THE SITUATION IN RUSSIA.
 This morning's telegrams are not by any means of a reassuring nature, but, on the contrary, tend to show that the revolutionary movement is spreading far and wide throughout the country. The evidences of insurrection in the provinces have been suppressed by the non-publication of the newspapers, but it is known that serious disturbances have broken out at Korno and Vilna. The revolutionary movement has spread among the 5,000 sailors of the Black Sea Fleet, to whom the fir at Sebastopol arsenal is due. Meanwhile the populace of Moscow are determined to emulate the example of St. Petersburg, and the workmen in the great factories are striking out of sympathy with their comrades.
 The dissatisfaction of the educated classes, as is seen by the action of the St. Petersburg Bar, is as dangerous a symptom as the conduct of the troops, who daily refused to fire on the sailors at Sebastopol. But the most serious political symptom is the conduct of the Tsar. The one political institution in Russia is the Emperor or Autocrat. Only the Emperor can make laws; he alone has the executive and judicial power. Take away autonomy and Russian society falls into primitive chaos. To the masses of the people it is like taking the sun out of the sky. Autocracy in Russia is the necessary source of any legal change in Russian society. The attempt to start reform from any other source must inevitably produce a revolutionary condition, consisting of a prolonged warfare of class against all, and bringing in its train impoverishment and misery beyond even Russian precedent. But the Emperor has shown the world that he is utterly unable even in the present terrible crisis to rise superior to the inherent weakness of his naturally feeble character, and so he is delegated the massacre of his subjects to the most reactionary of his kinsmen, while he took refuge in the Moscow palace. Autocracy, as represented by the Tsar, has consequently now ceased to have any meaning to the people, and thus the fundamental basis of Russia's political life has been undermined.
 On the other hand, the outlook is equally deplorable from the point of view of the people themselves. For the forces of reform in Russia possess neither the strength nor the ability to the nation at large, nor the cohesion amongst themselves necessary for carrying out a general scheme of revolution. Poles, Finns, Jews, Dissenters, citizens, proprietors, peasants, are too hopelessly divided by racial and religious discord for any united action, and, in their various fears of what the future may ultimately bring forth, they possess no means for executing concerted measures.
 An equally unknown factor is the attitude of the mighty host on the Sba. He has been generally believed for the long period of inaction which has elapsed since the last great battle has been more favorable to the Russians than to the Japanese, and that Kurapatkin is now far stronger in every way than he was when he fell back on his present position. But, if we may believe the news of the "Echo of Paris," that is not the fact. A month ago, as M. Dru is informed, Kurapatkin had only 175,000 infantry, and was short of mountain guns, his losses through sickness have been much higher than the public are aware, and his army is "literally melting away." To these facts must be added the knowledge of the fall of Port Arthur, and the depression which that knowledge must produce. Moreover it will be impossible to keep Kurapatkin's army in ignorance of the internal struggle going on at home. Strange rumours of massacres in St. Petersburg, of regiments refusing to fire on their own kith and kin, of the incendiary outbreak of the men of the Black Sea Fleet at Sebastopol, these and similar rumours, rendered still more alarming by exaggeration, must have a sinister effect on the morale of the army. The continuance of an unpopular war if the Government collapses is quite out of the question.

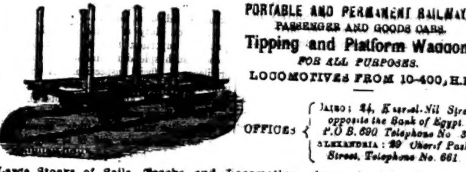

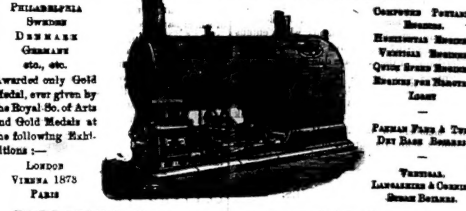
