We have determined that your request seeks records that are exempt from disclosure under the CPRA because they contain proprietary information, deliberative process privileged information, personnel information, and personal contact and private information the disclosure of which would invade the right to privacy of unrelated third parties. Where the BID can segregate the information that is exempt from disclosure, the records will be made available to you. However, due to the scope and breadth of your request, the BID will require an additional 14 days to identify, search for, and collect such records. When the records have been redacted, the cost will be as disclosed previously, plus staff time to copy. Alternatively, you can review these records in our office on a mutually agreeable date when both staff are present, and you can select those records you would like at the cost indicated on the form. Please let me know your preference is for copies and I will provide you with an approximation once we have a count. You have requested native format for emails, which can be delivered via flash drive at the same cost previously mentioned, \$3.50 per drive.
