mount since his suspension in the spring.

Cool weather continued with a threat of rain. There was a considerable reduction in attendance from the opening day, but normal lawn activity was noted, the success of the favorites and second choices leaving honors with the backers.

The steeplechase over the about two mile course furnished the usual thrills and spectacular incidents, with the right one, according to the betting wisdom, the ultimate winner, but only after he had been subjected to a hard contest. The one to be crowned with success was the veteran Robert Oliver, hero of many a struggle through the field. He was supported with confidence, but Fair Mac's preliminary caused a following for him, and Le Cyprin also shared attention. Whatever chance the latter had went glimmering early when Dale caused him to blunder at the water hedge and a moment later toppled off on the flat, when he attempted to right a misplaced stirrup. Dale's English style of riding did not fit in well with Le Cyprin's stride, and it caused his downfall.

Dale will carry a memento of his first American mount in the shape of an abrasion over the eye. Le Cyprin showed the most speed while he had his rider aboard, but his elimination enabled Surf to take up the running, closely attended by Robert Oliver, with Fair Mac close up. The leading pair jumped closely together over all the obstacles. Robert Oliver making several effectual attempts to move away, but he pecked and blundered at several of the hedges and not until over the last jump did he succeed in drawing clear. Then it was easy and he won under restraint. Surf was an easiness up second before New Haven, which passed the fast tiring Fair Mac in the straight run to the finish.

Grey Lag's ailment is fast disappearing and but slight trace of his lameness was noticeable this morning. Purchase, too, is coming around in great style. The latter's trouble was located in his hoof, due probably to wrench or strain, following becoming cast in his stall.

Black Servant did not escape unscathed in the

Devonshire International race, according to trainer Thompson, who said today that it was with difficulty he was led back to Windsor after the race. His lameness came as a result of gravel working into his heels, festering and causing a slight abscess. He showed no traces of being amiss in his gallop this morning.

James W. McLellan, who supervises the big band of horses owned by the Xalpa Farm Stable, stated this morning that at least twenty-five yearlings, in addition to many of the older horses, would be offered for sale here about the middle of the month, to reduce the establishment.

W. W. Darden came from Nashville this morning to remain for some time in attendance on the yearlings.

Secretary Edwards was busy this morning distributing stake blanks for the Metropolitan Jockey Club's stake races, which close August 8.

W. R. Tolmie, owner of Captain Hersher and other horses, is confined in a local hospital after a minor operation.

J. D. Carr, Thomas Piatt, Al Smith, C. W. Moore and Eugene Rucker are among the latest Lexingtonians to reach here.

Bred at Home, owned by E. R. Bradley, had to be left at Windsor in charge of T. P. Hayes on account of a high fever she had at the time that the others of the Bradley division was sent here. She will be kept inactive for the remainder of the racing season and be shipped to Idle Hour when she recovers sufficiently to be transported.

Eight colts and ten fillies comprise the yearling consignment received by trainer W. H. Karrick from the W. R. Coe Shoshone ranch at Cody, Wyo. Only three sires are represented, Polymelian, Sweep and Harmonicon. Jockey D. Dale, who was unseated by Le Cyprin during the running of the steeplechase, is a recent arrival from England and this marked his first mount in this country. He is under contract to Mrs. F. Ambrose Clark for the Saratoga meeting. He sustained several cuts about the head.

Jockey Frank Wilson, who was recently restored to good standing by W. R. Coe, his contract employer, after serving a suspension of four months, for insubordination, returned to the saddle this afternoon.

Trainer Will McDaniel saddled his first horse for the J. H. Rosseter stable today, Cape Pillar in the third race.

Marvin May of Cincinnati was among the arrivals this afternoon.

Charles F. Grainger was an arrival from his sunome home in Babylon, L. I., and will remain for the entire meeting.

George Strate, who is managing the racing affairs of J. H. Rosseter, received word today from Wickup ranch that twenty-eight foals make up this year's crop there. Twenty of the foals are colts. Friar Rock is sire of twenty-three of the youngsters and Disguise has the other five to his credit.

E. R. Bradley arrived yesterday morning from Devonshire, where he witnessed the narrow defeat of Black Servant.

Mr. Bradley was not in the least upset by the defeat of his great three-year-old and expressed his belief that Black Servant would reverse the decision with the Rancocas crack Grey Lag when they meet here. Trainer Thompson expressed the belief that Black Servant had trained off slightly.

The Kentucky stake blanks reached here yesterday morning and were greatly desired by most of the owners here who intend to make liberal nominations to the rich stake races offered by the Kentucky Jockey Club for its fall racing, beginning at Lexington September 3.

Noah McClelland, placing judge and clerk of the scales on the Kentucky circuit; W. H. Rowe, owner of the Pelican Stable; W. K. Harrington, whose Florissant Stable numbers twenty-two head here, and Daniel E. Sullivan of Louisville are late arrivals.

Admiral Cary T. Grayson came up from Washington to see his Gaume run in the Saratoga track.

H. C. (Bud) Fisher, whose horses have been here for several weeks under the care of trainer Alex B. Gordon, came up from New York.

W. R. Coe paid J. B. Joel \$12,500 for Pasquita because she was the dam of Polymelian, his extremely fast horse, and when she came over she had Sportiboy at her foot as a foal, the colt being included in the deal. Mr. Coe is abroad, but he has been amply rewarded for his enterprise, as Sportiboy has all the earmarks of a stayer and ought to win other races, especially when the route is over a mile.

Matt Byrne, one of the real old-timers of the turf, and at one time trainer of Salvator and Firenze, the king and queen of their day, and numerous other high class horses, was a visitor today. He is now a prosperous farmer in New Jersey.

WINDSOR, Ont., August 2.—Today was ladies' day at Devonshire and, despite disagreeable weather conditions, an immense gathering turned out, the gentler sex predominating. The spacious grandstand was packed and enthusiasm was frequently manifested. The Devonshire management's efforts to popularize the sport is meeting with much success, as the daily attendance shows.

Mad runners had their innings this afternoon, and horses that run well in that sort of going came in for strong support.

The Prince Edward Hotel Handicap, which was provided as a feature, furnished a stirring finish in which Yorkist came from behind in the stretch to beat St. Paul by a neck. The conditions of this race called for a dash of a mile and a sixteenth and had for incentive a purse of \$5,000. All of the eight carded went to the post. The race was marked by a bit of rough riding, Richcreek cutting across in front with Algonquin when the start came and in the drive through the homestretch, when Yorkist got to St. Paul, Walls, who had the mount on the latter, bumped Yorkist a couple of times.

The latter was not to be denied, however, and finishing fast and resolutely, headed St. Paul in the final drive. The light weighted Blarney Boy was third, beaten eight lengths for second place. At the conclusion of the race a ruling came from the stewards suspending jockeys Richcreek and Walls for the meeting.

Dresden made a runaway affair of her race and after her victory she changed owners. W. Fenwick claimed her from the Gallaher Bros. for \$5,000.

Out of respect for the memory of his friend, the late Enrico Caruso, Thomas Francis ordered that the horse which he named for the operatic star be withdrawn from the fourth race. The horse seemed to have an excellent chance of winning when the track became heavy, but Francis would not allow him to carry his colors this afternoon.

## RUBY GAINS A NEW OWNER

Mrs. J. Phillips claimed Ruby, the beaten favorite in the third race, for \$2,000.

Winneconne ran in the interest of C. Buxton in the seventh race. The latter purchased her of C. Anderson this morning.

Jockey J. Cony was suspended for the remainder of the meeting by the stewards, for cutting across in front in the first race.

There is a lot of talk here over a rumor that is being circulated of a shift in the dates at the Kenilworth track. It is said that some of those interested in the Kenilworth Jockey Club are much in favor of following right in behind the next Windsor meeting, while others in the club favor sticking to the dates allotted by the Canadian Racing Associations, which means that their second meeting would be in October. Provided the Kenilworth interests decide to follow the Windsor meeting, the Devonshire Park people will put off their second meeting until the latter part of August, otherwise they will follow in a few days after the close of the next Windsor meeting.

A storm which swept across the track here a few days ago unrooted one of the stables and landed it fifty feet away. There were twenty horses in the barn at the time, but none was injured.

G. R. Bryson has shipped the jumpers Bellringer and Haran to Belmont Park, where they have been turned over to Fred Berry, who will prepare them for the fall steeplechase on the metropolitan circuit.

Jockey King was suspended for the remainder of the meeting by the stewards yesterday for rough riding on Eddie Rickenbacker.
