This picture was painted by Ferrandiz under the direction of his friend Fortuny. It represents the interior of Fortuny's studio at Rome in 1874. In the centre may be seen a large Spanish-Moresque vase of the XIVth century; on the left, another of the XIIth century, lacking the neck and handles. All about the studio are scattered, in infinite variety, other objects of art, statues, Gothic tapestries, Spanish-Moresque dishes, etc., etc. There are also two busts, relieved against black. The one on the left is the portrait of Fortuny, the other, that of Ferrandiz. In this picture Fortuny painted with his own hand, 1st, the plumage which crowns the large Spanish-Moresque vase standing on table; 2d, the head of the attendant who leans upon the table; 3d, the left corner of the rug in the centre; 4th, the head of the spectator who is studying through a glass the central vase.

Fortuny inadvertently upset the easel on which it rested, and in falling it upset a bottle of ink, which ran over the whole picture. Without being in the least disconcerted, Fortuny washed the picture with volatile oil, and then, with his own rapid and expert hand, restored it to the present condition in two days of labor.


