I hope all is well. Jason Rudolph and I were on the phone with our legal and facilities team yesterday. I am looping in Ebony, too. While we don't plan to mobilize for tomorrow, we do plan to begin a proactive campaign on Prop. 39 to ratchet down tension, call on the District to improve Prop. 39 co-locations, and ask the District publicly to direct M&O fees to our partner site.

Jason, Ebony, what am I missing in terms of next steps? Can you make sure Extera is involved and helping to drive this work as we put together our plan over the coming weeks?

We have a pretty solid game plan for tomorrow. We've reached out to LAPD for support but it is hard to determine if they will actually show up to assist with removal of attendees who disrupt the meeting.
