MONEY AND SHARE MARKET

(FROM OUR FINANCIAL CORRESPONDENT.)

London, February 22.

The Money Market.

While the financial weather report may be still described as cloudy, there is an entire absence of storm-clouds, and the atmosphere appears to be getting brighter every day.

The efforts which are being made in banking circles in the matter of strengthening the gold reserve, and which were referred to by Mr. Asquith last night in the House of Commons, while they may not produce an agreement of any importance, are sufficient to indicate a comprehension on the part of the leading bankers of the desirability of not attempting to finance America in London.

Although the Bank return shows a loss in the proportion of cash to liabilities, it is still a very strong one, and foreign exchanges being in favour of London, it is likely, if the rate is maintained, that the Bank will be in an exceptionally strong position during the next few months.

The Stock Markets.

The content of a financial journal yesterday asked the question "What is the matter with markets?" That is a problem which is puzzling many members of the Stock Exchange who are totally unable to give an adequate reason why, at a time when conditions are apparently highly favourable, investment business should be so conspicuous by its absence.

Americans.

The tone of the American market has not been so satisfactory as during last week. The impending Harriman examination has had a weakening influence on some of the stocks, notably Union Pacific, which up to Wednesday night had lost 4 1/2.

Egyptians.

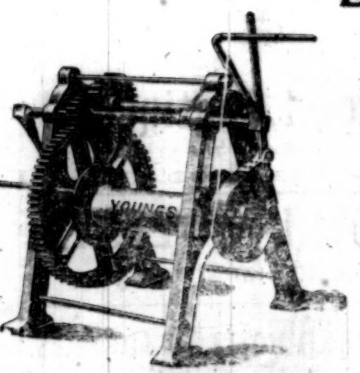
