GERMANY AND MOROCCO.
 Count von Bulow's speech in the Reichstag yesterday, an epitome of which appears in our telegram, clearly shows that Germany intends to have a finger in the Moorish pie, and from to-morrow, when the Kaiser lands at Tangier, a new development in the history of Morocco may not improbably be expected. We are informed in a telegram from Paris that the Sultan is preparing to utilize the visit to the utmost, and has already begun the stiff opposition to the French policy. The situation is one which cannot be wholly pleasing to France. She has ear-marked Morocco as her own, and she is not prepared to pull the chestnuts out of the fire for Germany, any more than for England. Her dissatisfaction will not be diminished by the Kaiser's visit to Tangier, where he is to be received with every official honor, and where the Moors will welcome him as a protector against French encroachment. Now, it is too much to say that, before the disaster to the Russian army, Germany would have been extremely warmly tender spot! It is again, not clear that it is to the interest of Germany to try to

make terms with France, who will be asked to buy off German interference in Morocco at the price of concessions, the nature of which it is not possible to specify, but which may reasonably be expected to bode no good to British trading interests when France is in a position to give valuable practical support to the trade of one Power against the trade of another! The incident is not only significant in regard to Morocco, but it is part and parcel of the entire change which must come over the political situation throughout the world from the shrinkage of Russian prestige, and the other collapse of the military power of the northern giant has set Germany free to divert her attention—if she sees fit—to sundry matters of interest to her which she could not so well look after while obsessed by the haunting dread of an attack by a Franco-Russian combination.

GERMANY'S POLICY.

Germany, therefore, intended to enter into communication with the Sultan forthwith. (H.)
