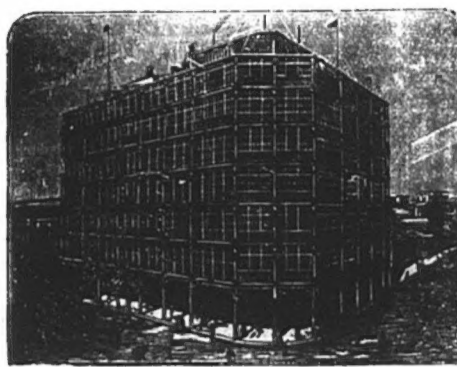

THE CALIPHATE.

An interesting point has been raised by Canon McColl, who maintains that the Sultan of Turkey is not, and never has been, Caliph; that the spiritual power is vested solely in the Sheik-ul-Islam. The importance of the point exists in the fact that were the Sultan truly Caliph Mohammedans in every country would be compelled to obey his orders and fight against their rulers. Canon McColl's assertion is supported by the fact that when Abdal Hamid inaugurated his great Pan-Islamic crusade, although some success was won among lesser tribes, the Sultans of Morocco and Zanzibar laughed to scorn the emissaries of the "Shadow of God" and "Refuge of the World"—by which unassuming titles the Sultan is known. The supreme spiritual head of the Church in Turkey is the Sheik-ul-Islam. The relations between himself and the Sultan are of a complicated, even grimly ludicrous, character, unparalleled throughout the world.

The Caliph must be of the Prophet's tribe, but that distinction cannot be claimed for the Sultan. Seeing that mothers of Turkish Sultans are almost invariably slaves, there is very little but plebeian blood left in the Turkish royal family. Still, heir he is born, and, with miraculous luck, Sultan he becomes. As such it is his privilege to lay hands upon the relics of Mohamed. This the Sheik-ul-Islam may not do. Now, the Sultan nominates, and may depose, the Sheik-ul-Islam. But this is a reciprocal arrangement, for if the Sultan's amiable subjects determine to murder or otherwise efface their lord they may not do so until the formal written permission of the Sheik-ul-Islam has been given. Moreover, if he wishes to make any appeal to the Faithful, he must so appeal through this potent priest. Without the consent of the latter he cannot promulgate any new dogms, neither can he alter any item of the Islamic ritual. He must have this high dignity about him, and must appoint him; but, having made the appointment, he has set up his own master and given into his hands the mastery of his life and death.

RUSSIAN REVOLUTION.

ANTI-GOVERNMENT COMBINE.

MILITARY TERRORISTS

St. PETERSBURG, September 4. All the revolutionary organizations have combined in one solid anti-government body. (P.)

ODESSA, September 4. A military terrorist organization has been discovered which had for its aim the extermination of all authorities and the co-operation of all revolutionaries. Fourteen officers have been arrested. (Reuter)

GENERAL STOSSSEL.

THE COURT-MARTIAL

St. PETERSBURG, September 4. A Ukase has summoned General Stossel to court-martial. (Havas)

GERMANY'S POLICY.

PRINCE BUELOW'S STATEMENT.

LONDON, September 4. The "Daily Mail" has published the account of an interview with Prince von Buelow, who is reported to have repudiated the idea that Germany thinks of competing with England for the mastery of the sea; her object was merely commercial rivalry. He declared that Germany's interests in Persia and the Bagdad railway were purely commercial. The King and the Emperor William at their recent meeting did not discuss acute political questions, as such did not exist between England and Germany. The meeting marked an auspicious stage on the road to the elimination of misunderstandings. (Foster)

MR. HALDANE IN BERLIN.

LUNCH WITH KAISER.

BERLIN, September 4. Mr. Haldane lunched with the Emperor William and subsequently had a lengthy interview with the Minister of Foreign Affairs. (Foster)

NATAL'S TROUBLES.

THE GOVERNOR CONGRATULATED.

DURBAN, September 4. Lord Elgin has sent to the Governor a congratulatory message appreciating the courage and self-restraint with which the recent emergencies were met. (Reuter)

BRITISH FLEET.

NEW BATTLESHIP LAUNCHED.

LONDON, September 4. The battleship Lord Nelson has been launched at Yarrow. (Reuter)

FRENCH MANOEUVRES.

BRITISH OFFICERS PRIVILEGED.

PARIS, September 4. General French and the other English officers attending the manoeuvres were greatly privileged, being the only foreign officers admitted to the deliberations of the empires. (Reuter)

FRANCE'S RELIGIOUS CRISIS.

EPISCOPACY AND POPE.

PARIS, September 4. The bishops have held an important conference to consider their attitude to the question of public worship, in conflict between the Pope and the French Government. (Reuter)

PARIS, September 4. A plenary meeting of the French Episcopacy was held this morning and sent to the Pope a telegram of filial obedience. (Havas)

MALTESE INFANT MORTALITY.

Many persons begin to be appalled by the infant mortality of Malta. They give expression to their alarm and anxiety in the local newspapers, particularly in the Italian section of them. It is not clear how the frightful loss of infant lives is caused nor how it can be lessened. Official statistics just published show the general death-rate to have been for the last governmental year 26 per 1,000 of the population, whereas children under one year have perished at the rate of 244 for every 1,000 born. The death-rate of children under five years of age amounts to 53 per cent. of the general death-rate.

AMERICAN INSURANCE SCANDALS.

The international policyholders' committee, according to the "New York Tribune," is beginning an investigation in France, Germany, and Great Britain to discover whether the Mutual Life and the New York have violated the law by failing to file policyholders' lists. Repeated complaints have reached the committee from men interested in the policyholders' movement in these countries that they have been unable to obtain proper lists.
