the greateast modern British man of science the greatest modern British man of science,
who was as supreme in his own line as was
Pasteur in Prance and Von Germany. Lord Kelvin was born in Belfast in 1824, and came of Scotol-Irish race of Ulster

matics in the Royal Academical Institute,
