OUR CONSULS. Mr. Ernest E. Williams makes some suggestions in "The Standard" for improving our consular system, from the point of view of the commercial world.

as well as of the Foreign Office, and he would compel them to pass examinations before appointment. Consuls, he argues, should be snappet out into two divisions—those in which owing to the lack of commerce or the preponderating character of other matters demanding the Consul's attention (such, for example, as certain of the posts in the Near East), the Board of Trade would not need to interfere, and the candidate would not need to hold a commercial diploma; and those in which commerce is of importance. To the former class the Foreign Office could appoint, with or without power of veto in the Board of Trade; to the other the Board of Trade could appoint, with simply power of veto in the Foreign Office.

ASSOCIATED COTTON GINNERS OF EGYPT.

The following report was submitted to the shareholders at the annual general meeting, held at the head office of the Associated Cotton Ginners of Egypt, Limited, in the Alexandria Central Buildings in Alexandria on Thursday last, the 10th inst. :-

In accordance with Article No. 143 of your Articles of Association, the directors have the honour to submit the annexed first statement of accounts covering a period of 9 1/2 months, namely from 15th June 1905 to 31st March 1906. At the formation of the company you possessed 15 ginning factories, of which the accompanying statement will give you the details, but of these 15 factories your board have considered it advisable to close two, in order to work only such factories as were most necessary for the economical working of the company. The past crop of Egyptian cotton, which we in common with all other people interested in cotton, even up to the end of last September, had hoped to see a big one, has unfortunately turned out one that will not reach 6,000,000 cantars. However, notwithstanding the short crop, we have every reason to be satisfied with the work that has fallen to the company. In fact the factories have ginned during the season cantars 1,773,247, 73/100, and we have pressed in our steam presses cantars 733,109,21/100. The Board have to state that owing to the insufficient capacity of the factory at Mansourah, the company lost

the ginning of about 150,000 cantars belonging to clients, which had to be ginned elsewhere. This, however, will not be repeated in the future, as we are building a new factory at Mansourah with 80 gins. On the other hand, at Zagazig, owing to the inferior quality of the cotton, our work at the four factories there this season has been reduced.

We, now, Gentlemen, propose that you should pass the report, balance sheet, and accounts up to the 31st March 1906. In accordance with Article 145 of the Articles of Association, the Board have accepted with regret the resignation of the first auditor, Mr. Petrovich, and temporarily elected Mr. Petermuller in his stead, in order that the books of the company and the accounts now presented to you should be verified. We propose, for your election, Mr. Petermuller

as Auditor for the ensuing year, and the amount of his remuneration is left for you to fix. Before closing this report, the Directors desire to record their appreciation of the services of Mr. Alex. Th. Kitroeff and consider themselves fortunate in having found a man of his experience as manager of so important an undertaking as ours.

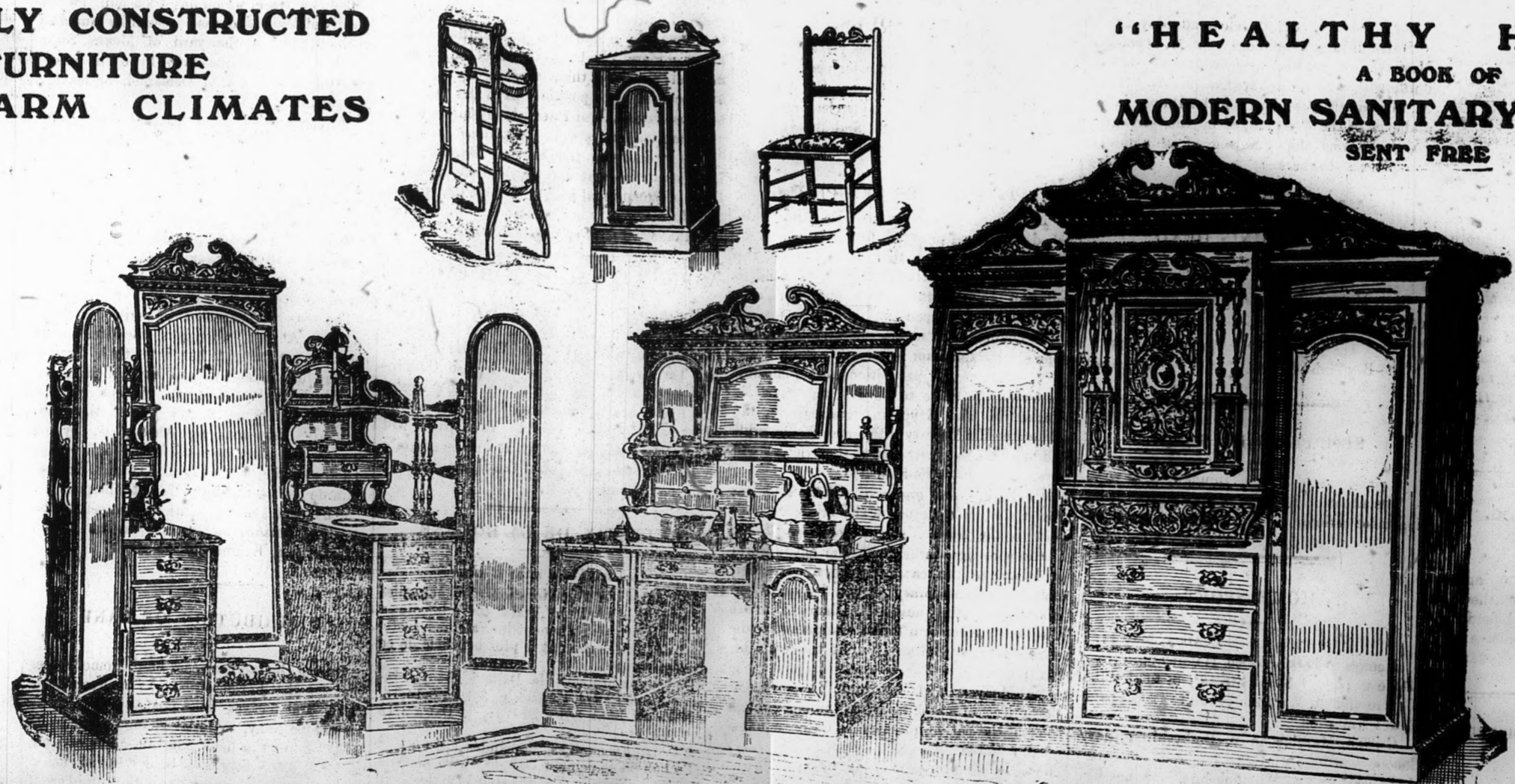
