LONDON, January 6.

At Derby, Mr. Chamberlain, after fighting with continuous interruptions for nearly an hour, was shouted down. His speech, which was on the subject of Colonial preference, was practically inaudible.

Speaking in the City, Mr. Hildesheim announced that the Sir Henry Campbell-Bannerman had given him a free hand to reorganise the army. He said that Sir Henry laid much stress on the fact that he was prepared, if he thought it requisite, to spend more to get more men.

Speaking at Sheffield, Mr. Asquith said that the expense of the nation have increased by £20,000,000 in ten years, of which half was for the army and navy. A wide field exists for the reduction of taxes, including those on coal, tea, sugar, and the income tax. (Telegraph.)
