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FOREWORD

Urbanization—the steadily advancing process of rapid metropolitan population growth and outward expansion of cities—is bringing new problems and also new opportunities for progress to Maryland suburban and rural areas. Between 1950 and 1960, Maryland's population advanced from 2.3 million to 3.1 million—representing a rate of increase exceeded in only eight other States throughout the nation. With this population growth concentrated in urban areas, land covered by cities and densely populated suburbs in Maryland climbed from a level of only 136,000 acres in 1945 to 321,000 acres in 1959—representing a rate of urban land development exceeded in only six other states during this period. Of the 434,000 dwelling units added to the State's housing inventory between 1940 and 1960, 349,000 or 80 per cent were built in suburban or rural areas—outside cities having populations of 2,500 or more.

Such phenomenal development has far-reaching effects upon an extensive region's economy and level of living. However, it creates its greatest direct impact upon public services and facilities, business, land values and real property taxes, the availability of "open space", and efforts to plan for future development, within immediate small geographic areas such as election districts. Changes in population density in these county sub-areas are effective indicators of the relative levels of private and public action that will be required to cope with this development. Density patterns—analyzed with respect to past and projected requirements for residential sites, transportation and utility systems, industrial and military installations, commercial outlets, and other factors generating area development—reveal important planning inferences. Examples of such inferences include the expected date of area "saturation" (the optimum population level for a given area commensurate with prevailing living standards) or the probable timing and direction of peripheral population growth waves around and between urban centers.

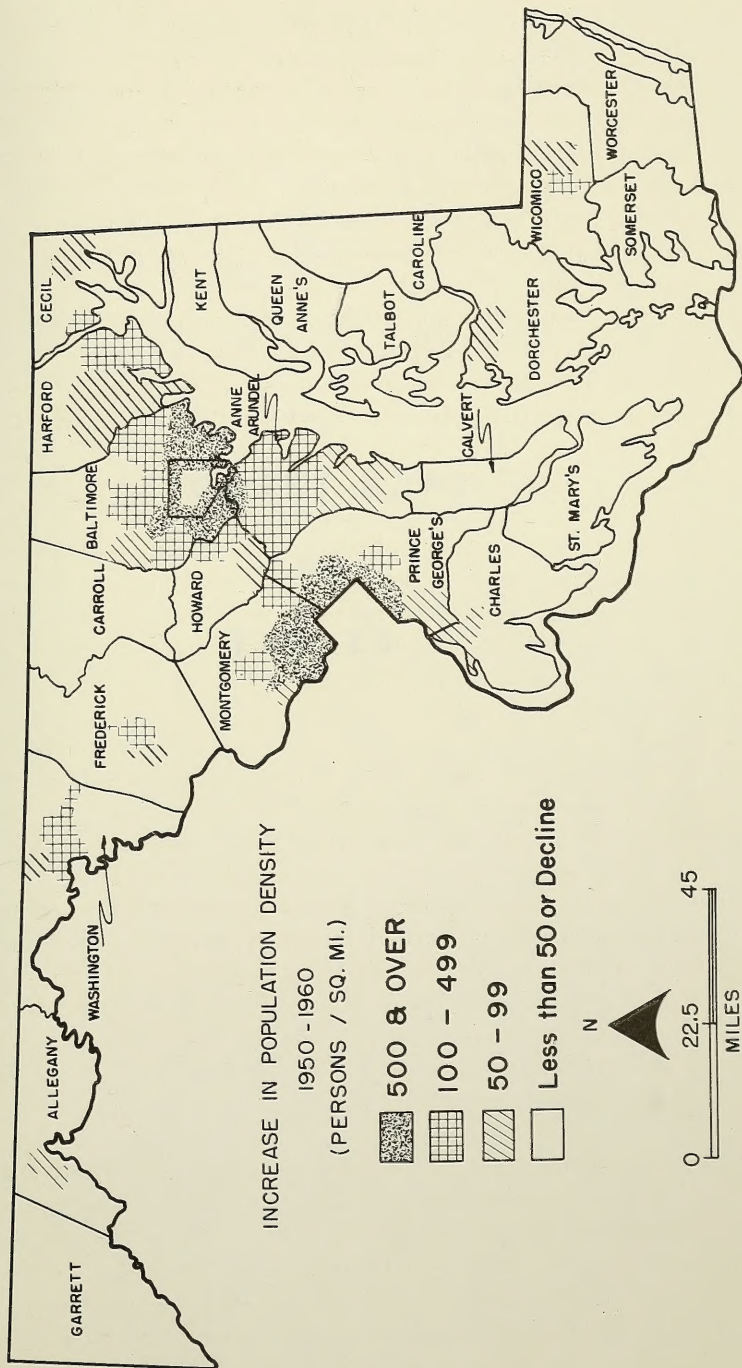
The data on population density by election districts compiled in this report are intended to assist: (1) the State's citizens in better understanding the rate and character of Maryland's population growth pattern; (2) private lending institutions, investors, and promotional groups—such as banks, home builders, realtors, and chambers of commerce—needing data for the evaluation of development proposals; and (3) legislators, other elected officials, and public agencies responsible for guiding the orderly, planned development of Maryland. The population and land area figures used in computing densities were obtained from the Bureau of Census, U. S. Department of Commerce. The election district boundaries are those as of 1960. Minor changes in election district boundaries—primarily in Anne Arundel, Montgomery, and Prince George's counties—during the period 1900 - 1960 may cause slight difficulties in the comparison of district densities over time. However, where new districts have been established, old districts abolished, or district boundaries changed in any form, corresponding adjustments in population also have been derived. Accordingly, the density levels and trends in the districts having boundary changes are believed to be substantially accurate and comparable.


In some instances, two or more election districts have been combined for purposes of this report. In order to eliminate the distortions that arise from comparing very small election districts having extremely high densities with much larger districts having less concentrated development, it was arbitrarily decided for study purposes that the minimum size of an election district (or combination of districts) would be 10.0 square miles. Districts smaller than 10.0 square miles were grouped with the contiguous district (or districts) having a density most nearly equal to the density of the smaller district.

The basic working data presented in this report are given in both tabular and map forms. The maps show changes in population density during the period 1950 - 1960 by election districts. As an aid to the identification of areas of particular significance, the maps indicate 1960 election district boundaries, primary highways, county seats, and incorporated communities having a 1960 population of 5,000 or more.

- URBANIZATION IN MARYLAND -



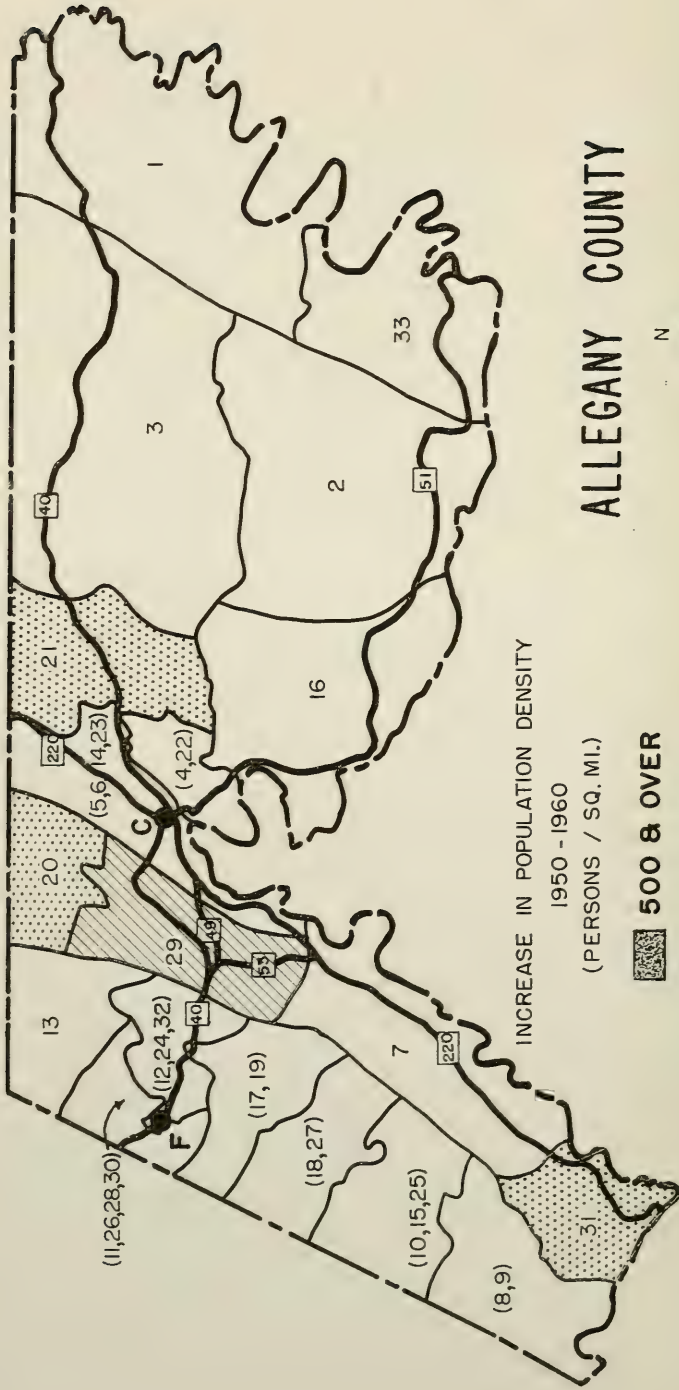

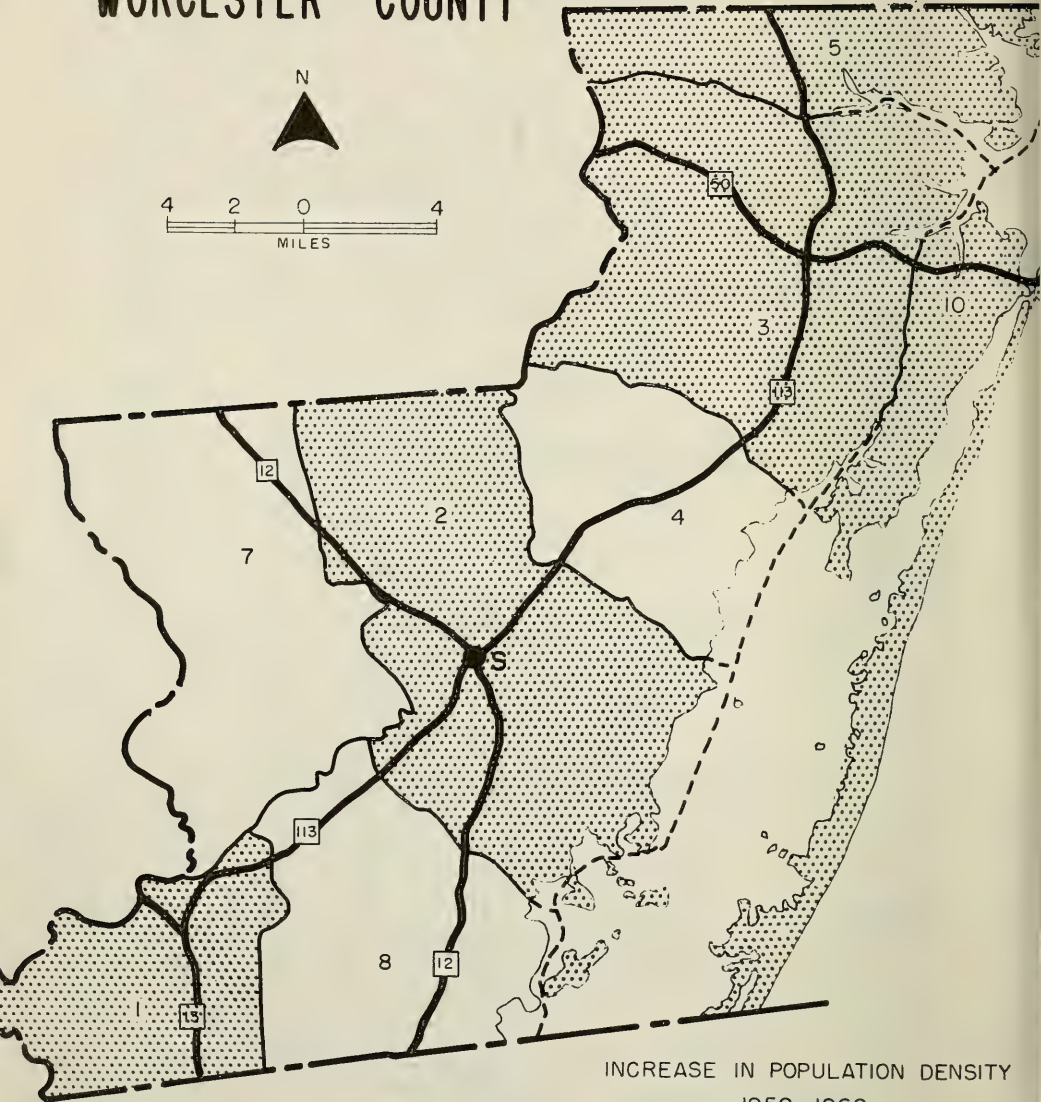
INCREASE IN POPULATION DENSITY

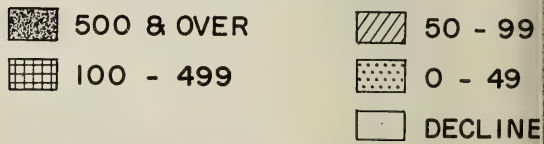
