THE BRITISH OFFICER AND THE SUDAN. The reverses sustained in the early part of the South African war are popularly supposed to have done John Bull a world of good. That they taught him some useful lessons is generally admitted, but failures even when retrieved have a tendency to sour the character, and the old gentleman has lately developed a most unpleasant habit of sneering at some of his servants, who are forbidden to counter his sneers with the somewhat obvious remark that efficiency in a household is conditioned by the interest that its master takes in problems of daily management. Before the Boer war broke out the British officer was played on a pedestal

by a public which was ready to burn incense before its idols, but graded them up more before the British Army was accused by writers in newspapers of every political shade of a lack of the military virtues except brute courage, and its officers were described by a variety of amateur critics, journalistic strategists, and disaffected irregulars as being almost without exception "Moorish". The reverse of the term "gilded popajays" which called forth such horror and indignation when used by Mr. John Burns some years before Colonel. This some soldier says that he found in the British Army is unfortunately true; but they are to be found in all armies except, perhaps, the Japanese. Russia appears to have suffered heavily from their presence in Manchuria, and the increase of that type of warrior in discharging the thoughtful students and experienced organisers who form the great German General Staff. Meantime our great public, while blaming the British military system, which perhaps deserves severe censure, is cruelly unjust in extending its blame to the officers, who are often its victims, and does not appear to realise that the finest material in the world on effect little if not starved with a proper organisation and supervised by an over-zealous policy of false economy. An admirable corrective to this unfairly contemptuous attitude is to be found in Section 24 of Lord Cromer's Report on the Sudan. We read in a most interesting passage that the officers, and more especially the young officers, engaged in the Civil administration of the Sudan show an admirable versatility and a remarkable capacity for work. Nor are they mere old-bilded automatons: numerous instances, writes Lord Cromer, can be quoted of young British officers, both civil and military, who have developed in a remarkable manner the best qualities of the British race, being warm advocates of the rights of Dinka, Shillouks, or others, among whom their temporary lot may be cast. This is very pleasant reading, for it confirms our own view that the "Britishness" of the British race is of Asiatic or African subjects has been greatly exaggerated by hostile or envious critics. Nor is wanting in intellectual capacity and shrewd observation. We read of a young officer who drew up a report on the Sudan prisons which is described by Lord Cromer, who has had an unsurpassed experience of reports of every kind, as a "practical, common-sense document, which contains the essence to be culled from a mass of voluminous literature." Others have written valuable and interesting reports on the manners and customs of the negro tribes of the Sudan, on the geography of the country and its resources, or have made most valuable suggestions to the Sudan Government relating to such matters as land settlement and agricultural loans. It is pleasant to hear from an authority who has been so long in the Sudan, and whose point of view is so fairly and so judiciously presented, that the British Army contains such admirable material, and Lord Cromer's conclusion, that the less fortunate results achieved in the army simply point to a faulty system and in no way reflect on the character and capacity of the individuals who work under it, deserves to be taken to heart by the critics who speak of the average British officer as an incompetent fool or brainless soldier. It is quite hopeless to expect our Parliamentarians to take it to heart!

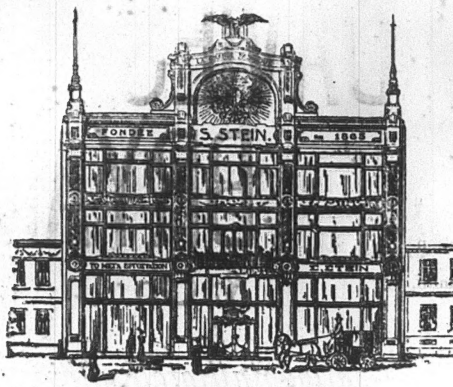
