TELEGRAMS.

THE NEW DUMA.

INDEPENDENT REPRESENTATION REDUCED.

ST. PETERSBURG, June 17. The new law strengthens the representation of intelligent classes in electoral assemblies and reduces the number of the unrepresented. It is hoped by this means to diminish the number of uneducated members of the Duma and to introduce more already experienced in local government. Each class elects only its own particular members, thus peasants and workmen cannot be represented by outside agitators, as at present.

ST. PETERSBURG, June 17. 9 deputies out of 16 whose arrest M. Stolypin demanded in the Duma have been arrested, including their leader M. Ozol.

OUTRAGES ON THE RAND.

NON-STRIKERS MALTREATED.

JOHANNESBURG, June 17. A number of serious outrages on non-strikers on the Rand have occurred. A foreman's house was blown up by dynamite and the man killed. Others were ambushed and fired upon, or seized and sjamboked.

THE FRENCH CHAMBER.

TAX ON SUGAR.

PARIS, June 17. The Council of Ministers has drawn up measures for the wine-growing departments. The agitators will be dealt with. M. Sarraut has resigned the Secretaryship of the Chamber.

ANGLO-FRANCO-SPANISH AGREEMENT.

PARIS, June 12. M. Pichon in the course of an interview said that the Franco-Spanish treaty was a natural sequel to the previous agreements regarding Morocco and the Far East, France wishing to guarantee her possessions in the Pacific, Atlantic, and Mediterranean.

PARIS, June 17. The Franco-Spanish and Anglo-Spanish agreements concerning the Mediterranean and Atlantic have been notified to the Powers.

THE SLEEPING SICKNESS.

LONDON, June 17. A conference of African colonies and protectorates, convened by the Colonial Office, met here to-day to discuss international measures for dealing with the sleeping sickness. Germany, France, Portugal, the Sudan, and the Congo Free State were represented.

TELEGRAMS.

WASHINGTON, June 17. A private telegram received here confirms that Viscount Aoki will be recalled. (Reuter)

TROUBLE IN PERSIA.

TEHRAN, June 17. The opposing faction fired on the refugees in the British Consulate at Kermanshah with the result that the legations have made representations to the Government. An effectual protection of the Consulate has been ordered by the Government.

TEHRAN, June 17. The dragoman of the Turkish Consulate has been shot dead. His murderer has escaped.

MAYORAL VISIT TO BERLIN.

BERLIN, June 17. The Lord Mayor of London and fifty members of the Corporation have arrived. They will be guests of the Municipality for a week. They received a hearty welcome.

KING OF DENMARK.

PARIS, June 17. The Danish Sovereigns have left for Berlin. (Havas)

ARRESTS IN RUSSIA.

WARSAW, June 17. Numerous arrests of Socialists and Nationalists have been made here.
