







TO-DAY'S TELEGRAMS.

RUSSIAN REIGN OF TERROR.

AUTHORITIES POWERLESS.

SOLDIERS ATTACK JEWS.

WARSAW, August 17. After the disturbances on Wednesday the soldiers, in the evening, attacked the Jews, killing or wounding 250 of them. (Reuter)

St. Petersburg, August 17. The reign of terror is general throughout Russia. The police are powerless and the Government is incapable of dealing with the situation. (Reuter)

WARSAW, August 17. A street boy yesterday evening threw a petard into a crowd of pilgrims here and wounded two of them, whereupon an infantry patrol rushed up and fired a volley into the midst of the crowd, wounding 38 persons. (P)

EARTHQUAKE AT VALPARAISO.

SERIOUS DAMAGE DONE.

VALPARAISO, August 17. An earthquake has taken place here. It was at first thought to be most serious and similar to that of San Francisco; this, however, seems to be an exaggeration, although some damage has been done and a panic occurred. (Reuter)

PARIS, August 17. It is reported from Valparaiso that serious earthquake have taken place. It is feared that there are numerous victims. (Reuter)

SEPARATION LAW IN FRANCE.

GOVERNMENTS' ATTITUDE.

PARIS, August 17. In a speech delivered here, M. Briand, Minister of Public Works, stated that the Government was determined to enforce the separation law. Some of its measures, he said, would meet with resistance, and probably be a disagreeable surprise to certain persons. (R)

ENGLAND AND GERMANY.

PARIS, August 17. The newspapers of Cologne state that the Emperor William and King Edward had important interviews, but that, however, no agreement was come to. (Havas)

WILHELMSCHEIT, August 17. Count von Bismarck arrived here this morning, and was in conference with the Emperor William. (Reuter)

ARMY AND NAVY.

(FROM OUR CORRESPONDENT.)

LONDON, August 6. It is officially intimated that the 3rd Battalion Coldstream Guards, Brevet Colonel G.R.P. Smith commanding, with details for various regiments in Egypt, will embark on the S.S. Stella at Southampton about the 27th September for Cairo, where the Coldstreamers are to be stationed prior to disembarkment. The Stella will reach Alexandria on the 11th October and will leave the following day with the 1st Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers on board for Malta. Arriving at Valetta on the 15th October, she will leave the same day for England with the 1st Battalion Rifle Brigade, bound for Belfast.

The vacancy for a captain in the 16th Infantry Brigade, caused by the death of the ill-fated Captain B.L. Partridge, by the promotion of Lieutenant J.W.F. Tarrant. Captain Tarrant received his first appointment in the line in the 1st Battalion South African Infantry (South Africa) in November, 1895, and was a considerable services in the South African War of 1900-2, including the operations in Orange River Colony, and the Transvaal and Cape Colony (Queen's medals with three clasps, King's medal with two clasps).

Major R. G. T. B. Carr, Rifle Brigade, serving lately with the Rifle Depot, Winchester, has taken his retired pay after over 18 years' service in the "Greenjackets." He is said to be camp to the Indian Viceroy from July, 1897, to November, 1903.

Two substitutes of the 20th Hussars have just been promoted to captaincies—Captain A. W. Jennings Bramly and J. C. Bott—after the exceptionally long substitutes' service of eleven years and a half and ten years and eight months respectively. Captain Jennings Bramly, who is presently serving with the Khedive's Army, entered the Royal Scots Greys in March, 1885, and the same year transferred to the 1st King's Dragoon Guards, and the 20th Hussars in succession. From September, 1902, till September, 1904, he was employed with the King's African Rifles, and on the expiration of this two years' tour, joined the Khedive's Army. He is presently employed as an Inspector of the Mongalia Province, with the rank of Bimbaibi.

Captains H. C. Warr, D.S.O., A. R. Loth, Lieutenants E. A. Bradford, F. A. Partridge, C. V. L. Fox, and A. J. Hunter, King's Royal Rifle Corps, have passed the examination for promotion to the next higher rank.

Lieutenant H. Beaumont, Lancashire Fusiliers, has been seconded for service with the Egyptian Army.

The orders for the 1st Battalion the Queen's Own Royal West Kent Regiment to proceed from Malta to Belfast in the coming troping season has been cancelled, and instead the 2nd Battalion Royal Scots Regiment, now in Cairo, will replace the 1st Battalion Royal Fusiliers in the latter city. The latter may be interested to add that the 1st Battalion of the Royal Scots Regiment, when raised in 1702, was raised at Belfast, by the then Earl of Donagall, for a considerable period it was known as the Belfast Regiment.

The 2nd Battalion King's Royal Rifle Corps will move from Raikhet to Jubulpore in the coming cold season.

The practice of non-commissioned officers of the 1st Battalion the Queen's Own Royal West Kent Regiment wearing the new peaked cap for walking out purposes is to be discontinued until the cap is generally issued to the army. It seems that a large number of these caps were purchased privately by the wearers.

Since Lord Charles Berosford took over the command of the Mediterranean Fleet it has improved greatly in gunnery. The brilliant performance of the destroyer "Brosier" has attracted considerable attention in naval circles. The gunners of this destroyer, firing with the 6-pounder quickfiring gun, hit the mark 46 times out of 58 rounds, and six hits out of eight with the 12-pounder. The cruiser Barbam with her 4.7 guns made 42 hits in 58 rounds, and the Venus 79 hits in 98 rounds—a great improvement in both since last year.

The first-class battleship Montagu, which has been lost to the fighting strength of the navy by the decision of the Admiralty not to expend further money in attempting to save what was a wreck from the first—thereby confirming our forecast of a week ago—represents a loss of £1,046,999, which was her original cost when she was built at Devonport in 1903. During the salvage operations, a further sum of £50,000 was spent on her. The Montagu had a displacement of 14,000, a speed of 18.8 knots, and she

carried an armament of four 12-inch guns, two 6-inch guns, and 21 smaller guns, and a crew of 750. Her maiden commission was spent on the Mediterranean Station.

If Parliament was sitting the loss of the Montagu would provide the material for the most searching interrogations as to whether it was a contingency taken into consideration when its naval shipbuilding programme was decided on. Naval experts do not at all like the naval policy of the Government. They respect the soundness of their two-power standard theory, and the Prime Minister's rejection of a possible combination of France and Germany against us is regarded as a fortunate piece of optimism, and an ignoring of the elementary tenets of their two-power more probable in international affairs than the unexpected. When Parliament assembles, numerous questions on the subject will be asked for the purpose of ascertaining what the two-power standard really is. The fact that both Germany and France, on the admission of the Secretary of the Admiralty, are building ships faster than we is not considered reassuring. Meanwhile our navy is one first-class battleship the less effective by the loss of the Montagu.

NOTES ET CRITIQUES.

Le Caire, 17 Août.

A Londres, le Cansulé anglais est resté, hier encore, invarié à 84 1/8. L'Unité est en hausse de 1/4 à 104 3/4. "Le National Bank a perdu 1/4 à 25. L'Agricole et la Daira sont demeurés inchangés à 9 7/8 et 16 7/8. La Delta Light est renouée en réaction de 1/8 à 11 3/4.

A Paris, l'action Crédit Foncier Egyptian a gagné 2 francs à 758 et le Banque d'Athènes a fléchi à 149.

Ici, le marché des valeurs a été, ce matin, calme avec une certaine tendance à la lourdeur, par moments, sur les valeurs dirigeantes. Il y a eu, toutefois, assez d'animation sur divers autres titres, et quelques uns d'entre eux ont bénéficié d'une plus-value.

Le National Bank a fini au même prix qu'hier, soit 26 26 1/16. L'Agricole est resté inchangé en clôture à 9 3/4-13/16. La Cassa di Sconto a réagi à 226 l'action ancienne et à 216 la nouvelle. Le Banque d'Athènes a été échangée à 147 1/2 et le Banque d'Orient à 132 1/2. Le Comptoir Financier est encore mouli à 6 1/2 l'action ancienne et 6 1/4 la hou velle; la part de fondateur est revenue à 44.45.

L'action Crédit Foncier a été moins fermée à 758-760; l'obligation à titre ancienne a reculé à 356.

La Nile Land a gagné 1/4 de livre à 13 3/4-13/16. La part de fondateur Agricole du Nil a fléchi à 7 1/4 et l'action Union Financière à 6 1/4. Les Allotments ont coté à 3 7/16-1/2.

L'action Entreprises Immobilières et de Travaux a été rochochée à 4 9/16-1/4. En bon marché, la Brasserie des Pyramides de passé de 130 à 134-135.

Les Héliopolites ont atteint 322; la part de fondateur est restée à 9 3/8.

La part Bourse Khédiviale du Caire a été négociée à 110-112, c'est-à-dire en hausse de 10 à 12 livres.

Dans le groupe des valeurs hôtelières, les Nougivich ont coté à 17. Les Égyptiens et les Upper Egypt se sont maintenus, sans affaires, à leurs prix d'hier.

Parmi les petites valeurs, les Delta Land ont coté fermes à 3 9/16 pour atteindre 3 21/32 et finir à 3 13/32-1/2. On est sans informations certaines sur les explications qui ont dû être données à l'assemblée ordinaire tenue hier à Londres. Les Estates sont restés stationnaires à 11 13/16-7/8; la part de fondateur a progressé à 11 3/8-1/2. Les Walker and Moinarachi ont fléchi à 0 5/8-1/16 et les Constructions à 1 7/16. Les Khedivial Mail ont avancé à 35 sh. 6 et les New Egyptian à 29 sh. 3.
