CONSULS AND BRITISH TRADE.
 Mr. Consul Waugh, reporting on the trade of Constantinople, mentions that last summer he visited, at the suggestion of the Board of Trade, the Chambers of Commerce of Sheffield, Bradford, and Manchester, with a view to finding what kind of information manufacturers and merchants look for in Consular trade reports, and in what other respects Consular assistance can promote British trade.

In his report, just published, Mr. Waugh shows his willingness to forward British trade interests in many ways that other Consuls disdain. He states, for instance, that while it is outside any Consul's power to see for a trader's debts, there are various ways in which unofficial persuasion or pressure can be brought to bear upon debtors, and where possible this is done. If this fails, he recommends a lawyer who can take legal proceedings, and by treaty the Consulate has the official right to watch lawsuits undertaken by British subjects before the Turkish courts. Mr. Waugh, in fact, invites inquiries on such questions, as well as on the advisability of giving credit, and on the employment of competent agents. Moreover, he has sent during the year confidential communications to firms interested in special trades.

If other Consuls adopt this sympathetic attitude to British traders a revolution would gradually be wrought in the Consular service. It is clear that the Foreign Office places no obstacles in the way, but, on the other hand, Mr. Waugh's report shows that everything depends on the Consul himself. It is noticeable that Mr. Waugh again emphasizes the importance of British manufacturers sending out efficient travellers. Of our total import trade into Turkey in 1904 no less than 64 per cent. consisted of cotton piece-goods and yarns, and in some measure this is due to the Armenian and Greek houses established in Manchester—which is testimony to the economic value of at least one section of our alien population. But German and Italian rivals are persevering, and a warning is given. Great Britain still does nearly twice as much trade with Turkey as any other country, but in the last quinquennium our exports increased only 33 per cent., while German exports increased 130 per cent.

TO-DAY'S TELEGRAMS.

ARMY REFORM.

QUESTION OF THE MILITIA.

LONDON, March 19. HOUSE OF COMMONS.—During the discussion on the Army Estimates, Mr. Haldane said that something would have to be done to make the Militia an adequate support to the reserve.

Mr. A. Forster said that the late Government was actually carrying out several economies which Mr. Haldane was now advocating. He objected to Mr. Haldane assuming credit for this.

HOUSES OF LORDS.—Lord Hardinge called attention to the shortage of 1,045 officers and 36,000 men in the Militia. Lord Portmouth said that the Government was anxious to remedy the objections to officers of the Militia being controlled by regulars and he was seriously considering this question. He hoped that further assistance would be afforded by the Universities and Lord Lieutenants in getting officers.

RUSSIAN NATIONAL ASSEMBLY.

ST. PETERSBURG, March 19. The preliminary elections for the National Assembly commenced yesterday throughout the greater part of Russia: perfect tranquillity prevailed.

REVOLUTION IN POLAND.

WARSAW, March 19. Constant outrages and disorders continue in Poland. An armed mob attacked the prison in the centre of the city, and released a political prisoner; a warder was killed and two others wounded. A passenger train was deliberately derailed and five persons injured. 120 pounds of dynamite have been discovered under a bridge.

LIBERT. SCHMIDT EXECUTED.

SEVASTOPOL, March 19. Lieutenant Schmidt has been executed.

SOCIALISM IN GERMANY.

BERLIN, March 19. One hundred and five Socialist meetings took place here yesterday to celebrate the revolution of 1848. The proceedings passed off quietly.

PUNITIVE EXPEDITION AT KANO.

LAGOS, March 17. A strong punitive expedition is concentrating at Kano against the powerful Emir of Hadjia in North Nigeria, who is persistently hostile to the British.

THE COURRIERES STRIKE.

LENS, March 19. There are 46,000 strikers at La Courrière. They have rejected the concessions offered by the masters and are becoming disorderly.

FRANCE AND ALEXANDRIA.

PARIS, March 19. The Chamber of Deputies has adopted the projected bill approving of the convention between France and the city of Alexandria.

FRENCH CHAMBER.

PARIS, March 19. The Chamber of Deputies has voted the budget of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. M. Bourgeois declared that he would continue M. Rouvier's pacific policy.

CHARING X STATION OPEN.

LONDON, March 19. Charing Cross station has been reopened to traffic.
