### WHAT IS WHISKY?

The decision of the London magistrates. Mr. Forbes had been asked on the subject of the whisky problem in discussion as mentioned in the following article from the "Daily Telegraph" on this epoch making decision which therefore be read with interest. It may be as well to state at once that intemperance is a mild form by which to describe the feeling excited in some quarters by the magistrats' proposition. Needless to say, however, opinion is divided on the subject. In one direction there is something like jubilation at the result of the Lillingston case. In others it would hardly be too much to say that consternation has been manifested. It seems, after all, that the question really ought to be—"Whisky not whisky?" But, inasmuch as the whole problem turns on complications and technicalities—a "blood" is an avoided at all costs—a close occupation of the main issue is at least desirable. Let it be understood, then, that these are, roughly, the details of the feeling excited in some quarters by the magistrats' proposition. Needless to say, however, opinion is divided on the subject. In one direction there is something like jubilation at the result of the Lillingston case. In others it would hardly be too much to say that consternation has been manifested. It seems, after all, that the question really ought to be—"Whisky not whisky?" But, inasmuch as the whole problem turns on complications and technicalities—a "blood" is an avoided at all costs—a close occupation of the main issue is at least desirable. Let it be understood, then, that these are, roughly, the details of the feeling excited in some quarters by the magistrats' proposition.

Certainly there is ample evidence that a large section of the public favour the mild "whisky" (the description hereafter used to be a kind of "whisky" which is produced from a blend of "valent" spirit and malt. Not a fluid of which 100 per cent. is composed of the same, and is not, as the old word, "malt," it will be generally conceded, a good deal to be desired. It was asserted last week that 70 per cent. of the "Scottish" whisky put upon the market consists of grain spirit. And it is further claimed that the "whisky" prepared for exportation to the Continent, in the greater part of cases, is more than 100 per cent. composed of grain spirit. This would seem to be a matter in which some form of "legislation" might come into the approval of the present Government.

This decision means, paradoxically enough, that a good many thousands of people who have been drinking "whisky" ever since their eyes are open may now find themselves and consequently their wives and children—may be, with the reflection that they have probably

FRENCH CABINET CRISIS.

CAUSED BY SEPARATION LAW.

The Chamber has rejected by 287 votes against 124 an order of the day approving the declaration of the Government on the subject of the application of the law for the separation of the churches from the State.

M. Rouvier stated that the Government would not take any part in the continuance of the debate and left the House, followed by the other Ministers.

M. Falloux has accepted the resignation of the Cabinet. The majority of 287 votes included the whole of the Right, half of the Progressives, with M. Ribot, most of the Socialists, and a number of Radical Socialists.

FRANCO CHAMBER. MINISTER'S BELLICOSE SPEECH. PARIS, March 7. CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES.—During the discussion on the Naval Estimates M. Loucheur was charged for his speech declaring that the naval programme was inadequate and pledging on the improvement of the navy in the event of war with Germany.
