. . . and locked with locks And labeled:



CRISIS IN THE CLASSROOM

1. INAM

The main objective of the Teacher Orientation seminar program is to give the students interested in the teaching profession an opportunity to work with pupils and to be made aware of the role of the classroom teacher. Utilizing this approach will aid the individual in making a decision as to whether he or she has made a realistic vocational choice.

Students in this program take over any classroom activity that the supervising teacher feels he or she capable of handling. The activities are varied but should include such things as observation, preparing and teaching of lessons, and individual tutoring.



OFFICE WORKERS

The Office Workers aid in the work of the secretaries. Their responsibilities are to answer phones, convey messages, and carry on other office procedures.







MATH TEAM

The Math Team works to improve skills in areas ranging from arithmetic to trigonometry, with emphasis on speed and accuracy. These students compete with students from other schools in the eastern division of the Greater Boston Mathematics League.



SCIENCE CLUB

The Science Club at Winthrop High School this year has been chiefly interested in acquainting the students with the science-oriented resources of Boston through trips to museums, exhibits, and other schools. Speakers have come to the school from colleges in the area to address the students on various subjects such as laser studies and field theories.



NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

The National Honor Society consists of members chosen from the Junior and Senior classes on the basis of proficiency in these areas: scholarship, leadership, citizenship, and character. In order for Juniors to become eligible for consideration for the W.H.S. Pullen Poynte National Honor Society they must have a B or better average in all subjects in June of the previous year and again at the end of the second marking period, in February of the following year.
