It has been a pleasure for me to have served as your principal and to have worked with you during these past four years. I wish for each one of you the very best that life can bring in the years ahead.

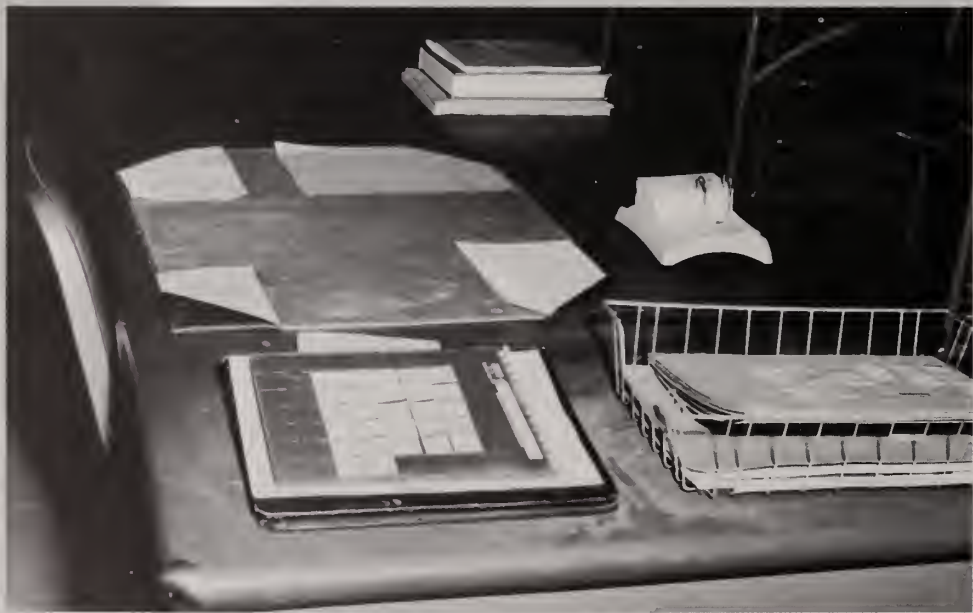
