NEW CYPRUS RAILWAY.

OPENING CEREMONY.

(FROM OUR CORRESPONDENT.)

Nicosia, Nov. 2. One of the most important events which have taken place in Cyprus for a long while was the inauguration of the first division of the Cyprus Government Railway on 31st October last.

The ceremony took place at Famagusta. His Excellency the High Commissioner and Lady King-Harman, with the leading officials and other invited guests, left Nicosia in two special trains, which, running at about 20 m.p.h. an hour, brought them to Famagusta at 11 a.m.

The formal opening of the line was then made by the High Commissioner, who wished it every success. He was then presented by the resident engineer, who is also now appointed general manager, with an electric train staff as a souvenir of the occasion.

ARTESIAN WELL BORING. It is regrettable that the artesian well boring at Nicosia has had to be temporarily suspended. The boring has been carried to a depth of some 430 feet, but as it has not yet struck a rocky stratum fresh lengths of piping have to be ordered, and the work is, for the time being, at a standstill.

SUCCESSFUL GYMKHANA. A most successful Gymkhana was held on 28th October on the polo ground, Nicosia. There were a fairly large number of entries, and a most pleasant and enjoyable afternoon was spent. Unfortunately the proceedings were somewhat marred by an accident to Capt. O'G., A.D.C. to his Excellency, whose horse caught his foot in a hole, causing the rider to fall and break his arm.

THE RUGBY REVIVAL. NEW ZEALANDERS' LATEST VICTORY. The New Zealanders beat Oxford yesterday by 47 to 0, bringing their total score to 540 against 15. The success of the New Zealanders have led to what in some quarters is a sort of religious revival. They have made certain critics rant as if Rugby football were the only thing worth doing in the world.
