A SETTLEMENT ARRIVED AT.

(FROM OUR OWN CORRESPONDENTS.) Manchester, August 18. The shadow of the impending crisis in the cotton industry which has been over Lancashire during the past few weeks, the seriousness of which become more and more apparent as the climax approached, has lifted, and there is joy throughout the County Palatine to-day.

The credit for the striking about this most unfortunate crisis, which has done so much to do in a great measure to the Lord Mayor of Manchester, Sir Thomas Thornhill Shann, (who was knighted by King Edward on his recent visit to Manchester). From the outset Sir Thomas, realizing how disastrous to the trade of the county a strike would be, set himself the task of trying to bring about an amicable arrangement between employers and employed.

He addressed a letter to the Masters' and Operatives' organizations in which he invited them to a joint conference at the Town Hall, and urged upon them the importance of straining every nerve to avoid a strike which would involve losses and privation, and the transferring their constant of funds now in their own hands.

The invitation to a conference was accepted by both organizations, and the meeting of representatives took place on Wednesday, the delegates, numbering 40, were entertained in the Town Hall by the Lord Mayor, who in a very practical speech asked that not a wider view of the matter be discussed than that which concerned their own personal interests.

The conference proceeded, and the work was very slow, the various points at issue being keenly debated on both sides. There was a short interval for tea, after which the proceedings were continued until nearly seven o'clock.

The Lord Mayor then called into the conference, and an outbreak of cheering accompanied those waiting outside that a settlement had been made.

The agreement entered into between the parties was to the effect that the operatives, outside the Bolton area, receive a bonus of 8 per cent for twelve weeks, at the end of which period the parties will again meet to discuss further arrangements.

The following is the official report issued by Mr. J. Smeethurst, secretary of the Employees' Federation:

At a joint conference held in the Manchester Town Hall on the 16th and 17th August between representatives of the Federation of Master Cotton Spinners' Associations, the Amalgamated Association of Operative Cotton Spinners, the Amalgamated Association of Card and Blowing Room Operatives, and the Amalgamated Northern Counties Association of Weavers, Wappers, and Winders, on the one hand, and the Bolton area on the other.

(1) That the Federation withdraw its application for a 5 per cent reduction in the Bolton area.

(2) That the operatives withdraw their application for a 5 per cent advance in wages in the Federation area, exclusive of Bolton.

(3) That the Federation agree to a 5 per cent bonus to be paid for twelve weeks from the first pay-day in September, paid monthly, at all Federation mills, exclusive of those in the Bolton area.

(4) That at the end of the twelve weeks the bonus shall continue up to the 1st March, 1906, after which date either side shall be at liberty to take whatever action it may think desirable with regard to a wage advance or reduction.

(5) That the joint committee meet together as early as possible for the purpose of framing some scheme for the automatic regulation of wages in the future.
